#### SATURDAY IN THE PARK: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Peoria Chiefs 6-3 at Neuroscience Group Field at Fox Cities Stadium.](https://www.wisconsinradio.com/)

Darrien Miller, Terence Doston, and Ben Metzinger each had a two-RBI hit and Steven Cruz pitched five scoreless innings for the Timber Rattlers. Kaleb Bowman entered the game in the ninth with the tying run on deck and got the final three outs to close out the game.

**CRUZ-ING:** Cruz allowed three hits, walked one and struck out four on Saturday. He retired the final seven batters he faced in the game for win #1 in 2023.

**BO KNOWS:** Bowman is 3-for-3 in save opportunities this season for Wisconsin. Yesterday, he got Patrick Romeri to ground into a double play and Francisco Hernandez to popout to left to end the game. Bowman needed just seven pitches for the final three outs. Bowman also had a save on Friday night.

**DOUBLE BUBBLE:** Wisconsin turned two key double plays on Saturday. Cruz escaped his only jam of the game – first and second with one out in the third inning – by getting Jimmy Crooks to ground into a 4-6-3 double play. Then, Bowman got a 4-6-3 double play in the ninth. Wisconsin has turned three 4-6-3 double play in the last two games.

**STRIKE FIRST:** Darrien Miller's two-out, two-run double in the first inning gave the Rattlers the lead. Wisconsin has scored first in six of their eight games this season.

**STRIKE HARD:** Doston singled off the glove of Peoria pitcher Austin Love in the second inning to drive in two runs for a 4-0 lead. Doston is on a five-game hitting streak.

**BIG BEN:** Metzinger's two-run double in the fifth put the Rattlers up 6-0. He also drove in two runs for Wisconsin on Friday night.

**GRAY HAVENS:** Joe Gray Jr had two singles and a walk on Saturday for his fourth multi-hit game of the season. Gray has also reached base in all eight games this season and has an OPS of .932.

**ABOUT PEORIA:** The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1983 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels in 1984. They changed their name to the Chiefs and their affiliation to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. They became a Cardinals affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his first year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, and Yadier Molina.

**ABOUT THE CARDINALS:** St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP TYLER WOESSNER:** Drafted by the Milwaukee Brewers in the sixth round of the 2022 draft out of Central Arizona College.

**WHAT A SEASON:** Woessner went 11-2 with a 3.55 ERA in nineteen games – eighteen starts – during his final season at CAC. He walked 34 and struck out 122 in 96-1/3 innings pitched for the Vaqueros.

**PITCHING INTO THE FINALS:** Central Arizona College advanced to the 2022 NJCAA College World Series in Grand Junction, Colorado. Woessner was the winning pitcher in the game that got CAC into the Championship game as he allowed three runs and struck out eight over seven innings in the Vaqueros' 7-4 win over Walters State Community College on [June 3, 2022](#). Central Arizona College won the National Title the next day with a 4-2 win over Cowley County Community College

**NORTH TO ALASKA:** Woessner pitched in three games – one start – for the Mat-Su Miners of the Alaska Baseball League in 2021. He had no record, walked three, and struck out four over seven innings.

**FIRST YEAR AS A BREWER:** Woessner started his pro career with the Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and made three appearances – two starts – with eleven strikeouts over six scoreless innings. Woessner also made one start for the Carolina Mudcats at the end of the 2022 Carolina League season.

**LAST START:** Woessner [beat Peoria on April 11 at home](#). He allowed three runs – one earned – on three hits and two walks with five strikeouts over five innings. Woessner earned his first professional win with his performance.

**VS. PEORIA:** Woessner had never faced Peoria prior to last Tuesday.

## PEORIA SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP TRENT BAKER:** Drafted by the St. Louis Cardinals in the ninth round of the 2021 draft out of Angelo State University.

**ANGELO:** Baker pitched four seasons at Angelo State, an NCAA Division II school in San Angelo, Texas. He was 31-7 with a 2.69 ERA and 148 strikeouts over 131 innings pitched in 52 games – 47 starts.

**SENIOR SEASON:** Baker went 13-1 with a 2.11ERA in seventeen starts during his final season at Angelo State. He had 120 strikeouts over 106-2/3 innings pitched, was named the Lone Star Conference Pitcher of the Year, and helped the Rams advance to the 2021 NCAA Division II College World Series. He pitched twice during that College World Series, but had a no decision in both starts.

**SUMMER WORK:** Baker pitched for three different summer wood bat leagues during his college career: Newark of the Perfect Game Collegiate Baseball League (2018), Mankato of the Northwoods League (2019), and Round Rock of the Texas Collegiate League (2020).

**GOING PRO:** Baker made eight relief appearances without a decision in the Florida Complex League affiliate of the Cardinals in 2021 after signing with St. Louis. In 2022, Baker made 25 starts for Palm Beach in the Florida State League and was 9-7 with a 3.14ERA and 138 strikeouts over 123-1/3 innings pitched.

**LAST START:** Baker [took the loss against Wisconsin on April 11](#). He allowed five runs on six hits with a walk and two strikeouts over four innings. Ernesto Martínez hit a two-run home run in the third inning off Baker to give Wisconsin a 5-0 lead.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Baker had never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to last Tuesday.
