INDY BITS

ABOUT MONDAY: A first-inning RBI groundout by Nick Yorke and second-inning RBI infield single by Billy Cook were the decisive runs in the Indianapolis Indians 2-1 win over the Nashville Sounds on Monday night at Victory Field. The Indians offense struck early, posting a run in each of the first two innings against Nashville right-hander Jacob Misiorowski, handing him his first loss of the campaign. Making his Triple-A debut, right-hander Po-Yu Chen shined to blank Nashville across 5.0 frames, allowing just three hits and two walks with four strikeouts. Dauri Moreta, Peter Strzelecki and Burch Smith each tossed 1.0 scoreless innings to bridge the gap to the ninth. After allowing a run on an RBI single by Freddy Zamora, Kyle Nicolas (S, 1) stranded the bases loaded in the ninth inning for his first save of the campaign. Yorke, Cook and Liover Peguero each recorded multiple hits in the contest to help lead Indy's offense.

VICTORY FIELD (LITERALLY): With Monday's win, the Indians extended their home winning streak to eight games and improved to 18-6 at home on the campaign. Indy's .750 home winning percentage is the highest of any Triple-A team this season and is tied for the fourth highest of any full-season Minor League team. The Indians' winning percentage at home this season is the highest through the team's first 50 games of the season since 2021, when the Indians had a .762 winning percentage (16-5) at home through their first 50 games.

HAVE A DEBUT, PO-YU: Po-Yu Chen was called up from Double-A Altoona to start in place of Braxton Ashcraft on Monday and excelled in his Triple-A debut. Chen tossed 5.0 scoreless innings, allowing three hits, two walks and striking out four. The 23-year-old Taiwan native joined Bubba Chandler on Aug. 9, 2024, at Nashville (7.0ip, 2h, 0r) and Quinn Priester on Sept. 21, 2022, vs. St. Paul (5.0ip, 2h, 0r) as the only Indians starters to toss 5.0 scoreless innings with three hits or fewer allowed

PITCHER'S DUEL: The 2-1 contest on Monday showcased both Indianapolis' and Nashville's stellar pitching staffs. In May, Indians pitchers lead Triple-A staffs in WHIP (1.20), opponent's batting average (.217), strikeouts (235) and strikeouts per nine innings (11.05). They also rank second in ERA (3.29, 70er/191.1ip), only trailing Nashville's mark of 3.14 (67er/19.2.0ip) in the month. Additionally, they've allowed the fewsh this (152) and are tied for the fourth-fewest walks (77) in May. Indians starters have allowed two or fewer runs in 14 of 23 starts and lead Triple-A clubs with 134 strikeouts in the month. Meanwhile, Indy's bullpen has a 2.40 ERA (23er/86.1ip) with a 1.09 WHIP and a .203 opponent's batting average in May, all of which lead Triple-A teams. On the flip side, Nashville's staff has been dominant all season, leading Triple-A pitching staffs with a 3.12 ERA (153er/441.2ip) and a .645 opponent's OPS and holding the second-lowest WHIP (1.24) of all teams. Nashville's bullpen has pitched to a Triple-A leading 3.03 ERA (70er/207.2ip) so far this season, far surpassing Jacksonville's 3.58 ERA (98er/246.1ip), which is the second-lowest

NEW YORK(E) STATE OF MIND: Nick Yorke tallied two hits on Monday to push his active hitting-streak to six games. Across his hitting streak, Yorke is hitting .389 (7for-18) with a .950 OPS. Yorke has also hit safely in 18 of 20 games in May, picking up multiple hits in six games and multiple RBI in four of those contests. In the month, the 2020 first-round pick by the Boston Red Sox is hitting .324 (24-for-74) with nine runs scored, two doubles, two homers, nine RBI and five stolen bases. Additionally, Yorke has recorded a hit in all seven career games he has played against the Sounds, leading Nashville opponents since the beginning of 2024 (min. 20 PA) in batting average (.435, 10-for-23) and on-base percentage (.500).

