ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cedar Rapids Kernels beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 4-1 at Neuroscience Group Field at Fox Cities Stadium. The duo of Cory Lewis (5IP, H, R, BB, 3K, Win) and Mike Paredes (4IP, 0H, 0R, 2BB, 3K, Save) combined to hold the Timber Rattlers to one hit in the game. Kala'i Rosario and Andrew Cossetti both homered late for the Kernels to add insurance to their 2-1 lead. Rosario has fourteen homers this season and is tied for second in the Midwest League in this category. Cedar Rapids has won six straight games. The Rattlers have dropped four straight games.

ONE FOR ONE: Wisconsin trailed 1-0 after Kyler Fedko's sacrifice fly plated a run in the top of the second inning. Robert Moore tied the game with a twoout, RBI single in the bottom of the third inning to score Je'Von Ward, who had walked and stole second base earlier in the inning. **DEBUT:** Nate Peterson was Wisconsin's starting pitcher last night as he made his Timber Rattlers debut. He allowed a run on four hits and a walk over four innings. Peterson was not involved in the decision.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence as the Cedar Rapids Braves, an affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves in the Three-I League, in 1958. That was the same year and league the current Timber Rattlers franchise joined the Three-I League as the Fox Cities Foxes. Both teams moved to the Midwest League when the Three-I League ended after the 1961 season. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels have made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins, including this year. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, Trevor Hoffman, Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook, and Ted Simmons.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places three active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Robert Moore (#8), Hendry Mendez (#13), and Matthew Wood (#24). Eric Brown Jr (#6)y, Eduardo García (#19), and Joseph Hernandez (#25) are currently on Wisconsin's IL. MLB Pipeline has eight active Kernels on their list of Minnesota prospects: Emmanuel Rodriguez (#2), Noah Miller (#11), Misael Urbina (#19), Alejandro Hidalgo (#20), CJ Culpepper (#26), Kala'i Rosario (#27), Ben Ross (#28), and Cory Lewis (#30). Connor Prelipp (#3) is currently on the IL and Jose Salas (#7) is on the Development List.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

#### WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CAMERON WAGONER: Selected by Milwaukee in the eleventh round of the 2022 draft out of Eastern Michigan University.

**EASTERN NOTES:** Wagoner did not pitch collegiately in 2022. He made six relief appearances during the abbreviated 2020 season and 18 appearances – three starts – in 2021. He was 2-4 with a 4.42 ERA and 67 strikeouts over 57 innings during his two college seasons.

HOW DID YOU SPEND YOUR SUMMERS? Wagoner played for Greeneville in the Appalachian League in 2021 and was with both Wareham and Cotuit in the Cape Cod League in 2022. He was 2-3 with a 4.97 ERA in nineteen games – two starts – and 57 strikeouts over 38 innings pitched in those summer leagues.

**AS A PRO:** Wagoner made four appearances – two starts – for the ACL Brewers Gold after signing with Milwaukee. He was 1-0 and had eight strikeouts in eight innings in the ACL.

**DOWN UNDER:** Wagoner pitched for the Brisbane Bandits of the Australian Baseball League during the Winter of 2022-23. He made ten starts during the regular season of the ABL and was 3-1 with a 3.26 ERA and 43 strikeouts in 47 innings pitched.

**LAST START:** Wagoner won at Dayton on July 19. He allowed two runs on five hits with a walk, a hit batsman, and eight strikeouts. Wagoner allowed a homer in the game, a two-run homer in the fifth inning. He set a new professional single-game high for strikeouts in the victory, his first since April 14.

**VS. CEDAR RAPIDS:** Wagoner took the loss at Cedar Rapids on May 26. He allowed three runs – two earned – on nine hits with a walk and three strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings.

# CEDAR RAPIDS SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CJ CULPEPPER: The Minnesota Twins selected Culpepper in the thirteenth round of the 2022 draft out of California Baptist University. Culpepper is the #26 prospect in the Minnesota organization according to MLB Pipeline.

**GOLDEN STATE:** Culpepper pitched from 2020 through 2022 for CBU. He was 7-7 with fourteen saves in 44 games – sixteen starts – in his three seasons. Culpepper had 126 strikeouts in 108-1/3 innings pitched with a 3.74 ERA in his college career.

THAT'S WAC: Culpepper was the closer for the Lancers in 2021 and went 2-2 with thirteen saves over 22 appearances to be named Western Athletic Conference Freshman of the Year and First Team All-WAC. In 2022, Culpepper was 5-3 in sixteen games – fourteen starts at Cal Baptist and was Second Team All-WAC.

**COMPLEXITY:** Culpepper made one one-inning relief appearance for the Florida Complex League Twins in 2022 after signing with Minnesota. He walked a batter, hit a batter, and struck out a batter without allowing a hit or a run.

**STARTING OVER:** Culpepper began the 2023 season with the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels. He was 4-3 with a 2.33 ERA and 53 strikeouts over 46-1/3 innings pitched in eleven starts before his promotion to Cedar Rapids on June 26.

**LAST START:** Culpepper beat Peoria at home on <u>July 20</u>. He allowed three hits, walked two, and struck out four over five scoreless innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Culpepper has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this afternoon. Today is also his first appearance against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
