THE PENULTIMATE GAME: The Wichita Wind Surge continue the final series of the season in The Sparkling City by the Bay tonight. The Surge final road series of the season. The Wind Surge are 31-36 on the road this season, the team finished the 2023 road season with a record of 28-41, with the win Tuesday night the team surpassed the fewest road wins in a season.

THE PENNANT CHASE - The team trails Tulsa by one game with two to play, and the Surge own the tie-breaker. The Wind Surge are in Corpus Christi this weekend for the final two games of the season. Tulsa will host Arkansas for the final two games of the season. The Surge are 8-2 this season vs. Corpus. Tulsa and Arkansas current series and season series is even, 2-2 and season even at 11. If Wichita advances to postseason, the team would host Springfield, Tuesday, September 16th.

*Amarillo clinched the South Wednesday and will play Midland in the playoffs for South Division.

*Springfield clinched the North last night, winning both halves.

VS. HOOKS- The Surge defeated Corpus Christi five of the six meetings earlier this season in Wichita, it was just the second trip the Hooks have ever made to the ICT. Wichita won four of six in Corpus in 2024 and the all-time series has the Wind Surge leading the Hooks, 22-12. Wichita leads the current series three games to one and lead the season series 8-2. The Surge pitchers have allowed three six runs in four games, and just 18 hits in series. Hooks pitchers have dealt 51 strikeouts in four games, 15Ks on Tuesday, 14 on Wednesday and 13 Thursday and 9 last night.

7TH INNING SURGE LEADS TO WIN -Andrew Cossetti hit his 14th homer of the year in an 8-3 come from behind win. Will Bush put Corpus Christi ahead on a two-run homer in the second. Both teams added on in their halves of the third with Kala'i Rosario scoring on an infield error to tie the game and Joseph Sullivan making it a 3-2 Hooks advantage on an RBI single. Darren Bowen and Logan Whitaker held the Hooks to three hits over the following three and one-third innings, with Whitaker striking out three men against two walks over two innings of relief to earn his first win with the Wind Surge. A four-run frame took place for Wichita in the seventh on four hits, starting with a game-tying opposite field blast to left from Hendry Mendez. Ricardo Olivar punched a run-scoring single toward right field and later swiped home on a double steal. Cossetti singled to drive home Ben Ross for a 6-3 Wind Surge advantage. Mike Paredes struck out the side to secure the 8-3 win and his seventh save *Mike Paredes leads the Wind Surge in wins (11) and saves (7).

*Kala'i Rosario steals two more bases, has 32 now in 2025.

ON THE MOUND - Ryan Gallagher will make his 24th overall start of the season and tenth in Double-A tonight vs. Corpus Christi. The former Cubs farmhand fired 11 scoreless innings earlier this month with the Wind Surge spanning two starts. In his last outing he allowed three runs in three and two third innings against Tulsa on Sunday, he made two starts last week vs Drillers. He is 4-1 with a 5.35 ERA in seven Wind Surge

GOING FOR NEW HEIGHTS - The Wind Surge secured in a winning season in Brian Dinkelman's first season at Wichita, the Surge have 75 victories. The club record for wins is the 2022 season when the team won 78 games, the team won just 58 wins last year. Dink has a career record of 442-347 and has a winning record in all six seasons as a manager. Wichita is 344-324 all-time.

ROSARIO MVP? The Texas League season is winding down and Kala'i Rosario leads the Texas League in hits, home runs, RBI, runs, total bases and extra base hits. 2nd in hits, slugging. His 33 career Surge home runs moves him to second in franchise history, 3 behind Aaron Sabato (36). Rosario joined Kyler Fedko as second ever Wind Surge player to join 20/20 Club, 20HR and 20+ stolen bases in a season. He hit the cycle earlier this season. He set the single-season franchise record with 25 homers and has already set the record for most RBI in a single season (83).

