ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Indianapolis Indians rallied for four runs in the fifth inning, headlined by a two-run shot from Billy Cook, and held the Toledo Mud Hens offense at bay as they took Game 1 of their six-game set at Victory Field, 7-1. The Indians' big inning broke a scoreless tie between the two clubs. Ronny Simon and Ji Hwan Bae each singled and advanced to scoring position before Nick Solak drove them both in with a single of his own, chasing Toledo starter Wilkel Hernandez. Billy Cook capped the inning and doubled the lead with a two-run home run, his second homer in as many games. Toledo and Indy traded runs in the sixth. Justyn-Henry Malloy provided the lone spark for the Mud Hens with a lead-off home run in Toledo's half. Jared Triolo responded with a double to lead off Indy's half of the inning and moved to third on a line out, setting up Tsung-Che Cheng to pad Indy's lead with a sacrifice fly. Bae cushioned Indy's advantage and capped the scoring with his fourth hit of the day, a two-RBI double, in the eighth. Thomas Harrington fanned seven Mud Hens across 5.2 one-run innings. He improved to 3-0 with a 2.75 ERA and a 1.17 WHIP in four July starts. Randy Labaut, Ryan Borucki and Kyle Nicolas followed out of the bullpen, holding the Mud Hens to one hit, no runs and no walks across the final 3.2 frames.

WINDIANAPOLIS: With last night's win, the Indians improved to 39-13 at Victory Field. They have won 11 of their last 13 games played at home since June 27 and 29 of their last 36 since May 11. On the season, Indianapolis is pacing all full-season minor league clubs in wins and winning percentage (.750). Indy's home winning percentage is its highest to this point in the season since at least 2005, surpassing a .692 clip (36-16) through July 22, 2012. Indianapolis' highest winning percentage in a full season in the Victory Field era (since 1996) is .681 (49-23) in 1997. Indy has not lost more than three consecutive games this season, joining Durham as the only Triple-A clubs to have not done so on the campaign. The Indians have not completed a season without losing three or more games in a row since 2006, when they dropped three straight games seven times that season, compared to two instances for the 2025 Indians. Since at least 2005, the Indians have not had a season where they have suffered two or fewer three-plus game losing streaks.

MAGIC NUMBERS: The Indians seven-run outburst in last night's win moved their record when they score seven or more runs to 27-1. That mark is good for the third-highest winning percentage among Triple-A teams this season. Indy has had 16 such instances at home this season and has not dropped a game. Additionally, when the Indians score four or more runs in a game, they are 47-12, which places them at second in Triple-A with a .797 winning percentage.

BAEWATCH: Ji Hwan Bae notched four hits, including a double, to go with two RBI in last night's contest. It was Bae's first four-hit game since May 18, 2024, also vs. Toledo. Bae has reached base safely in 36 of 41 games on the campaign and in 14 of his last 16 since June 28. Since returning from the 7-day injured list on June 27, he is hitting .359 (23-for-64) with 13 runs, two doubles, three triples, 11 RBI, nine walks, seven stolen bases and a .911 OPS in 17 games. He has picked up multiple hits in seven games and has driven in at least one or more run in nine since returning. Additionally, Bae has not made an error this season, converting on all 76 chances between the three outfield positions.

SOLAK ECLIPSE: Nick Solak notched his third multi-hit game in the last four contests last night, going 2-for-5 with a run scored and two RBI. He has also recorded an RBI in each of his last four games since July 13 vs. Gwinnett. Solak extended his team-best on-base streak to 29 games since June 10, which is the third-longest active run in Triple-A. His on-base stretch is the longest by an Indian in a single season since Adam Frazier also reached base in 29 straight from May 9-June 8, 2016. Across his streak, Solak is hitting .351 (39-for-111) with 23 runs, six doubles, three home runs, 17 RBI, 15 walks, two stolen bases and a .924 OPS. He has hit safely in 26 of those 29 games, including a team-high tying 14-game hitting streak from June 12 (1-27). On the season, Solak owns the highest batting average (.367, 87-for-237) of qualified full-season minor league hitters while ranking fourth in on-base percentage (.437) and eighth in OPS (.994).

LET BILLY COOK: Billy Cook put an exclamation point on Indy's fifth inning with a two-run blast, his second home run in as many games and his fourth in his last six played since July 12 vs. Gwinnett, which is tied for the third most in Triple-A in that span. Cook did not hit his first home run of the season until June 24 vs. Omaha. Since then, he has slugged six homers, which is tied for the sixth most in the International League.

BUCCO BORUCKI: LHP Ryan Borucki had his rehab assignment transferred from Low-A Bradenton to Indianapolis on Friday last week. He made one rehab appearance with Bradenton on July 8, tossing a scoreless inning with one strikeout before being transferred to Indianapolis. Borucki has made 81 appearances with Pittsburgh since signing as a minor league free agent on May 9, 2023. In those appearances, he is 5-3 with a 4.09 ERA (35er/77.0ip) and a 1.04 WHIP. In 2023, the southpaw set the record for the lowest WHIP (0.74) of any Pirates pitcher with at least 40.0 innings pitched in a season. With the Pirates in 2025, he has held left-handed hitters to the lowest batting average (.087, 4-for-46) of any major league pitcher (min. 40 AB against lefties), before hitting the 15-day IL on June 21 with low back inflammation. In 24 appearances with Indy, he has logged a 2.22 ERA (6er/24.1ip) with 32 strikeouts and a 1.07 WHIP. 21 of his appearances have been scoreless, including the four he has made in his current rehab stint.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians and Toledo Mud Hens continue their six-game set at Victory Field at 7:05 PM tonight. Indy has won its last six games against Toledo at Victory Field, marking its longest winning streak against the Mud Hens at home since May 19-June 20, 2017, when they also won six straight. With a win, the Indians would establish their second-longest winning streak against the Mud Hens at Victory Field since at least 2005, only trailing an 11-game run from June 27, 2012-May 12, 2013. RHP Sean Sullivan takes the mound for Indy for his seventh appearance (fifth start) of the season. In his four starts with the Indians this season, he has a 0-1 record with a 3.00 ERA and a 1.17 WHIP. This will be his first career appearance against the Mud Hens. He will be opposed by southpaw Devin Smeltzer, who will be making his second start of the season after signing a minor league contract with the Detroit Tigers on July 8. Smeltzer has made four appearances (one start) against the Indians in his career to the tune of a 1-1 record with a 5.19 ERA (5er/8.2ip). In his sole start against Indy, on April 15, 2022, he tossed 5.0 scoreless innings while allowing three hits and fanning three.

ON THIS DATE IN 2010: Designated hitter Brandon Moss drove in six runs in the Tribe's 17-11 win vs. Charlotte to set a new career high and continue his bid to be the International League leader in RBI. In the seven-spot in the lineup, Moss went 3-for-6 with a double and two home runs (his 15th and 16th of the year). Moss ended the season with a league-leading 96 RBI and paced the Indians with 133 hits, 32 doubles, 22 home runs, 235 total bases and 73 runs scored.
