ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Lansing Lugnuts beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 4-3 at Neuroscience Group Field. Lansing took a 3-0 lead in the top of the fourth inning. Wisconsin chipped away with single runs in the fourth and fifth innings. Jadher Areinamo tied the game in the bottom of the eighth with a homer. However, the Lugnuts scored a run on a balk in the top of the ninth and held off the Rattlers in the bottom of the ninth for their fourth win in a row.

HOME RUN DERBY: There were four homers in last night's game. Nate Nankil hit a two-run home run for Lansing in the top of the fourth. Darlyn Montero made it back-to-back homers for the 3-0 lead. In the bottom of the fourth, Eduardo Garcia hit his first home run of the year to get the Rattlers on the scoreboard. Areinamo hit his second homer of the game in the eighth.

THE NINTH CIRCLE: Clark Elliott reached on a windblown triple to start the top of the ninth. A balk by Wisconsin pitcher Jeferson Figueroa allowed Elliott to score the go-ahead run. In the bottom of the ninth, Wisconsin loaded the bases but could not score. The loss was the third in a row for the Rattlers.

HEATING UP: Areinamo was 2-for-4 with a walk last night to extend his current hitting streak to seven games. He is 9-for-28 (.321) during the streak.

HE GETS ON BASE: Matt Wood walked in the eighth inning for the Rattlers. Wood is on an eight-game onbase streak, reaching in all eight of his games played this season. He is 6-for-26 with seven walks and two hit by pitch for an on-base percentage of .429.

SPARK PLUG: Tayden Hall hit in Wisconsin's lead-off spot for the fourth game in a row yesterday. He had a pair of singles. In those four games at the top spot in the order, Hall has reached base ten times and scored

ABOUT THE LANSING LUGNUTS: The Lugnuts began their existence as the Lafayette (IN) Chiefs of the Mississippi-Ohio Valley League in 1955. Lafayette became the Red Sox in 1956 and as the Mississippi-Ohio Valley League became the Midwest League. The franchise moved Waterloo, Iowa in 1958 and remained there as the Hawks, Royals, Indians, and Diamonds until the end of the 1993 season. New ownership bought the team and moved them to Springfield, Illinois for two seasons before finally locating the team in Lansing, Michigan in 1996. Since they started in Lansing, the Lugnuts were affiliated with the Kansas City Royals (1996-1998), the Chicago Cubs (1999-2004), the Toronto Blue Jays (2005-2019), and the Athletics. The Lugnuts won Midwest League titles in 1997 and 2003. Notable Lansing alumni include Kevin Appier, Carlos Beltrán, Rich Hill, Mark Prior, Carlos Zambrano, Bo Bichette, Vladimir Guerrero Jr, Danny Janssen, Noah Syndergaard, and Rowdy Tellez.

ABOUT THE ATHLETICS: The Athletics have been on and off in the Midwest League since the 1968 season. They were in Burlington from 1968 through 1974 before leaving the league. The A's returned to the Midwest League in 1982 to be the parent club of the Madison Muskies and stayed in Madison through 1993. Their affiliation stayed with the franchise after its move to West Michigan in 1994. The Athletics left the league again after the 1997 season only to return with Kane County as their affiliate from 2003 through 2010. From there, they went to Burlington (2011-2012), Beloit (2013-2019), and now Lansing since 2021.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Bishop Letson (#14), Blake Burke (#16), Jadher Areinamo (#23), Juan Baez (#26), and Manuel Rodriguez (#30). MLB Pipeline has six Athletics prospects listed in their Top 30: Tommy White (#7), Steven Echavarria (#12), Gage Jump (#14), Ryan Lasko (#19), Rodney Green Jr (#20), and Nate Nankil (#30). Joshua Kuroda-Grauer (#10) is currently on Lansing's IL.

## PITCHING MATCHUP

#### WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER (GAME ONE):

RHP BRANDON WOODRUFF: Selected by Milwaukee in the eleventh round of the 2014 draft out of Mississippi State.

**ON ASSIGNMENT:** Woodruff is making his third rehab start for the Timber Rattlers. He made two starts for Wisconsin in July, 2023. He is currently on a 30-day rehabilitation assignment from the Brewers as he works his way back from shoulder surgery in October, 2023.

THREE YEARS AT STATE: Woodruff pitched three seasons with Mississippi State and was 3-6 with a 4.70 ERA and 81 strikeouts over 90 innings pitched in 34 games – eighteen starts – in college.