WHO COOKED HERE: Billy Cook picked up two hits on Monday to extend his active-hitting streak to four games dating back to May 23, across which he's hitting .357 (5-for-14) with a .828 OPS. Cook has started each of his last three games in the lead-off spot since May 24 and has batted leadoff in six games this season, recording a hit in each contest and reaching base safely multiple times in five of six. While leading off this season, Cook is hitting .350 (7-for-20) with two doubles and a .950 OPS. Similarly to Yorke, Cook has also hit well against the Sounds since his Triple-A debut in 2024, totaling a .298 batting average (14-for-47) while ranking third among opponents with at least 50 plate appearances in OPS (.996).

BRAXTON IN THE BIGS: Braxton Ashcraft was recalled by Pittsburgh on Monday and made his Major League debut in relief at Arizona the same night. Ashcraft allowed three baserunners across 3.0 scoreless innings to finish the game for the Pirates and punched out Tim Tawa, the first batter he faced, to earn his first Major League strikeout. Ashcraft is the fourth former Indianapolis Indian to make his debut with Pittsburgh this season, joining Thomas Harrington, Tsung-Che Cheng and Matt

TWO BUCCOS ABOARD: The Indians roster boasts two major league rehabbers in Nick Gonzales and Dauri Moreta. Gonzales was placed on the 10-day injured list on March 28 with a non-displaced left ankle fracture sustained after hitting a two-run home run in the sixth inning on Opening Day at Miami. Moreta was placed on the 60-day injured list on Feb. 16 after undergoing Tommy John surgery and being sidelined for the entire 2024 season. Nearly 14 months after his last professional appearance, the right-hander began a rehab assignment with High-A Bradenton on April 29 and tossed 2.0 scoreless innings in two games. He has since pitched to a 2.57 ERA (2er/7.0ip) with Indy, allowing three hits while striking out 11 across his eight appearances.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: After a rare Tuesday off day, the Indianapolis Indians and Nashville Sounds are set to pick up their six-game series at 6:35 PM from Victory Field. With last night's win, the Indians have won three straight games against the Nashville Sounds at Victory Field dating back to Aug. 12, 2023. Thomas Harrington, MiLB's No. 84 prospect according to MLB Pipeline, will take the mound for Indy for his eighth Triple-A start of the season. Harrington faced the Sounds once in his career, on Aug. 10, 2024, at Nashville, allowing four hits, two unearned runs and striking out five across 4.2 innings. Nashville will counter with 30-year-old southpaw Bruce Zimmermann. Zimmermann, who spent all of his time in Triple-A before this season in the International League East with the Norfolk Tides, will be making his first career appearance against the Indians.

ON THIS DATE IN 2011: Shortstop Josh Harrison went 5-for-5 at Pawtucket as the Indians earned a comeback win, 9-7. Harrison finished the day with three doubles, two RBI, three runs scored and a stolen base. After falling behind 7-0 through three innings, Indianapolis put together a string of four multi-run innings, including a two-run ninth, for the win. Indy's bullpen combined for 7.0 three-hit innings to close out the game, with Tony Watson earning his first win of the season after pitching the eighth.

Thomas Harrington: The Campbell University alum is currently the Pirates' No. 3 prospect and Minor League Baseball's No. 84 overall prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

Major League Debut: Harrington had his contract first selected by Pittsburgh on April 1, 2025 and debuted with a 4.0 inning start the same night at Tampa Bay. Picked up his first career save in his next appearance on April 7 vs. St. Louis.

Last Outing: Harrington took the loss after allowing two runs on three hits and three walks while striking out two across 5.1 innings in Game 1 of a doubleheader on May 22 at Toledo.

Against the Mud Hens: Harrington has made one start against Nashville, on Aug. 10, 2024, on the road. In that start, which was his second in Triple-A, he allowed two runs and struck out five across 4.2 innings.
