ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The West Michigan Whitecaps beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 1-0 at LMCU

<u>Ballpark.</u> Jake Holton broke a scoreless tie with a two-out, RBI single in the bottom of the ninth.

CHANGING LINEUPS: The Rattlers made two lineup changes and the Whitecaps made one lineup change prior to the game. Arbert Cipion and Ethan Murray were scratched from the Timber Rattlers lineup card for Terence Doston and Jose Acosta. Esney Chacon was a late scratch for Bryant Packard for the Whitecaps.

TOUGH NIGHT FOR THE OFFENSE: Wisconsin was held to four hits, drew no walks, and didn't have a runner reach second base against five West Michigan pitchers. Acosta had two singles to lead the hitters. However, he was erased on double plays each time.

ON THE MOUND: Antoine Kelly was the Wisconsin starter and worked three scoreless innings, walked one, struck out two, and allowed no hits. Joey Matulovich allowed three hits with three strikeouts over three scoreless innings. James Meeker allowed a leadoff single before retiring seven batters in a row to get to one out in the bottom of the ninth.

SO CLOSE: Meeker gave up a one-out double to Josh Crouch in the ninth. He got the second out on a ground out. However, Holton drove in Crouch with a single on the first pitch to win the game for West Michigan.

SUB-TWO: Last night's game was played in 1:59. It was the second Wisconsin game on this road trip to be played in under two hours. The game on July 6 at South Bend was played in 1:55.

PURE MICHIGAN: This series at West Michigan is the first time the Timber Rattlers have visited the Whitecaps in Michigan since July 11-13, 2018.

DÉJÀ VU: Wisconsin opened that 2018 series at West Michigan with back-to-back walkoff losses. The Whitecaps beat the Rattlers 3-2 on July 11 on a base-loaded walk in the bottom of the tenth. The second game of that series was a 4-3 loss on a sacrifice fly in the bottom of the ninth.

ABOUT WEST MICHIGAN: The West Michigan Whitecaps joined the Midwest League in 1994 when the Madison Muskies moved to Grand Rapids, Michigan following the 1993 season. The Whitecaps started play in the league as an affiliate of the Oakland Athletics. They became Low-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers for the 1997 season. The Whitecaps won six Midwest League Pennants (1996, 1998, 2004, 2006, 2007, and 2015) before getting the bump up to the High-A Affiliate of the Tigers going into the 2021 season. Notable former Whitecaps include Nick Castellanos, Joel Zumaya, Fernando Rodney, Brandon Inge, and Cameron Maybin.

ABOUT THE TIGERS: Detroit has been affiliated with the Whitecaps since 1997. The Tigers had just one other stint in the Midwest League prior to their current partnership. They were with the Clinton Pilots from 1971 through 1975.

THE SEASON SO FAR: West Michigan finished the first half 31-35 in fourth place in the Eastern Division. They are coming into this series with Wisconsin after going 5-1 in a six-game series at Dayton. The Whitecaps are the first-place team in the Eastern Division and have a two-game lead over Great Lakes, the first half champions in the Eastern Division

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Tyler Black (#7), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), and Zavier Warren (#17). Carlos Rodríguez (#21) is on the Wisconsin injured list. MLB Pipeline has five members of the Whitecaps roster on their list of Top 30 Prospects in the Detroit system: Ty Madden (#5), Dylan Smith (#8), Colt Keith (#12), Keider Montero (#25), and Brant Hurter (#29).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ISRAEL PUELLO: Acquired by Milwaukee as a player to be named later from in a trade that sent David Phelps to the Philadelphia Phillies on August 31, 2020. Puello, Juan Geraldo, and Brandon Ramey were announced at the PTBNL on September 18, 2020.

 $\mbox{\bf ORIGIN STORY:}$ Puello was signed by the Phillies out of the Dominican Republic on July 2, 2017.

FIGHTIN' PHIL: Puello pitched two seasons (2018 and 2019) for the Phillies White affiliate in the Dominican Summer League. He went 4-6 with a 4.52 ERA in fourteen starts in 2018 and 2-1 with a 1.92 ERA in fifteen starts in 2019. Puello had 143 strikeouts over 131-1/3 innings pitched. Puello was named a DSL All-Star in 2019.

WHAT'S BREWING? Puello was 1-4 with a 4.94 ERA in ten starts for the Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League in 2021. He walked nine and struck out 37 over 27-1/3 innings pitched.

SWEET CAROLINA: Puello was 3-7 in thirteen games – six starts – with a 5.51 ERA and 61 strikeouts over 49 innings pitched for the Carolina Mudcats before joining the Timber Rattlers on June 28. Puello was 0-2 in four games – two starts in June...BUT, he had a 3.38 ERA, opponents were hitting just .192 against him, and he had sixteen strikeouts over sixteen innings in June.

LAST START: Puello <u>lost at South Bend on July 6</u>. He allowed one run on three hits with a walk and four strikeouts over seven innings. The Timber Rattlers were shutout in the 3-0 loss to the Cubs.

VS. WEST MICHIGAN: Puello has never faced the Whitecaps prior to this afternoon. Today is the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Detroit Tigers since July 1, 2019 when he lost to the Tigers-1 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League as a member of the Phillies organization. He allowed two runs on six hits with five strikeouts over five innings in that game

WEST MICHIGAN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

LHP MATT WALKER: The Tigers selected Walker in the thirteenth round of the 2019 draft out of Illinois State University.

RED BIRD: Walker pitched three seasons at Illinois State. He went 12-13 in 50 games – 37 starts – with 176 strikeouts and a 5.42 ERA in 186 innings pitched in his collegiate career.

WE'RE GOING TO REGIONALS: Walker pitched a complete game and picked up the win over the Louisville Cardinals for Illinois State in an NCAA Regional Game on June 1, 2019. He allowed two runs on two hits with two walks and seven strikeouts in the game.

ABBREVIATED DEBUT: Walker made one relief appearance for the Connecticut Defenders in the New York-Penn League after signing with the Tigers. He did not pitch as a pro again until 2021.

SPENDING TIME IN FLORIDA: Walker was 4-1 in 25 games – four starts – for the Lakeland Flying Tigers last season. He had a 4.09 ERA, walked 31 and struck out 62 in 61-2/3 innings. Walker started the 2022 season with the Whitecaps before being sent back to Lakeland on April 23. He was 1-0 in fourteen games – one start – with a 3.52 ERA and 20 strikeouts over 23 innings with Lakeland before earning his way back to West Michigan on June 30.

LAST START: Walker <u>lost at Dayton in game two of a doubleheader on July 7</u>. He allowed three runs on five hits with two homers, three walks, and four strikeouts over three innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Walker has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this afternoon. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