TOP OF THE LEAGUE - The Wind Surge second in league in batting average (.256), lead in runs scored (711), second in total bases (1,931), 1st in home runs (169), and walks (603), while second in doubles (225).

ARMS BATTLE- The Wind Surge are third in the league in ERA, second in the league with 13 shutouts. The team has dealt the third fewest walks in Class AA, 434.

ICT NOTES -35 of the last 43 wins, the team has scored five runs or more.... The +116 run differential is second best in the league Wichita is the lone team in the Texas League that has not had a player intentionally walked this year. The Wind Surge starting pitchers have a 4.07 ERA, 3rd best in the league. The 20 wins are the fewest, and the starters have pitched the fewest innings in Class AA (530.1). The Wind Surge have played error free baseball in 13 of their last 19 games. The team has 35 come from behind wins, six when trailing after 8 innings. Team had seven of those total years one thru four, with one last yr.

SHUT EM DOWN - The Wind Surge pitchers have dealt 13 shutouts this season, second highest in Texas League this season and a new club record for a single season. The team pitched eight shutouts in 2021 & 2022. The Wind Surge have pitched 37 shutouts all time.

THE LAWYER! The Minnesota Twins promoted reliever Cody Laweryson to the Major Leagues. He's the 10th Wind Surge player to get called up to an MLB team in the same season after playing for Wichita. Laweryson is the sixth former Wind Surge player to reach the big leagues this season, alongside Evan Sisk (April 16, Kansas City Royals), Luke Keaschall (April 18), Carson McCusker (May 18), Travis Adams (June 6), and Pierson Ohl (July 29) all to





Year end tidbits, notes:

THE FUTURE- The Wind Surge have been well represented at the Major League Baseball Futures Game over the past few seasons. Kaelin Culpepper is the fifth Wind Surge player selected in team history, alongside Luke Keaschall (2024), David Festa (2023), Matt Wallner (2022), and Josh Winder (2021).

TO THE SHOW- In the short five-year history of the Wind Surge the team has promoted 40 players to Major League Baseball. In 2025 Wichita promoted six players, a pair of coaches and a broadcaster. Ramon Borrego made the move from manager to Twins First Base Coach. Corbin Day promoted from hitting coach to Twins advance scout. Luke Keaschall, Carson McCusker, Travis Adams, Pierson Ohl, Cody Laweryson and Evan Sisk all made MLB debuts this season. Ohl and Laweryson becoming the 9th and 10th to be called up the same season they played in Wichita.

PERFECT VISION - The Wind Surge had a pair of players accomplish 20-20 seasons in a Wind Surge uni. Kyler Fedko accomplished the feat in July, hitting 22 homers and 26 stolen bases prior to his promotion to St Paul. Kalai Rosario accomplished the feat in August. Kaelin Culpepper also had a 20-20 season with combined numbers between Cedar Rapids and Wichita.

THE CYCLE – Kala'i Rosario is the second Wind Surge hitter in franchise history to hit for the cycle (Christian Encarnacion-Strand, July 17, 2022, vs. Arkansas). He's also the first Wichita hitter this year with five or more RBIs in a game (6). The last Surge player with six RBI in a game would be Carson McCusker last May 7th vs Arkansas. Its also the third cycle in the ballpark, Thomas Saggese hit for the cycle for Springfield on August 19, 2023.

GOING THE DISTANCE – The Wind Surge and Tulsa Drillers played a new Texas League record 14 inning game on April 16th. The longest extra innings game since the automatic runner rule got implemented in 2016. The Drillers got the best of the Surge winning 5-4 in three hours and 57 minutes.

IT WAS A GREAT RUN, BEN!- The Surge postponed their game on September 3rd due to a light malfunction. It was the first Wind Surge home game since May 3, 2022 and was 1,220 days since the last postponed game also vs. Tulsa. In fact the last four home games postponed have all been vs. Tulsa. Tulsa has been involved in three of the longest rain delays in ballpark history and been in town for the only pregame and midgame fireworks show.

