INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: A pair of two-run homers by Jack Suwinski and Brett Sullivan, and 8.1 shutout innings from the pitching staff led the Indianapolis Indians to a 7-1 win over the Nashville Sounds on Thursday night at Victory Field. Following 4.2 shutout frames from starter Carmen Mlodzinski, Ryder Ryan and Carson Fulmer allowed just two baserunners in 3.1 combined innings. The Sounds broke up the shutout bid against Isaac Mattson in the ninth. After stranding a leadoff triple from Jimmy Herron to begin the game, the Indians offense got to work early and often. A two-run second inning featured defensive miscues by the Sounds before a mammoth 461-foot home run by Suwinski – the Indians second-longest since official Statcast tracking began in 2022 – doubled the lead against Carlos Rodriguez in the third. The home runs continued, with Sullivan extending the lead on another two-run shot in the sixth for his first homer of the year. An RBI single by Billy Cook in the eighth tacked on an additional insurance run. Suwinski reached base safely in three of his four plate appearances, with a double and walk joining his two-run homer. Alika Williams also logged a pair of hits, and Sullivan tallied two RBI from his long ball.

MAGIC MLODZINSKI: Carmen Mlodzinski made his second career start with the Indians last night and recorded another 4.2 scoreless innings, extending his scoreless innings streak to 10.2 innings since his first start on May 23 at Toledo. He held Nashville to just three hits, which were the fewest he has allowed in a start since allowing three on Sept. 16, 2022, vs. Double-A Akron. Across his first two Triple-A starts, Mlodzinski has racked up 15 strikeouts and has held opponents to a batting average of .184 (7-for-38).

VICTORY FIELD (LITERALLY): With last night's win, Indy improved to 19-7 at home, good for a .731 winning percentage that ranks second among all Triple-A teams this season. The Indians also avoided losing back-to-back games at home, which they haven't done since dropping the last game of their first home series on April 6 vs. Iowa and the first game of their second home series on April 15 vs. Toledo. Since then, the Indians are 17-3 at home, good for a .850 winning percentage that paces all Triple-A teams and trails only High-A Brooklyn (13-2, .867) for the highest winning percentage among all minor league teams in that stretch. In May, the Indians have a .800 winning percentage (12-3) at Victory Field, which would be their highest in a month at home (min. 7 games) since they also went 12-3 at Victory Field in May 2017.

PITCHER'S DUEL: In May, Indians pitchers lead Triple-A in opponent batting average (.224) and strikeouts per nine innings (10.96), are tied for the most strikeouts (253) and rank second in ERA (3.44, 80er/209.1ip), WHIP (1.23) and opponent OPS (.668). Additionally, they've allowed the fewest hits (173) and the fifth-fewest walks (84) in May. Indy's bullpen has a 2.25 ERA (24er/96.0ip) with a 1.08 WHIP and a .206 opponent batting average in the month, all of which lead Triple-A teams. On the flip side, Nashville's staff has been dominant all season, leading Triple-A pitching staffs with a 3.22 ERA (164er/458.2ip) and a .652 opponent OPS while holding the third-lowest WHIP (1.25). Nashville's bullpen has pitched to a Triple-A leading 3.04 ERA (73er/216.1ip) so far this season, far surpassing Jacksonville's 3.48 ERA (98er/253.1ip), which is the second-lowest ERA by a Triple-A bullpen.

MAY FLOWERS FOR FELLOWS: Drake Fellows was named the Indians May Player of the Month today, becoming the first Indians reliever to do so since Hunter Stratton in Aug. 2023. In May, Fellows has a 2-0 record with a 0.71 ERA (1er/12.2ip), which is the fifth lowest of any Triple-A reliever with at least 10.0 innings pitched in the month. He has just allowed an earned run across his last 10.1 innings pitched dating back to his first appearance of the month on May 3 at Omaha. He's also racked up 14 strikeouts to three walks and has held opponents to a 1.03 WHIP in his five May appearances. Four of Fellows' five appearances in May and eight of his 12 appearances on the season have gone 2.0-plus innings and he has only allowed more than one run in one of those multi-inning appearances.

JACK ATTACK: Jack Suwinski helped to power the Indians offense last night, just as he's done all season since joining the team. Since his first game of the season with Indy in Game 1 of a doubleheader on April 25, Suwinski leads qualified Indians hitters in home runs (6), RBI (22), OPS (.827), extra-base hits (10), total bases (44) and runs scored. He also leads Indians hitters for the entire season in RBI and is tied with Nick Solak for the team lead in homers despite spending a majority of April with Pittsburgh.

