ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Beloit Sky Carp beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 12-5 at ABC Supply Stadium. Wisconsin pitchers walked thirteen Beloit batters in the game. The Sky Carp took a scored three runs on five walks in the bottom of the second inning, added two runs in the third, and two more in the fourth to take a 7-0 lead. Wisconsin scored three runs in the top of the sixth without a hit on four walks and two hit batsmen. The Sky Carp tacked on five more runs in the bottom of the eighth.

IT HAPPENED AGAIN: Last night marks the second time Wisconsin pitchers have walked thirteen batters in a game. The last time was also against the Beloit Sky Carp (May 13 at home).

LOOKING FOR A JUMP START: Through the first twelve games of the second half, Wisconsin has scored 43 runs (3.58/game). Those are the fewest runs scored by a team in the Midwest League in the second half of the season.

OLD RELIABLES: Blake Burke had two hits, including an RBI double in the ninth inning, for his 21st multi-hit game of the season. Jadher Areinamo doubled, walked, scored, and drove in a run last night for the Rattlers. Areinamo has 20 doubles this season and is second in the league. Areinamo leads the Rattlers in RBI with 42 and Burke is second with 41. Both Burke and Areinamo have 21 multi-hit games this season.

DEEP ROOTS: Wisconsin reliever Bayden Root pitched 3-1/3 scoreless innings with one hit, no walks, and two strikeouts for the Rattlers. That was the longest outing of Root's pro career.

CALL TO ACTION: Luiyin Alastre was called into the game from right field with the base loaded and no outs in the bottom of the eighth inning after Miles Langhorne left the game with an injury. Alastre allowed all three runners to score after a walk, a sacrifice fly, and a single. Alastre did get a strikeout later in the frame. Last night was the third time he has needed to pitch in three games this season.

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's fourth season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Angel Espada is in his first season as the manager of the Sky Carp. Bill Hall, Prince Fielder, Rickie Weeks, Chris Bosio, Greg Vaughn, Joey Meyer, BJ Surhoff, Tim Dillard, Mitch Stetter, and Matt Chapman played in Beloit.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places five Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Bishop Letson (#14), Blake Burke (#17), Jadher Areinamo (#23), Juan Baez (#26), and Manuel Rodriguez (#29). MLB Pipeline has five Beloit players on their Top 30 list of Marlins prospects: Noble Meyer (#4), Echedry Vargas (#16), Gage Miller (#21), Karson Milbrandt (#24), and Brayan Mendoza (#30).

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JARON DeBERRY: The Milwaukee Brewers selected DeBerry in the third round of the 2024 draft out of Dallas Baptist University.

JC: DeBerry pitched the 2021 season at Northern Oklahoma-Enid and was 5-1 with a 4.10 ERA in fourteen games – twelve starts. In 2022, he was at Grayson College with a 4-0 record, a 3.27 ERA, and 60 strikeouts in 41.1IP.

SUMMER JOBS: DeBerry was with Duluth in the Northwoods League in 2022 and Cowlitz in the West Coast League in 2023. He combined to go 4-0 with a 1.85 ERA and 37 strikeouts over 39 innings playing in the Summer Leagues.

DBU: DeBerry was 10-2 with a 4.11 ERA in two seasons with Dallas Baptist. He had 124 strikeouts in 124-1/3 innings. He was a First Team All-Conference USA selection in his final season. In his last start with the Patriots, DeBerry shutout Arizona over six innings as Dallas Baptist beat the Wildcats in the Tucson Regional of the 2024 NCAA Tournament.

BEFORE WISCONSIN: DeBerry made his pro debut with three starts for the Carolina Mudcats before joining Wisconsin on May 20. He had no record, allowed one run, walked one, and struck out thirteen in 8-2/3 innings with the Mudcats.

LAST START: DeBerry had a no decision against Quad Cities at home on <u>June 28</u>. He allowed two runs on four hits with two walks and four strikeouts over 4-2/3 innings.

VS. BELOIT: DeBerry has never pitched against the Sky Carp before tonight. This evening is also his first appearance against an affiliate of the Miami Marlins.

BELOIT STARTING PITCHER:

RHP KARSON MILBRANDT: Selected by the Miami Marlins in the 3rd round of the 2022 draft out of Liberty (MO) High School. Milbrandt is ranked as the #25 prospect in the Marlins system by MLB Pipeline.

IS IT IN YOU? Milbrandt was named the Gatorade Player of the Year for Missouri prior to the 2022 draft. He was 7-1 with a 1.66 ERA and 91 strikeouts over 50-2/3 innings pitched. He also hit .400 with an OPS of 1.043 in his senior season.

VANDERWHAT? Milbrandt signed with the Marlins over a commitment to Vanderbilt University.

STARTING OUT: Milbrandt made one professional appearance in 2022, a two-inning start for the Jupiter Hammerheads against the Lakeland Flying Tigers on September 9 in a Florida State League game. He allowed two runs on two hits with a walk and a strikeout for a no decision.

LEAVING JUPITER: Milbrandt started the 2023 season with the Jupiter and was 3-3 with a 5.33 ERA in twelve starts. He walked 26 and struck out 52 in 52-1/3 innings pitched before being assigned to Beloit on June 28. Milbrandt was 0-3 with a 4.60 ERA in eleven starts for the Sky Carp after the promotion. Last season Milbrandt went 1-8 with a 4.33 ERA in 22 starts for Beloit.

LAST START: Milbrandt lost at Peoria on <u>June 27</u>. He allowed five runs – three earned – on five hits and four walks with four strikeouts over 5-1/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Milbrandt lost game one of a doubleheader at Neuroscience Group Field on May 16 when he allowed a run on three hits with two walks and three strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings. In three starts against Wisconsin last year, Milbrandt had a no decision at Wisconsin on May 17, lost at Wisconsin on July 4, and a no decision at home on July 23. He gave up ten runs on thirteen hits with eleven walks and ten strikeouts over 12-1/3 innings versus Wisconsin last season.
