INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: A three-run rally in the eighth inning propelled the Indianapolis Indians to a 10-9 comeback victory over the Memphis Redbirds on Thursday night at AutoZone Park. Trailing by two runs in the top of the eighth, Alike Williams and Liover Peguero drew back-to-back walks before Nick Yorke roped a ground-rule double off Oddanier Mosqueda to score Williams and trim the deficit to one. Jack Suwinski followed with a game-tying sacrifice fly, and Nick Solak delivered his fifth RBI of the night with a go-ahead single to left. Memphis opened the game with a three-run first inning. The Indians responded with a solo home run from Solak in the second before an offensive burst in the third. Sung-Che Cheng doubled and stole third, Yorke delivered an RBI single and Suwinski was hit by pitch to load the bases. Solak then cleared them with a double off Redbirds starter Drew Rom. Billy Cook followed with an RBI double and later scored on a single by Matt Fraizer before the game entered a rain delay. Following the delay, Memphis answered with two runs in the bottom of the third and surged ahead in the fifth with a four-run frame. The Indians chipped away in the sixth when Cheng singled and moved to third on a Yorke double. Suwinski grounded out to bring Cheng home before the Indians' rally in the eighth.

SOLAK ECLIPSE: Outfielder Nick Solak elected free agency and signed with Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent on Wednesday after having his contract outrighted by the Pirates. He made a triumphant return to the lineup, going 3-for-5 with 5 RBI and two runs, finishing a triple shy of the cycle. It marked the most RBI in a single game by an Indy batter since Joshua Palacios' five RBI on Sept. 8, 2024, at Toledo and Solak's most in a game since Aug. 28, 2022, with Round Rock at Albuquerque. He extended his hitting streak to nine games, the longest active run on the team, batting .500 (17-for-34) with three doubles, one triple, two home runs, eight RBI, four walks, nine runs, one stolen base and a 1.377 OPS in this span since May 7 vs. Columbus. Additionally, he has scored a run in four straight, the longest such active streak on the team. Among all minor leaguers with at least 25 games played, Solak ranks first in average .402 (47-for-117) and third in both SLG (.658) and OPS (1.116). He has reached base safely in 30 of 33 games this season and has one-plus hit in 29 of those, including a team best 13-game hitting streak from April 3-23.

COMEBACK KIDS: After scoring four unanswered runs when trailing, 9-6, the Indians improved to 14-5 in one-run games this season and picked up their 16th comeback win of the campaign. Their 16 comeback wins through June 5 are the most by the team since the 2019 Indians totaled 17 comeback wins to that date. Last night marked Indy's second win this season when trailing after the 7th frame (2-21).

CONCRETE JUNGLE: Nick Yorke continued his scorching run at the plate, going 3-for-5 with two doubles, one RBI and two runs. The trio of hits matched a season high (3x, MR - 5/1 @ OMA) and marked his 12th multi-hit game of the campaign, which is tied with Nick Solak for the most such contests on the team. Since May 1, he has hit safely in 22 of 27 games and posted multiple hits in nine of those. In this span, he is hitting .327 (33-for-101) with five doubles, two home runs, 13 RBI, six walks, 13 runs and seven stolen bases. Since this date he leads the team in hits, total bases (44) and stolen bases.

SOMEONE COOKED HERE: Billy Cook went 2-for-3 with one double, one RBI, two walks, one run and two stolen bases in last night's contest. It was his first multi-steal game since Sept. 5, 2023, with Double-A Bowie vs. New Hampshire. Cook reached base safely four times in back-to-back games, and for the third time this season, also doing so on Wednesday night. He has now hit safely in 10 of his last 11 games with an official at-bat dating back to May 23 at Toledo. In that span, he is hitting .349 (15-for-43) with two doubles, four RBI, eight walks, five runs and four stolen bases. He drew three walks on Wednesday, his most since walking three times on Sept. 2, 2024, at Toledo.

