**ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS:** The current franchise began its existence in 1949 as the Cedar Rapids Rockets, an unaffiliated team in the Central Association. They moved to the Three-I League as the Cedar Rapids Indians, an affiliate of Cleveland in 1950. They were affiliated with the Milwaukee Braves from 1954 through 1962. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins from 2013 through 2023, including a 2023 Midwest League Championship. That streak ended last year when the Kernels missed the playoffs. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, and Milwaukee Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook. Hall of Famers John McGraw (1891 Canaries), Lou Boudreau (1938 Raiders), Ted Simmons (1967 Cardinals), and Trevor Hoffman (1991 Reds) played for earlier pro teams in Cedar Rapids.

**ABOUT THE TWINS:** Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP MANUEL RODRIGUEZ:** The Milwaukee Brewers signed Rodriguez as an International Free Agent out of Mexico on April 5, 2022.

**WHIRLWIND:** Rodriguez had a very busy 2022. After signing with Milwaukee in April, he began his professional career in the Dominican Summer League in June and went 1-5 with a 4.54 ERA in twelve games – five starts. Later in the year he pitched for Mexico in the U-18 World Cup of Baseball. Rodriguez went 1-1 in the tournament with a win over Australia and a loss to the Netherlands.

**PLAYOFF EXPERIENCE:** Rodriguez has pitched in the postseason in each of the last two seasons. He made a relief appearance for the ACL Brewers in the Arizona Complex League Semifinal Game in 2023 and was the starter in Game Two of the Carolina League Playoffs for the Mudcats against Fredericksburg.

**AMERICAN RATING:** *Baseball America* lists Rodriguez as the #25 prospect in the Milwaukee System in their 2025 *Prospect Handbook*.

**LAST START:** Rodriguez pitched Game Two of the Carolina League playoff series against Fredericksburg on [September 12, 2024](#). He allowed a run on one hit with no walks and three strikeouts over two innings for a no decision.

**VS. CEDAR RAPIDS:** Rodriguez has never faced the Kernels prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Minnesota Twins.

## CEDAR RAPIDS STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP CHARLEE SOTO:** The Minnesota Twins selected Soto in Competitive Balance Round-A with the 34<sup>th</sup> pick of the 2023 draft out of Reborn Christian High School in Kissimmee, Florida.

**BREAKING OUT:** Soto made his professional debut in the 2024 Spring Breakout Game for the team of Twins prospects.

**MUSSEL MAN:** Soto pitched in Fort Myers (Florida State League) last season. He was 1-7 with a 5.23 ERA in 21 games – 20 starts. Soto struck out 87 in 74 innings last season.

**RATED TWICE:** MLB Pipeline has Soto as the #8 prospect in the Twins organization. *Baseball America* ranks Soto at #9 in their 2025 *Prospect Handbook*.

**LAST START:** DeLucia had a no decision against Dayton at home in Game Two of the East Finals on [September 12](#). He allowed four runs – three earned – on six hits with a walk and five strikeouts over 4-1/3 innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Soto has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