HOME SWEET HOME - The Surge finish the home schedule 44-25, the 44 home wins leads the league and sets a new franchise record for home victories, the club won 35 in 2022 and 34 games in its inaugural season of 2021. The team had a seven game win streak in June, matching a club record. The team set a new record with eight straight wins in the final homestand August and September.

THE PROPELLER'S IN THE BUILDING – The Wind Surge defeated Tulsa to win the Propeller! The Propeller Series presented by Coors Light started in 2021 and the Drillers have won three of the first five years. Wichita won the trophy in 2021 and this season. The Surge and Drillers split the 2025 season series, Wichita wins the tie-breaker winning the final game.

PACK EM IN – The crowd of 10,253 on September 6th is the second-most in the ballpark history. It was the largest crowd of the 2025 season. The ballpark attracted 10,442 fans on September 16, 2023.

THE TURNSTILES – Wichita attracted an average of 4,084 fans per game this season, fifth highest in The Texas League. Three of the top six crowds in ballpark history made their way to the ballpark. Setting new highs for Harry Potter Night, Independence Day and Faith and Family/90's Night.

RUCK EM UP - Jake Rucker played in his third season with the Surge and sits a top the club record in career games, RBI, hits, doubles, runs, and total bases.

PITCHING ACCOLADES – Pierson Ohl moved to the top of the franchise marks with 15 career wins, second with 228 innings. Aaron Rozek second with 14 wins, but set new highs with 255 innings pitched and 235 strikeouts. John Stankiewicz has set the new franchise record for career pitching appearances. He has appeared in 78 games between 2024 and 2025 seasons

MISTER SABATO - Aaron Sabato cruised to the top of the all-time home run record for a Wind Surge player. He has hit 36 home runs in his three seasons with the Wind Surge.

HE'S THE WIN MAN: Mike Paredes became the individual franchise recordholder for wins as a pitcher in a single season with 11, besting Kody Funderburk's 10-win 2022. Paredes is second for the most wins for a pitcher across all of Minor League Baseball. He also leads the club with 7 saves, tied for 8th in the league.

WALK OFF'S - The Wind Surge walked off winners three times in 2025 and hit a pair of walk off home runs in the final homestand. Kala'i Rosario and Ben Ross walking off winners with home runs. The Surge were on the shorthand of a club record 11 walk-off losses.

LATE GAME MAGIC - The Wind Surge have won six games this year when trailing after eight innings and have 35 come from behind victories for the season. The club had a combined 7 wins when trailing after eight innings, prior to this season. (3 in '21, 2 in '22 and one in '23&'24)

PHOTO FINSHES- The Wind Surge are 11-20 in one-run games, the 20 defeats, third highest in Texas League and third most in Class AA. In 2024 the team played a Minor League high 49 one-run games and were 16-33. The team has 33 come from behind wins this season including biggest comeback in team history, rallying down seven runs vs Tulsa on July 6th to win a game.

SHUT EM DOWN - The Wind Surge pitchers have dealt 13 shutouts this season, second highest in Texas League this season and a new club record for a single season. The team pitched eight shutouts in 2021 & 2022. The Wind Surge have pitched 37 shutouts all time.\

FLUSH THE MOUSE- The Wind Surge 22 blown saves are the fourth most in the Texas League this season, the team's 3.80 ERA bullpen ERA is fourth best in the league.

GRAND SLAMMA! The Wind Surge crushed eight grand slams this season including a walk off grand slam and a pinch hit grand slam. The eight slams in a season is a new single season high, the team hit six in 2022.

FALL BALL: Major League Baseball announced the rosters for the Arizona Fall League (AFL) season. The season begins on October 6. Eight Twins minor leaguers will play for the Peoria Javelinas this season... Wind Surge players represented will include: RHP Hunter Hoopes and OF Hendry Mendez...also representing the Twins will be hitting coach Danny Marcuzzo and former Surge athletic trainer Taylor Carpenter.