JACK MAGIC: Jack Suwinski (0-for-3) posted two RBI and one run last night. With an RBI groundout and a sacrifice fly, he became the first Indian to post a multi-RBI performance with no hits or walks since Mark Mathias drove in a pair on June 22, 2023, vs. Columbus.

DAZZLING DAURI: The Indians roster features one major league rehabber, right-hander Dauri Moreta. Moreta was placed on the 60-day injured list on Feb. 16 after undergoing Tommy John surgery and being sidelined for the entire 2024 season. Nearly 14 months after his last professional appearance, the right-hander began a rehab assignment with High-A Bradenton on April 29 and tossed 2.0 scoreless innings in two games. He has since pitched to a 4.46 ERA (5er/9.2ip) with Indy, allowing seven hits while striking out 14 across his 12 appearances dating back to May 6.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians continue their six-game series tonight against the Memphis Redbirds at 8:05 PM. Last night, the Indians secured back-to-back wins at Memphis for the first time since Aug. 12 and 13, 2023. Looking to secure at least a series split, left-hander Hunter Barco toes the rubber for Indianapolis. In his previous start on May 31 vs. Nashville, Barco tossed 3.0 shutout frames on one hit and three walks with seven strikeouts. He became the first Indians pitcher since at least 2005 to strike out seven in 3.0 shutout innings or fewer. Between Double-A Altoona and Indianapolis, it marked his third seven-plus strikeout performance in nine starts on the campaign. He has not allowed more than three hits in any of those nine starts, posted two hits or fewer in eight of those and one hit or fewer in four. Seven of those starts were scoreless outings. It marks his first career appearance against the Redbirds. Taking the mound for Memphis is fellow southpaw Quinn Mathews. Mathews is winless (0-2) in his four starts this season, tossing just 13.0 innings on the campaign. He has walked three or more batters in all of those and six batters twice. He has thrown a season-low 2.2 innings in his previous two starts. It marks his first career appearance against Indianapolis.

ON THIS DATE IN 2001: The Indians swept a twinbill vs. Durham at Victory Field behind a walk-off home run in Game 1 and a four-run seventh inning to mount a comeback in Game 2. Right fielder Micah Franklin smacked three extra-base hits on the day, making him one single away from the doubleheader cycle. Franklin hit a double and a solo home run in the opener, his seventh of the season, in a 4-3 walk-off win. Franklin would go on to pace the team with 23 home runs in 2001. In the nightcap, trailing 5-3, a four-run seventh inning was highlighted by a bases-clearing triple off the bat at Franklin as the Indians sealed the doubleheader sweep with a 7-6 win.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Hunter Barco: The southpaw ranks as Pittsburgh's No. 5 prospect and Minor League Baseball's No. 90 overall prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

Historic Zeroes: Barco did not allow a run in his six starts with Double-A Altoona, totaling 25.2 consecutive scoreless innings to begin the season, marking the longest scoreless streak in Curve history.

Last Outing: On May 31 vs. Nashville, Barco tossed 3.0 shutout frames on one hit and three walks with seven strikeouts. He became the first Indians pitcher since at least 2005 to strike out seven in 3.0 shutout innings or fewer.

Against the Redbirds: Tonight marks Barco's first career start against the Redbirds.

EAS Pitcher of the Month: Barco was awarded the 2025 Eastern League April Pitcher of the Month Award after leading the league (min. 20ip) in ERA (0.00, 20.2ip) and batting average against (.132, 9-for-68), while ranking second in WHIP (0.63) and tied for fourth in strikeouts (30).

Mowing Them Down: Barco finshed his award-winning April with back-to-back eight-strikeout starts, the last of which came in just 3.0 innings of work on April 27 at Double-A Chesapeake. He became the first Pirates full-season farmhand to strike out eight or more batters in 3.0 innings or less since Osvaldo Bido also struck out eight in 3.0 innings vs. Triple-A Louisville on Aug. 4th, 2022.

Miscellaneous: Barco was selected by the Pirates in the second round (44th overall) of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Florida (Gainesville).
