SUNDAY AFTERNOON: The Great Lakes Loons beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 3-2 at Dow Diamond. The Timber Rattlers had a 2-1 lead after a run-scoring fielder's choice by Joe Gray Jr in the top of the fifth. Former Timber Rattler Kekai Rios homered for the Loons to tie the game in the bottom of the fifth. Jonny

DeLuca drove in the go-ahead run with a two-out, RBI double in the bottom of the sixth.

ROUGH PATCH OF ROAD: The Timber Rattlers wrapped up their first two-week road trip of the season with a 3-8 record. Wisconsin was 2-3 with a cancelation at Beloit from June 7 through June 12. The Rattlers went 1-5 at Great Lakes from June 14 through June 20. Wisconsin dropped the final five games of the series against the Loons. Wisconsin was also eliminated from playoff contention in the first half with the loss on June 18.

FIRST TIME: Wisconsin is on its first five-game losing streak of the season. Great Lakes outscored the Timber Rattlers 32-12 in the last five games of the series at Dow Diamond. Wisconsin stranded 35 runners and went 6-for-39 with runners in scoring position over the final five games of the series.

KELLY'S KS: Antoine Kelly pitched twice in the series at Great Lakes. He struck out sixteen over 10-2/3 innings to run his strikeout total for the season to 84. Kelly is tied with Connor Phillips of Dayton for the Midwest League lead in strikeouts.

REHABBING: The Rattlers welcome Milwaukee Brewers infielder Mike Brosseau and relief pitcher Trevor Gott to town for rehab appearances starting tonight. Brewers starting pitcher Brandon Woodruff will be making a rehab start for the Timber Rattlers on Thursday.

WELCOME: The Brewers have also announced that reliever Justin King has been transferred to Wisconsin from Milwaukee's Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League. King had been signed from the Florence Y'Alls in the independent Frontier League on June 3.

ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo from 1969-1976, Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Tyler Black (#7), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Zavier Warren (#17), and Cam Robinson (#26). Carlos Rodríguez (#21) is on the Wisconsin injured list. MLB Pipeline has three current River Bandits on their Top 30 list of Kansas City Royals prospects: Peyton Wilson (#11), Luca Tresh (#23), and Diego Hernandez (#30).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP RYNE MOORE: The Brewers selected Moore in the 18th round of the 2021 draft out of Old Dominion University.

THE MONARCH: Moore went 9-1 with a 3.16 ERA in seventeen games – fourteen starts – in his final season at ODU. He was also named a Second Team All-Conference USA selection in 2021.

AM I BLUE? Moore began his professional career with Milwaukee's Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League after signing his professional contract. He made six appearances – two starts – and allowed a run on four hits over 12-2/3 innings for Brewers Blue.

IN MY MIND I'M GOING TO CAROLINA: Moore started the 2022 season with the Carolina Mudcats. He was 0-1 with a 2.31 ERA in six starts in the Carolina League. Moore walked eleven and struck out 38 over 35 innings for the Mudcats.

WELCOME TO WISCONSIN: Moore joined the Timber Rattlers on May 12, 2022.

LAST START: Moore <u>lost at Great Lakes on June 15</u>. He allowed five runs – four earned – on six hits with four walks and five strikeouts over 4-2/3 innings pitched.

VS. QUAD CITIES: Tonight is the first time Moore will face the River Bandits. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Kansas City Royals.

QUAD CITIES SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

LHP ERIC SKOGLUND: Selected by the Kansas City Royals in the 3rd round of the 2014 draft out of the Central Florida with the 92nd overall pick.

ON THE JOURNEY: Skoglund started his professional career with the Idaho Falls Chukars in 2014, moved to the Wilmington Blue Rocks in 2015, and was with the Northwest Arkansas Naturals in 2016. He was 6-3 in fifteen starts at Wilmington and went 7-10 in 27 starts for the Naturals with 134 strikeouts over 156-1/3 innings.

CHASING STORMS: Skoglund made nineteen starts for Omaha, the Triple-A affiliate of the Royals, in 2019. He went 4-5 with a 4.11 ERA and 102 strikeouts over 100-2/3 innings.

MLB DEBUT: Skoglund made the start for the Royals against the Detroit Tigers on May 30, 2017 and was the winning pitcher after allowing two hits and no runs over 6-1/3 innings. Skoglund is 2-11 in 27 games – 22 starts – over parts of three seasons with Kansas City.

NEWS: Skoglund received an 80-game suspension for the 2019 season for violation of the MLB drug policy. Missed the 2021 season due to injury. He started this season on the Omaha IL before being sent out to the Arizona Complex League to start a rehab assignment on June 6, 2022.

LAST START: Skoglund <u>lost to the ACL White Sox at home on June 16</u>. He allowed six runs – five earned – on eight hits with no walks and two strikeouts over 1-2/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Skoglund has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening.
