ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the West Michigan Whitecaps 6-1 at Neuroscience Group Field.](#) Bishop Letson had nine strikeouts over five scoreless innings as the Wisconsin starting pitcher for the win. The Rattlers scored four runs in the first and added solo homers by Jader Areinamo and Blake Burke.

THAT WOULD BE AN ECUMENICAL MATTER: Letson set a new single-game high as a professional with his nine strikeouts last night. The Whitecaps loaded the bases with two outs against Letson in the second inning before he ended the inning with a strikeout. Max Clark reached on a single to start the third. Then, Letson retired the final nine batters he faced. In his last two starts, Letson has pitched 10-1/3 shutout innings with one walk and thirteen strikeouts.

PROVIDING SUPPORT: Wisconsin took the lead on an RBI single by Eduardo Garcia in the bottom of the first. Later in the first, Juan Baez added a two-run single and an error on the play let the fourth run score. Areinamo hit his third home of the season with a long ball to start the fifth inning. Burke also hit his third homer of the season with a lead-off shot in the seventh.

THE MAGIC NUMBER: Wisconsin is 5-0 when scoring five or more runs.

IN RELIEF: Aaron Rund pitched two perfect innings with two strikeouts as the first reliever out of the Wisconsin bullpen. Dikember Sánchez allowed a run on a hit with three walks and two strikeouts over the final two innings.

MULTI-BALL: Areinamo and Garcia each had two hits for the Rattlers last night. Areinamo leads Wisconsin with eight multi-hit games this season. Garcia has seven multi-hit games in 2025.

DAYBREAK: Today is the tenth day game of the season for Wisconsin. They are 5-4 in day games so far in 2025.

ABOUT WEST MICHIGAN: The West Michigan Whitecaps joined the Midwest League in 1994 when the Madison Muskies moved to Comstock Park, Michigan following the 1993 season. The Whitecaps started play in the league as an affiliate of the Oakland Athletics. They became Low-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers for the 1997 season. The Whitecaps have won six Midwest League Pennants – 1996, 1998, 2004, 2006, 2007, and 2015. Notable former Whitecaps include Nick Castellanos, Joel Zumaya, Fernando Rodney, Francisco Cordero, Brandon Inge, Cameron Maybin, Alex Avila, and Willy Adames.

ABOUT THE TIGERS: Detroit has been affiliated with the Whitecaps since 1997. The Tigers had just one other stint in the Midwest League prior to their current partnership. They were with the Clinton Pilots from 1971 through 1975.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TYSON HARDIN: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Hardin in the 12th round of the 2024 draft out of Mississippi State University.

BULLDOG: Hardin was 3-3 and two saves with a 6.59 ERA and 61 strikeouts over 56 innings in forty games – two starts – at Mississippi State.

DAYTONA 500: Hardin pitched two seasons at Daytona State College (2021 and 2022). He was the team's pitcher of the year as a freshman and was 8-5 with two saves in 38 appearances – fifteen starts – at DSC.

BREAKING OUT: Hardin worked two innings in Milwaukee's 2025 Spring Breakout Game against the Cincinnati Reds on [March 16](#). He allowed one hit and struck out three without a walk in two scoreless innings.

LAST START: Hardin had a no decision at Cedar Rapids on [April 26](#). He allowed two runs on six hits with two walks and four strikeouts over four innings.

VS. WEST MICHIGAN: Hardin has never faced the Whitecaps prior to this afternoon. Today is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Detroit Tigers.

WEST MICHIGAN STARTING PITCHER:

LHP JOE MILLER: The Detroit Tigers selected Miller in the eleventh round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Pennsylvania.

THE PENN IS MIGHTIER: Miller pitched four seasons for the Quakers. He was 10-8 with a 4.49 ERA and 160 strikeouts over 132-1/3 innings in 33 games – 24 starts during his time at Penn.

FROM THE COAST TO THE CAPE: Miller pitched for Asheboro (2019) and Savannah (2021) in the Coastal Plain League and Chatham in the Cape Cod League (2022) over three summers. He was 9-5 with a 2.48 ERA in 21 games – eighteen starts – during his summer collegiate league play.

LET'S GET IT STARTED: In 2022, Miller made a brief relief appearance in the Florida Complex League and four brief starts for the Lakeland Flying Tigers in the Florida State League.

LAND OF THE LAKE: Miller spent 2023 with Lakeland and was 2-3 with a 3.93 ERA and 78 strikeouts over 68-2/3 innings in 18 games – twelve starts. Miller started the 2024 season with Lakeland and was 2-0 with three walks, 29 strikeouts, and an ERA of 1.23 in six games – four starts – before his promotion to West Michigan on May 14. He finished the year with the Whitecaps and was 3-4 with a 4.42 ERA in nineteen games – eighteen starts.

LAST START: Miller had a no decision at Dayton on [April 27](#). He allowed five hits and walked one with three strikeouts over four innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Miller was 0-1 in two starts against Wisconsin – [June 13](#) and [July 13](#) – in 2024. He gave up two runs on seven hits with two walks and two strikeouts over six innings in those starts.
