# **INDY BITS**

ABOUT SUNDAY: The back-and-forth contest was all Louisville until the second half, with the Bats taking a 2-0 lead with one run in the first and one in the fourth on a P.J. Higgins RBI double. Indianapolis then tied the game on a two-run home run by the rehabbing Endy Rodríguez - his second in as many days after he launched one in Game 1 of Saturday's doubleheader. A run-scoring groundout in the seventh gave the Bats the lead before the two-run bottom half. The first two Indians batters reached base safely on singles, with a sacrifice bunt by Billy Cook moving both into scoring position. Stewart then drove in Jack Suwinski on a sacrifice fly, and a wild throw by right fielder Jack Rogers brought Nick Yorke home as the game-winning run against Connor Phillips.

BATS MEET BROOMS: Sunday's win clinched a six-game sweep of the Louisville Bats, marking Indy's third sweep since Minor League Baseball moved to the six-game format in 2021, and it's first since taking six straight from St. Paul from Aug. 13-18, 2024, at Victory Field. The Indians have now won their last seven games and took 10 of the 12 games on their two-week homestand. The seven-game winning streak is Indy's longest of the season and its best since a nine-game run from July 23-Aug.1, 2024. It's also the longest-active winning streak in the International League and the second-longest active winning streak in all of Minor League Baseball, only trailing Triple-A Sugar Land's 11-game streak.

CARDIAC KIDS: The Indians picked up two comeback victories over the weekend, overcoming 2-0 deficits in Game 2 of Saturday night's doubleheader and in Sunday's season finale. Indy's 13 comeback victories so far this season surpasses the seven it had through 43 games in the 2024 season. Indianapolis leads the International League with a .295 batting average in tie games and ranks fifth with a .259 batting average when the team is trailing. The Indians also moved to 16-5 in games decided by two-runs or less with a 6-4 victory in Game 1 on Saturday and 11-3 in one-run games with their 4-3 victory on Sunday.

QUÉ LO QUE: Rehabber Endy Rodríguez tagged a game-tying two-run homer off RHP Aaron Wilkerson in the sixth inning of Sunday's victory. It was his second two-run homer in as many days, as he clubbed his first off RHP Alan Busenitz in Game 1 of Saturday's doubleheader. He began his rehab assignment on Wednesday after being placed on the 10-day injured list on April 15 with a right-hand laceration, sustained when struck by a pitch in the dirt on April 14 vs. Washington. On his rehab stint, Endy is hitting .300 (3-for-10) with two homers, four RBI, three runs scored, a walk and a 1.264 OPS.

CAPTAIN JACK: Jack Suwinski helped fuel the Indians offense in the series against Louisville, going 5-for-18 with a double, two homers, nine RBI and a .983 OPS in five games. Suwinski's nine RBI in the series all came in a three-game stretch from May 14-17 (2), in which he recorded three RBI in all three games and tied for the most RBI in Triple-A in that span. Suwinski's streak of three RBI in three straight games was the longest by an Indians hitter since Brad Eldred tallied three or more RBI in three straight games from July 18-20, 2005. The Chicago, III. native has reached base safely in 16 of 19 games since debuting on April 25 and leads the team with 17 RBI in that stretch. He also leads active Indians players (min. 4G) in slugging percentage (.508), OPS (.864), home runs (4) and total bases (32) in this span.

NEW YORK(E) STATE OF MIND: Nick Yorke picked up two hits in Sunday's contest, bringing his total in May to 17, which leads all Indians hitters in the month. Yorke has hit safely in 11 of 13 games played in May and has racked up multiple hits in five of those contests. On the month, Yorke has totaled a .321 batting average (17-for-53) with two homers, six RBI, eight runs scored, four stolen bases and a .755 OPS.

PEGGY PROWESS: Since being optioned from Pittsburgh on May 12, Liover Peguero has picked up a hit in four of five games with Indianapolis, giving him a .400 batting average (6-for-15) with three runs scored, a double, a home run, four RBI and a 1.138 OPS since his return. Peguero has also showcased his defensive versatility since returning, playing two games at third base and one at short while also playing his first-career professional game at first base on May 17 (1) vs Louisville, recording seven putouts in seven total chances.

TWO MORE BUCCOS ABOARD: In addition to Endy Rodríguez, the Indians roster also boasts two additional major league rehabbers in Dauri Moreta and Nick Gonzales. Gonzales was placed on the 10-day injured list on March 28 with a non-displaced left ankle fracture sustained after hitting a two-run home run in the sixth inning on Opening Day at Miami. He excelled in 94 games with Pittsburgh last season, hitting .270 (97-for-359) with 19 doubles, three triples, seven home runs and 49 RBI. Moreta was placed on the 60-day injured list on Feb. 16 after undergoing Tommy John surgery and being sidelined for the entire 2024 season, Nearly 14 months after his last professional appearance, the right-hander began a rehab assignment with High-A Bradenton on April 29 and tossed 2.0 scoreless innings in two games. He has since allowed two runs while striking out eight in 4.2 innings (five appearances) with Indy.

TODAY'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians look to pick up their eighth straight win as they kick off a six-game road trip against the Toledo Mud Hens at 11:05 AM. The Indians have won nine of their last 12 game against the Mud Hens, including a current five-game winning streak from their series earlier this season at Victory Field. RHP Braxton Ashcraft is set to take the bump for the Indians across from LHP Nick Margevicius. Ashcraft faced the Mud Hens twice earlier this season during their first series and was tagged for six earned runs across 8.0 innings pitched in those starts. This will be Margevicius' first-career start against the Indians, who are 7-3 when facing left-handed starters this season.

ON THIS DATE IN 1987: Dennis Martinez fired a one-hit shutout in a 5-0 win for the Indians against Buffalo at Bush Stadium. Martinez finished with five strikeouts in the 9.0-inning complete game. Left fielder Tom Romano and third baseman Jeff Řeynolds both hit home runs for Indy while second baseman Johnny Paredes and first baseman Razor Shines notched two hits apiece.

# TONIGHT'S PITCHER

**Braxton Ashcraft:** The right-hander is Pittsburgh's No. 7 prospect according to MLB Pipeline and No. 4 according to *Baseball America*.

**Opening Day Starter:** Ashcraft made his second career Opening Day start on March 28 at St. Paul, last doing so on June 14, 2019, with Class-A short season West Virginia.

**Last Outing:** Ashcraft did not factor into the decision on May 14 vs. Louisville, allowing five hits and four earned runs while striking out a season-high eight strikeouts across 6.0 innings.

**Against the Mud Hens:** In two career starts against Toledo, which both came earlier this season, Ashcraft is 0-0 with a 6.75 ERA (6er/8.0ip), 13 hits allowed and a six strikeouts.

**Prospectus:** Ashcraft entered the 2025 season rated as Pittsburgh's No. 6 prospect according to MLB Pipeline and No. 4 according to *Baseball America*. Since being drafted by the Pirates in 2018, No. 4 is his highest ranking according to *BA*, elevated from No. 10 last season.

**Miscellaneous**: Ashcraft was drafted by Pittsburgh in the second round (51st overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Robinson High School (Waco, Texas). He had his contract first selected by Pittsburgh on Nov. 14, 2023.
