SUNDAY IN THE PARK: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Cedar Rapids Kernels 7-5 at Neuroscience Group Field.](#)

Eduardo Garcia hit a three-run home run in the top of the fourth inning to give Wisconsin a 4-0 lead. The homer was the tenth of the season for Garcia. Marco Dinges and Juan Baez had three hits with Blake Burke and Luiyin Alastre adding two hits for the Rattlers. Wisconsin took four of the six games in the series from the Kernels to win their third straight series. Wisconsin is 13-5 in their last eighteen. **STAY HOT:** Garcia is on a 21-game on-base streak, the longest active streak in the Midwest League. He is 26-for-80 (.325) with eight doubles, a triple, seven homers, sixteen RBI, 25 runs scored, and nine walks for a 1.113 OPS during the streak.

MAKE A NOTE OF IT: Garcia is the first Timber Rattler to have ten home runs in a season before July since Clint Coulter in 2014. Garcia leads the MWL in extra-base hits (26)

THREE-PEAT: Dinges had his third three-hit game of the series with the Kernels on Sunday. He also had three hits in game one of Wednesday's doubleheader and three hits on Thursday night. Dinges went 10-for-20 with six RBI in the five games he played in the series with the Kernels.

MULTI-MAN: Burke recorded his 17th multi-hit game of the season on Sunday. He is second in the league in hits (66) and third in the league in average (.325).

NICE DEBUT: Sam Garcia made his first Midwest League start for the Rattlers on Sunday. He allowed two runs on two hits with a walk and four strikeouts over 5-1/3 innings for the win.

ABOUT GREAT LAKES: The Great Lakes Loons came into existence in 2007 after the Midwest League team left Battle Creek, Michigan at the end of the 2006 season. The team in Battle Creek had been known as the Michigan Battle Cats, Battle Creek Yankees, and the Southwest Michigan Devil Rays. The Loons have been affiliated with the Los Angeles Dodgers since 2007. They have made the Midwest League playoffs nine times since 2007. The Loons won the Midwest League title in 2016 and lost to Cedar Rapids in the Midwest League Championship Series in 2023. Notable Great Lakes alumni include Clayton Kershaw, Kenley Jansen, Nathan Eovaldi, Joc Peterson, Julio Urias, Walker Buehler, and Gavin Lux. Jair Fernandez, who played in 52 games with the Timber Rattlers in 2007, is in his second season as the manager of the Loons.

ABOUT THE DODGERS: The Los Angeles Dodgers were only in the Midwest League for a few seasons prior to affiliating with the Loons. They were in Dubuque in 1967 and in Clinton from 1977 to 1979. Orel Hershiser and Steve Sax were notable Dodgers to play in Clinton.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) places five Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Bishop Letson (#14), Blake Burke (#17), Jader Areinamo (#23), Juan Baez (#26), and Manuel Rodriguez (#29). [MLB Pipeline](#) has six Loons on their list of Top 30 Dodgers prospects: Josue De Paula (#2), Zahir Hope (#3), Kendall George (#12), Eriq Swan (#16), Mike Sirota (#18), and Logan Wagner (#24).

THE SEASON SO FAR: The Loons were 34-32 in the first half and missed the playoffs. They are currently 27-23 in the second half. They are in third place in the East Division and trail first place Dayton by five games.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP RYAN BIRCHARD: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Birchard in the 5th round of the 2023 draft out of the Niagara County Community College.

PLAYER OF THE YEAR: Birchard was named the Western New York Athletic Conference Player of the Year in 2023. He was 8-0 in ten games – nine starts – with a 1.08 ERA and 95 strikeouts over fifty innings pitched. Birchard was also named a First Team All-NJCAA Division III All-American in 2023.

QUICK TRIP TO TRENTON: Birchard made four appearances – two starts – for Trenton in the MLB Draft League after the end of his college season. He allowed one run, walked one, and struck out sixteen over nine innings before signing with Milwaukee.

DELAYED START: Birchard did not pitch professionally in 2023. He made a start for the Carolina Mudcats on April 6, 2024 (4.0IP, H, R, 0ER, 2BB, 6K) but was placed on the IL after that game. He next pitched with the ACL Brewers on July 16 and July 22. Birchard rejoined Carolina for appearances on July 28 and August 3 before being sent to Wisconsin on August 13.

AS A RATTLER (2024): Birchard made five regular season starts for Wisconsin last season. He was 0-3 with an 8.71 ERA. He walked fourteen and struck out thirteen in 10-1/3 innings with the Timber Rattlers

LAST START: Birchard beat Cedar Rapids at home on [June 4](#). He struck out a career-high ten over 5-2/3 innings while allowing two runs on two walks and five strikeouts.

VS. GREAT LAKES: Birchard had a no decision at Great Lakes on [August 24, 2024](#). He allowed one hit, walked four, and struck out six over three scoreless innings.

GREAT LAKES STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CAM DAY: The Los Angeles Dodgers signed Day as a non-drafted free agent out of the University of Utah on August 2, 2023.

DID YOU SAY “UTES”? Day pitched two seasons at Utah. He went 4-12 with an 8.54 ERA in 31 games – 25 starts – with 91 strikeouts and 57 walks in 117 innings.

SUMMER BALL: Day pitched for the Corvallis Knights of the West Coast League during the summer of 2022. He was 2-0 with a save and a 0.48 ERA in five games – three starts.

BEFORE THE LAKES: Day started his pro career with two games – one start – and 2-1/3 innings for the ACL Dodgers in 2023. Last year, Day went 5-6 with a 4.68 ERA in 24 games – fifteen starts – for Rancho Cucamonga in the California League. He walked 52 and struck out 94 in 102 innings pitched for the Quakes.

LAST START: Day had a no decision against Fort Wayne at home on [May 27](#). He allowed two hits, walked one, and struck out four over four scoreless innings.

LAST APPEARANCE: Day lost at South Bend on [June 3](#) in a relief outing. He allowed seven runs on eight hits with three walks and two strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Day has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. Tonight is also his first appearance against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
