ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Quad Cities River Bandits 4-0 at Modern Woodmen Park.](#) Tyson Hardin pitched five no-hit innings and faced the minimum to earn the win in his Midwest League debut. The Bandits were held to one hit in the game.

HARD DAY'S NIGHT: Hardin walked the second batter in the first inning. He got the next hitter to line into a double play. Then, Hardin retired Quad Cities in order from the second through the fifth inning. He struck out four and needed only 51 pitches.

AFTER TWO THEY GO! Wisconsin scored all their runs last night after there were two outs and none on base. Jadher Areinamo and Matt Wood had consecutive doubles with two outs in the third inning to give Wisconsin a 1-0 lead. Eduardo Garcia followed with an RBI single to score Wood. In the sixth, Daniel Guilarte singled with two outs. Then, Hedbert Pérez cracked a two-run home run to right for the 4-0 lead. The Rattlers had seventeen base runners last night and only three of those reached base with less than two outs. Juan Baez was the only Wisconsin hitter to reach base as the lead-off batter last night.

DOESN'T MATTER WHEN: In their last two games, Wisconsin has scored seven consecutive runs after they had two outs with none on base.

CLOSING IT OUT: Aaron Rund walked two and struck out one over 1-1/3 innings in relief of Hardin. Brian Fitzpatrick finished the game a walk and four strikeouts in 2-2/3 innings for the combined shutout.

ONE HIT: The only hit for Quad Cities was a one-out single by Carter Frederick off Rund in the top of the seventh. Frederick had a clean single to center on a 3-2 pitch.

STREAKING: Areinamo is on a three-game hitting streak. He is also the only Rattler to reach base in all four games this season.

ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo (1969-1976), Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP RYAN BIRCHARD: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Birchard in the 5th round of the 2023 draft out of the Niagara County Community College.

PLAYER OF THE YEAR: Birchard was named the Western New York Athletic Conference Player of the Year in 2023. He was 8-0 in ten games – nine starts – with a 1.08 ERA and 95 strikeouts over fifty innings pitched. Birchard was also named a First Team All-NJCAA Division III All-American in 2023.

QUICK TRIP TO TRENTON: Birchard made four appearances – two starts – for Trenton in the MLB Draft League after the end of his college season. He allowed one run, walked one, and struck out sixteen over nine innings before signing with Milwaukee.

DELAYED START: Birchard did not pitch professionally in 2023. He made a start for the Carolina Mudcats on April 6, 2024 (4.0IP, H, R, 0ER, 2BB, 6K) but was placed on the IL after that game. He next pitched with the ACL Brewers on July 16 and July 22. Birchard rejoined Carolina for appearances on July 28 and August 3 before being sent to Wisconsin on August 13.

AS A RATTLER: Birchard made five regular season starts for Wisconsin last season. He was 0-3 with an 8.71 ERA. He walked fourteen and struck out thirteen in 10-1/3 innings with the Timber Rattlers.

LAST START: Birchard had a no decision at home against Lake County in Game One of the 2024 Midwest League Championship Series on [September 15](#). He allowed three runs – two earned – on three hits and five walks with three strikeouts over 1-2/3 innings.

VS. QUAD CITIES: Birchard took the loss in a start against the River Bandits at home on [August 30, 2024](#). He gave up four runs on three hits and three walks and a strikeout in 0.1IP. Spencer Nivens hit a two-run homer against Birchard in the game.

QUAD CITIES STARTING PITCHER:

RHP FELIX ARRONDE: The Kansas City Royals signed Arronde, a native of Cuba, to a minor league contract on June 28, 2021 just after he turned eighteen.

RATING: MLB Pipeline ranks Arronde as the #18 prospect in the Royals system. *Baseball America* slots him at #19 in the Royals organization.

COLUMBIAN EXHIBITION: Arronde spent 2021 and 2022 in the Dominican Summer League. He split time between the ACL and the Columbia Fireflies in 2023. Arronde repeated the Carolina League in 2024 and was 4-8 with a 2.94 ERA and 103 strikeouts with only 32 walks over 110-1/3 innings pitched. His WHIP last year was 1.02 and opponent hit just .205 against him.

LAST APPEARANCE: Arronde pitched in relief in game one of the doubleheader at Peoria on [April 5](#). He ran on a hit and two walks with two strikeouts over two innings for a no decision.

LAST START: Arronde had a no decision at Augusta on [August 28, 2024](#). He pitched five scoreless, hitless innings with a walk and a strikeout for a no decision.

VS. WISCONSIN: Arronde has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. He made two starts against the Carolina Mudcats, Milwaukee's Carolina League affiliate, in 2024. Arronde was 1-0 and allowed three runs – two earned – on six hits with three walks and seventeen strikeouts over twelve innings.

THIS DATE IN TIMBER RATTLERS HISTORY

April 9, 1995: The Rattlers lost 3-2 at Peoria. Manager Mike Goff and reserve catcher Dusty Wathan were ejected from the game in the middle of the first inning when Wathan was caught with chewing tobacco while warming up Joe Mathis in left field before the bottom of the first inning. A new rule was put in place at the time that called for the ejection of any player caught with tobacco during a game. The player's manager was also to be ejected.

April 9, 1998: The Timber Rattlers beat Rockford 3-2 in eleven innings in Wisconsin's home opener. Carlos Maldonado had a walk-off RBI single for the win.

April 9, 2003: Wisconsin finally opened their season after six straight postponements at home. Wisconsin split a doubleheader against Clinton with a walkoff, 2-1 win in game one on a Gary Harris walkoff single. The LumberKings won game two 5-2.

April 9, 2009: The Rattlers played their first game as an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers when they beat Quad Cities 2-1 at home. A sellout crowd of 5,487 were on hand to see Wisconsin rally from a 1-0 deficit with two runs in the bottom of the eighth.
