### ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Peoria Chiefs beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 6-2 at Dozer Park.](#)

The Chiefs had a 3-1 lead heading into the bottom of the fourth inning. They collected five straight singles to score three runs and take command with a 6-1 lead. Wisconsin was held to four hits in the game.

**OOPS! HE DID IT AGAIN:** Wisconsin leadoff hitter Dylan O'Rae was hit by a pitch in the first inning. O'Rae has reached base in the first inning in six consecutive games. Last night, O'Rae reached base twice and stole two bases, but did not score.

**TAKING THE LEAD:** The Timber Rattlers stole a run in the top of the second. Eduarqui Fernández stole second and the throw went into centerfield. The error allowed Jadhver Areinamo to jog home from third base with the go-ahead run.

**RUNNING WILD:** Wisconsin stole four more bases in five attempts last night. The Timber Rattlers have 39 stolen bases this season to lead the Midwest League in that category.

**PUTTING UP GOOSE EGGS:** Reliever Yerlin Rodriguez pitched a scoreless eighth inning with a walk and three strikeouts against the Chiefs last night. In six appearances this season, Rodriguez has allowed two hits and no runs over six innings.

**PUTTING THE BALL IN PLAY:** Wisconsin hitters struck out five times last night. Through sixteen games this season, the Rattlers offense has the fewest strikeouts in the Midwest League (114). Out of all the teams in Minor League Baseball, only the Fresno Grizzlies (112) of the California League have struck out fewer times than the Timber Rattlers.

**SOMETHING ABOUT THIS PLACE:** Wisconsin is 11-23 at Dozer Park since the Midwest League moved up to the High-A classification for the 2021 season. Dating back to the 2022 season, Wisconsin is 1-10 against the Chiefs at Dozer Park.

**ABOUT PEORIA:** The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels for 1983 and 1984 with a change to the Chiefs nickname for 1984 followed by an affiliation switch to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. Peoria became the Cardinals Midwest League affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his third year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, Yadier Molina, Nolan Gorman, and Victor Scott II.

**ABOUT THE CARDINALS:** St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

**PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES:** [MLB Pipeline](#) places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Luis Lara (#9), Luke Adams (#16), Dylan O'Rae (#21), Jadhver Areinamo (#23), and Patricio Aquino (#29). [MLB Pipeline](#) has nine active Peoria players on their list of Top 30 Cardinals prospects: Cooper Hjerpe (#6), Leonardo Bernal (#7), Won-Bin Cho (#9), Brycen Mautz (#20), Zach Levenson (#22), Pete Hansen (#26), Joshua Baez (#29), and William Sullivan (#30).

**THE CHIEFS SO FAR:** Peoria is 6-10 to start the season. The Chiefs avoided a six-game sweep at Quad Cities with a win on Sunday afternoon over the River Bandits at Modern Woodmen Park. Peoria's only home series prior to this one with Wisconsin was against Beloit from April 9 through April 14. The Chiefs were 4-2 in that series with the Sky Carp.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP MARK MANFREDI:** The Milwaukee Brewers selected Manfredi in the 9<sup>th</sup> round of the 2023 draft out of the University of Dayton.

**THE COLLEGE BEFORE COLLEGE:** Manfredi pitched two abbreviated seasons at Sinclair Community College in Dayton before moving to the University of Dayton. Manfredi was 2-1 with a 3.38 ERA in seven games – three starts – in his two seasons at Sinclair.

**RADIO FLYER:** Manfredi pitched two seasons at Dayton. He was 4-6 with a 4.42 ERA in 29 games – 24 starts – with 158 strikeouts over 138-1/3 innings pitched. Manfredi finished third in the Atlantic 10 in strikeouts for his senior season.

**SUMMER CATCH:** Manfredi made three starts for Wareham in the Cape Cod League prior to the 2023 draft. He had 16 strikeouts over 13 innings with a 2.08 ERA with three no decisions before signing with Milwaukee.

**PLAYOFF CALL:** Manfredi did not pitch as a professional in the regular season last year. However, he was the starting pitcher for the ACL Brewers in their semifinal playoff game against the ACL Rockies on August 24, 2023. He pitched a scoreless inning with a walk and three strikeouts.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** Manfredi had a no decision in four scoreless innings of relief against the Cedar Rapids Kernels at home on [April 18](#). He struck out eight with no walks and one hit in the game.

**LAST START:** Manfredi made his Timber Rattlers debut on [April 10](#) at South Bend. He allowed three runs – two earned – on five hits with four walks and five strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings.

**VS. PEORIA:** Manfredi has never faced the Chiefs prior to this evening. He has also never pitched against an affiliate of the St. Louis Cardinals.

## PEORIA STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP BRYCEN MAUTZ:** The St. Louis Cardinals selected Mautz in the second round of the 2022 draft out of the University of San Diego.

**STAY CLASSY, SAN DIEGO:** Mautz pitched three seasons at San Diego. He was 13-4 with a 4.37 ERA in 34 games – 21 starts in college. As a junior, Mautz was 10-2 with a 3.87 ERA and 129 strikeouts over 90-2/3 innings.

**NO. IT'S IOWA:** Mautz played for the Waterloo Bucks of the Northwoods League in 2021. He was 0-1 with three saves and a 2.08 ERA in twelve games – two starts. Mautz walked fifteen and struck out 29 over 30-1/3 innings in the Northwoods League.

**FLORIDA MAN:** Mautz did not pitch professionally in 2022. He was with the Palm Beach Cardinals in 2023 to start his pro career. Mautz was 4-9 with a 3.98 ERA and 115 strikeouts over 104 innings pitched.

**LAST START:** Mautz lost at Quad Cities in game two of a doubleheader on [April 17](#). He allowed six runs on nine hits with no walks and six strikeouts over four innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Mautz has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers before this morning. Today is also the first time he will face an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