PAIR O' PIRATES: The Indians roster boasts two major league rehabbers in Nick Gonzales and Dauri Moreta after Endy Rodríguez's rehab assignment came to an end on Tuesday. Gonzales has picked up a hit in each of his last three games, including a triple in last night's contest, which marked his first extra-base hit of his rehab assignment. He was placed on the 10-day injured list on March 28 with a non-displaced left ankle fracture, sustained after hitting a two-run home run in the sixth inning on Opening Day at Miami. Moreta was placed on the 60-day injured list on Feb. 16 after undergoing Tommy John surgery and being sidelined for the entire 2024 season. Nearly 14 months after his last professional appearance, the right-hander began a rehab assignment with High-A Bradenton on April 29 and tossed 2.0 scoreless innings in two games. He has since pitched to a 2.25 ERA (2er/8.0ip) with Indy, allowing five hits while striking out 11 across his nine appearances.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indians look to clinch at least a series split with a win against the Sounds in Game 4 of their six-game set tonight at 7:05 PM from Victory Field. Indianapolis has not lost a home series since their first of the season against the Iowa Cubs from April 1-6. Additionally, the Indians are 5-1 in Game 4 of series' and 7-2 on Friday so far this season. MiLB's No. 2 prospect, Bubba Chandler, is set to take the mound for the Indians, who are 7-3 in his starts so far this season. Chandler has faced the Sounds once, in his Triple-A debut on Aug. 9 at Nashville, and held them to two hits and no runs while striking out six across 7.0 innings. Nashville will send righty Tobias Myers to the mound to counter Chandler. The Indians have hit Myers well in his two starts against them, managing 13 hits and nine runs across 6.2 innings against the 6'1" righty.

BUBBA BUMP DAY: In Bubba Chandler's last start on May 24 at Toledo, he became the first Indians pitcher since Chase De Jong on April 13, 2022, at St. Paul, to take a no-hitter into the seventh inning. He finished his effort with one hit and two runs allowed across 6.1 innings. On the season, Chandler ranks second among qualified Triple-A pitchers in ERA (2.27, 11er/43.2ip), opponent batting average (.178) and strikeouts per nine (12.57) while tying for the third-most strikeouts (61). He's also allowed the least hits of any qualified Triple-A pitcher and has held opponents to the third-lowest OPS (.544). Since his debut on Aug. 9, 2024, Chandler has held opponents to a .538 OPS and strikes out 12.47 batters per nine innings (115 K/83.0ip), which both are the best marks for any Indians pitcher with at least 80.0 innings pitched since 2005. Additionally, he ranks second in ERA (2.06, 19er/83.0ip) and opponent batting average (.180), and seventh in WHIP (1.06).

ON THIS DATE IN 2006: In a 16-2 win at Syracuse in which the Indians outlit the SkyChiefs, 20-6, first baseman Chris Richard drove in four runs on a double and three-run home run. Indy's offense put up a nine-run ninth inning to finish off the win with an exclamation point. Richard ended the season with a team-high 17 home runs and 67 RBI.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Bubba Chandler: Right-hander Bubba Chandler is currently rated the No. 2 overall prospect in Minor League Baseball according to MLB Pipeline and is the Pirates No. 1. In 17 career starts with Indianapolis, Chandler is 6-1 with a 2.06 ERA (19er/83.2ip) and 115 strikeouts. He has struck out eight-plus batters in seven of those starts and six-plus in 10.

Last Outing: Chandler did not factor into the decision on May 24 at Toledo, tossing a season-high 6.1 innings with one hit, two runs, four walks and five strikeouts.

Against the Sounds: Chandler has one career start against the Sounds, earning the win in his Triple-A debut on Aug. 9, 2024, at Nashville. He tossed 7.0 shutout innings with two hits, one walk and six strikeouts.

IL Pitcher of the Month: Chandler was named the 2025 International League April Pitcher of the Month after he led all minor league pitchers with at least 20.0 innings in fewest hits allowed (seven) and batting average against (.106, 7-for-66). He is the first Indianapolis Indians pitcher to win a league monthly award since Zach Duke in May 2005. He went 1-0 with a 1.33 ERA (3er/20.1ip), 27 strikeouts and a 0.64 WHIP across five starts in the month. In addition to his minor league leading marks, he led IL pitchers with at least 20.0 innings in WHIP and finished third in ERA.

IL Pitcher of the Week: Chandler was named the International League Pitcher of the Week for Aug. 5-11, 2024, after tossing 7.0 shutout innings with two hits, one walk and six strikeouts while he secured the win.

Miscellaneous: Selected by Pittsburgh in the third round (72nd overall) of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of North Oconee (Bogart, GA.) High School. . Selected to the 2024 All-Star Futures Game and struck out Royals prospect Gavin Cross.
