- LAST TIME OUT - WISCONSIN 5, CEDAR RAPIDS 3 / CEDAR RAPIDS 8, WISCONSIN 2** : Cedar Rapids and Wisconsin split the series-opening double-header Wednesday afternoon. After the Timber Rattlers came away with a 5-3 win in game one, Cedar Rapids took an 8-2 win in game two. Zebby Matthews picked up his second win in as many starts in game two, going 5.0 innings, allowing just two runs on five hits. Gabriel Gonzalez posted his first three-hit game of the season going 3-3 2 2B, 2 R and 2 RBI. Ruble Cespedes continued his hot start to the season collecting two more doubles and three more RBI in the win. The victory snapped the five-game losing streak to the Timber Rattlers at Neuroscience Group Field.
- WELCOME TO WISCONSIN**: Cedar Rapids and Wisconsin open up the first and only trip for the Kernels to Appleton in 2024. The Timber Rattlers where the only team the CR did not have a winning record against last season (12-12), among teams they played in more than one set (West Michigan 3-3). The Kernels were also 4-8 in Appleton last season losing both series 4-2 including losing the final four games.
- WHAT'S AT STAKE**: A win would improve the Kernels over .500 for the first time this season at 6-5 on the year, give the Kernels a 2-1 advantage in the series against Wisconsin and 2-0 on Thursdays.
- RAKIN RUBEL**: Infielder Rubel Cespedes was named Midwest League Player of the Week for the first full week of the season. Cespedes 12-24 (.500) in the series vs Dayton with 3 HR, 2 2B, 11 RBI, and 5 R. Through the first eight games of the season, Cespedes leads the Midwest League in HR (3), RBI (11), SLG% (.846), OPS (1.346) and total bases (22). His seven RBI in the Kernels' first win of the season were the second most in a CR game since 2016 and since Christian Encarnacion-Stand collected 9 on 4/8/22.
- OH WISCONSIN**: After dropping the first two games of the season in Beloit, the Kernels struggles in Wisconsin continue. Cedar Rapids went 14-3-3 in series last season, and all 3 series losses came in Wisconsin. The Kernels went 3-6 in Beloit last season and a combined 4-8 in the two series against Wisconsin in Appleton. Since the start of 2023 CR is 8-17 (.320) in their games in the state of Wisconsin while going 79-38 (.675) in every other state.
- FINALLY CHAMPIONS**: For the first time in 29 years, Cedar Rapids lifted the Midwest League championship trophy in 2023. The Kernels finished the regular season with an 82-50 record, their best mark since 2013 and the best record in all of Minor League baseball. The Kernels won both first and second-half West division titles, clinching a postseason birth for the 10th consecutive season, every year as a Twins affiliate. In the postseason, the Kernels fell behind Peoria 1-0 in the West Division championship series, but after wins in games two and three, the Kernels advanced to the Midwest League Championship series for the second time in three years. Cedar Rapids came from behind with a five-run ninth inning to clinch game one on the road against Great Lakes before winning a decisive game three to clinch the title at home three days later.
- MR. 300**: Kernels' manager Brian Dinkelman collected his 300th career win on the bench with the Kernels in CR's final win of the regular season in 2023. Dinkelman returns to the helm of Cedar Rapids in 2024 with a career record of 300-223 in his five years, four seasons. With now 305 career wins, Dinkelman is 11 shy of Jake Mauer's 316 for the most wins as the Kernels manager since Cedar Rapids became a Twins affiliate in 2013.
- STARS OF TOMORROW**: 9 of the Twins' top 30 prospects start on the 2024 Kernels opening day roster: Gabriel Gonzalez (no. 4 Twins, 76 MLB, Twins top right-handed hitting prospect), RHP C.J. Culpepper (8), INF Luke Keaschall (9), INF Danny De Andrade (14), Connor Prielipp (17), RHP Andrew Morris (18), RHP Zebby Matthews (20), C Ricardo Olivar (22), RHP Darren Bowen (29).
