WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON: The Peoria Chiefs shut out the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 6-0 at Neuroscience Group Field. Wilfredo Pereira, Nathanael Heredia, and Leonardo Taveras combined on the three-hit shutout for the Chiefs. The trio of Peoria pitchers combined to strike out eleven without walking a batter.

MR. SMITH: Russell Smith was Wisconsin's starting pitcher on Wednesday. He set a new professional single-game high for innings pitched with six. He allowed a run in the first and three runs in the fourth. All three runs in the fourth inning happened after two outs.

IT HAPPENED AGAIN: The Timber Rattlers have been shutout in Smith's last two starts. Cedar Rapids beat Wisconsin 9-0 at Perfect Game Field on May 26

DID YOU KNOW? The Timber Rattlers have been shut out three times this season. Peoria has two of those shutouts (yesterday and game one of a doubleheader on April 10).

OCHO: Joe Gray Jr stole his eighth base of the season vesterday. He has not been caught stealing this season and has only been thrown out once in his last sixteen attempts dating back to last year.

MAKE IT A DOUBLE: Zavier Warren doubled in the bottom of the first yesterday. Warren leads the Midwest League with fifteen doubles.

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1957 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1956 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels in 1983. They changed their name to the Chiefs and their affiliation to the Chicago Cubs for the 1984 season. They became a Cardinals affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his first year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, and Yadier Molina.

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

LHP BRANDON KNARR: The Brewers signed Knarr as a non-drafted free agent out of the University of Tampa on July 17, 2020.

GOLDEN DOME: Knarr pitched at Notre Dame as a freshman and appeared in twelve games.

TO FLORIDA: Knarr spent his sophomore season at the College of Central Florida. He was 6-1 with 86 strikeouts and an ERA of 4.66 over 65-2/3 innings in sixteen games – thirteen starts.

TAMPA, TOO: Knarr transferred to the University of Tampa for the 2019-2020 season and was 4-1 with 64 strikeouts and a 2.55 ERA over 35-1/3 innings pitched in six starts before the shutdown.

IN THE MUD: Knarr started the 2021 season with the Carolina Mudcats. He was 7-2 with 103 strikeouts over 75 innings and an ERA of 3.84 in sixteen games – thirteen starts – before his promotion to Wisconsin on August 17.

AS A RATTLER LAST YEAR: Knarr made five starts with Wisconsin at the end of the 2021 season. He went 1-1 with fourteen walks, 25 strikeouts, and fifteen earned runs allowed over 22-1/3 innings.

AWARD WINNING: Minor League Baseball named Knarr the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week on May 23, 2022 for his performance on May 21 against South Bend.

LAST START: Knarr <u>won at Cedar Rapids on May 27</u>. He allowed three runs on eight hits with two walks and five strikeouts in five innings. Knarr has won seven consecutive starts.

VS. PEORIA (2022): Knarr is 1-1 in two starts against the Chiefs this season. He lost in game one of a doubleheader on April 10 at home and won in at Peoria on April 28. Knarr has allowed one unearned run on four hits with four walks and twelve strikeouts over 11-2/3 innings against Peoria this season.

PEORIA SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP DIONYS RODRÍGUEZ: The Cardinals signed Rodríguez as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic in 2018.

AND TO THE REPUBLIC: Rodríguez pitched of the Dominican Summer League affiliate of the Cardinals in 2018 and 2019. He was 4-0 with two saves despite a 7.40 ERA in nineteen relief appearances in 2018 between the Cardinals Red and the Cardinals Blue affiliates. In 2019, Rodríguez was 2-1 with two saves and a 5.88 ERA in seventeen relief appearances. Rodríguez walked 51 and struck out 58 in 50-1/3 innings pitched in those two seasons.

WILD PALMS: Rodríguez pitched for Palm Beach in 2021made seven starts after signing with the Cardinals. He made 22 appearances – twelve starts – for the Cardinals last season in the Low-A Southeast and was 4-5 with 22 walks, 88 strikeouts, and a 3.36 ERA in 69-2/3 innings pitched.

RATING BY THE BOOK: Baseball America ranks Rodríguez as the #21 prospect in the St. Louis system.

LAST START: Rodríguez lost to Lake County at home on May 27. He allowed an unearned run on two hits with two walks and no strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN (2022): Rodríguez is 0-1 in two starts against the Timber Rattlers this season. He had a no decision at Wisconsin in game two of a doubleheader on April 10 and lost to the Rattlers at home on April 28. Rodríguez has allowed one run on seven hits with six walks and twelve strikeouts over nine innings against Wisconsin this season.