**SKIPPED US:** Woodruff started his professional career in the Pioneer League with the Helena Brewers in 2014 and moved to Brevard County in the Florida State League in 2015 without playing for the Timber Rattlers.

**MAKING MOVES:** Woodruff went 4-1 with a 1.83 ERA in Brevard County before a promotion to Biloxi in the Southern League where he went 10-8 with 124 strikeouts and a 3.01 ERA in 113-2/3 innings during the 2016 season.

**MLB DEBUT:** Woodruff started the 2017 season with Colorado Springs in Triple-A before making his Major League debut with the <u>Brewers on August 4. against the Tampa Bay Rays</u>. Woodruff was the winning pitcher in that debut with six strikeouts over 6-1/3 scoreless innings.

**LAST BREWERS START:** Woodruff had a no decision at Miami on September 23, 2023. He allowed four runs on six hit with two walks and six strikeouts over five innings.

**LAST START:** Woodruff was the starter for the Nashville Sounds on April 12 in a game against the Memphis Redbirds. He allowed two runs on four hits with two walks and five strikeouts for a no decision. That was his first regular-season, in-game action since the start against the Marlins in 2023.

#### LANSING STARTING PITCHER (GAME ONE):

**LHP GAGE JUMP:** The Athletics selected Jump in in Competitive Balance Round-B with the 73<sup>rd</sup> overall pick in the 2024 draft out of LSU. Jump is the #14 prospect in the Athletics system according to both MLB Pipeline and *Baseball America*.

NO TO SAN DIEGO: The Padres picked Jump in the eighteenth round of the 2021 draft out of JSerra Catholic High School in San Juan Capistrano, California. He elected to go to UCLA.

**JUMP AROUND:** Jump pitched at UCLA in 2022 and was 1-1 with two saves and a 3.86 ERA in seven games – three starts. He underwent Tommy John Surgery during the summer of 2022, missed the 2023 season and transferred to LSU for the 2024 season. At LSU, Jump went 6-2 with a save and a 3.47 ERA in seventeen games – fifteen starts. He walked 33 and struck out 123 in 99-1/3 innings during his college career. Jump did not pitch professionally in 2024.

**LAST START:** Jump had a no decision against Great Lakes at home on <u>April 11</u>. He allowed two runs on four hits with three walks and six strikeouts over four innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Jump has never faced Wisconsin prior to this evening. Today is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.

#### **WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER (GAME TWO):**

RHP CHANDLER WELCH: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Welch in the sixth round of the 2024 draft out of Tulane University.

CATCH A GREEN WAVE: Welch pitched three seasons at Tulane. He was 15-13 with three saves and a 5.42 ERA in 67 games – 29 starts in college. Welch had 204 strikeouts over 199-1/3 innings with Tulane. As a junior – his final season of college baseball, Welch was 7-4 with a 4.65 ERA. In his final collegiate start, Welch was the starting pitcher for Tulane against Oregon State in the NCAA Regional at Corvallis on May 31, 2024. He allowed six runs on seven hits with two walks and a strikeout over four innings against the Beavers

**CHAMPIONS:** Tulane won the AAC Conference Tournament in Welch's sophomore and junior seasons.

**LET'S GET IT STARTED:** Milwaukee assigned Welch to Carolina on September 8, 2024 and he made his pro debut for the Mudcats against Delmarva. He was transferred to Wisconsin and made a relief appearance in the playoffs against Lake County.

**LAST START:** Welch had a no decision at Quad Cities on April 12. He allowed a run on three hits with no walks and seven strikeouts over six innings.

**VS. LANSING:** Welch has never faced the Lugnuts prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Athletics.

#### LANSING STARTING PITCHER:

RHP STEVEN ECHAVARRIA: The Athletics selected Echavarria in the third round of the 2023 draft out of Milburn (NJ) High School.

STOMP ON THE GATOR: Echavarria had a commitment to the University of Florida when the Athletics drafted him. He signed with the A's but did not pitch professionally in 2023. Heading into this season both MLB Pipeline and Baseball America has him rated as the #12 prospect in the A's system.

**STOCK FOOTAGE:** Echavarria made his pro debut with Stockton last season. He made nineteen starts and was 0-5 with a 6.55 ERA. He walked 36 and struck out 59 in 57-2/3 innings.

**LAST START:** Echevarria had a no decision against Great Lakes at home on <u>April 12</u>. He allowed three runs – one earned – on four hits with two walks and five strikeouts over 3-1/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Echavarria has never faced Wisconsin prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
