## ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Beloit Sky Carp 5-0 at ABC Supply Stadium.](#)

Joseph Hernandez, Steven Cruz, and Tanner Shears combined on the two-hit shutout. Robert Moore and Matt Wood each had three hits for Wisconsin. Eric Brown Jr and Moore both had two RBI. The win was the fifth in a row for the Timber Rattlers.

**THE SOUND OF SILENCE:** The Sky Carp didn't get their first hit until a lead-off, infield single in the eighth inning. Hernandez walked two, hit a batter, and struck out four over 3-1/3 innings. Cruz allowed the first Beloit hit, walked four, and struck out two over 4-2/3 innings to earn his sixth win of the season. Shears allowed a lead-off double and walked two with two strikeouts in a scoreless ninth. Wisconsin pitchers have allowed two unearned runs in the first three games of this series.

**THE HEIST:** Wisconsin stole five bases last night. Wood, Moore, and Brock Wilken each had one. Eduarqui Fernández stole two bases in the sixth inning.

**BUILDING THE LEAD:** The Rattlers took a 1-0 lead on an RBI grounder by Hendry Mendez in the first inning. Brown had two-out, RBI singles in the second and fourth inning. Moore added a two-out, RBI single in the fourth and an RBI fielder's choice in the sixth for the final run of the game.

**FIVE-BY-FIVE:** The Timber Rattlers have won five games in a row for the first time this season. Wisconsin had two six-game winning streaks in 2022. Wisconsin has also clawed their way back above the .500 mark in the second half for the first time since they were 20-19 on August 10.

**ABOUT BELOIT:** The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's third season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Billy Gardner Jr is in his first season as the manager of the Sky Carp.

**ABOUT THE MARLINS:** The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

## WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP ALEXANDER CORNIELLE:** Milwaukee signed Cornielle as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on June 15, 2019.

**FAST DEBUT:** Cornielle made his professional debut with one inning of relief against the Cubs #2 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League on August 2, 2019. He allowed one run on no hits with two walks in one inning. Cornielle made three appearances in the DSL in 2019 with no record and one run allowed over four innings.

**HIT PLAY:** Cornielle started the 2021 season with the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and was 4-2 in nine games – four starts – with a 4.64 ERA and 50 strikeouts over 33 innings pitched. He was called up to Carolina at the end of the season and was 0-1 in two starts with ten strikeouts in eight innings.

**WEEKLY AWARD:** Cornielle was named the ACL's Pitcher of the Week on September 6, 2021 after his performance against the White Sox on August 31, 2021. He allowed one run on one hit and two walks with six strikeouts over five innings in the game.

**FEELING 2022:** Cornielle was 9-7 in 22 games – 19 starts – with a 3.19 ERA and 124 strikeouts over 101-2/3 innings pitched for the Carolina Mudcats this season before joining the Timber Rattlers on August 23. He was second in the Carolina League in strikeouts and third in the Carolina League in ERA before his promotion to Wisconsin. Cornielle was 1-0 in three starts with Wisconsin and allowed four runs with six walks and 21 strikeouts over 17-1/3 innings pitched.

**LAST START:** Cornielle pitched five scoreless innings against Quad Cities at home on [August 24](#). He allowed two hits, walked two, and struck out seven. Cornielle left the game with a 2-0 lead, but the River Bandits rallied to beat Wisconsin 3-2.

**VS. БЕЛОИТ (2023):** Cornielle has no record in three home starts – [April 29](#), [July 4](#), and [July 9](#) – against the Sky Carp this season. He has allowed five runs on eleven hits with three walks and fifteen strikeouts in 13-2/3 innings pitched. Wisconsin has won all three games that Cornielle has started against Beloit.

## БЕЛОИТ SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP CADE GIBSON:** Selected in the tenth round of the 2022 draft by the Marlins out of Louisiana Tech.

**TECHNICALLY SPEAKING:** Gibson was 10-8 with a 5.57 ERA in 42 games – 24 starts – in two seasons at Louisiana Tech. He struck out 159 over 156-2/3 innings pitched in his career. In his final season of college, Gibson went 6-5 with a save and a 4.87 ERA in nineteen games – thirteen starts. Gibson also had 93 strikeouts with nineteen walks in 85 innings in his final season at Louisiana Tech.

**GETTING COMPLEX:** Gibson started his pro career with the Florida Complex League affiliate of the Marlins and allowed one run on four hits with ten strikeouts over seven innings in four games – one start – for no record. He moved up the Florida State League and Jupiter where he was 1-0 in four relief appearances with ten strikeouts over 7-2/3 scoreless innings.

**JUPITER RISING:** Gibson started the 2023 season in Jupiter and was 2-3 with a 3.12 ERA in seven games – six starts. He walked ten and struck out 33 in 34-2/3 innings pitched. Gibson was promoted to Beloit on May 20.

**LAST START:** Gibson picked up the win against Lake County at home on [August 25](#). He allowed one run on five hits with a walk and five strikeouts over seven innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Gibson made the start for a no decision at Neuroscience Group Field on [July 9](#). He allowed three runs on eight hits with three walks and three strikeouts over six innings in the game. Joe Gray Jr homered off Gibson in the first inning on July 9. That game was the first time Gibson faced the Timber Rattlers and the first time he pitched against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
