ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers outslugged the South Bend Cubs with a 14-8 victory at Four Winds Field. Luis Lara was on base five times with two hits, a walk, and two hit batsmen. Lara also scored three runs, drove in two, and stole a base

O'RAE OF SUNSHINE: Dylan O'Rae was on base four times with three walks and a single on Wednesday. He stole three bases and scored four runs. O'Rae has been on base in all five Wisconsin games this season. He is 7-for-18 with six walks, five stolen bases, six runs scored, an OBP of .560 and an OPS of 1.004.

MIKE CHECK: Mike Boeve was 2-for-3 with two walks and two RBI last night to extend his season-opening onbase streak to five. Boeve is 7-for-18 with five walks, an OBP of .500 and an OPS of .944

MULTI-BALL: Every Timber Rattler in the order had at least one hit last night. Luis Lara, Gregory Barrios, Boeve, and Jesús Chirinos each had two hits. Seven Rattlers had at least one RBI in the game. Lara, Barrios, Boeve, Chirinos, and Ramón Rodríguez each had two RBI.

FIRST! Jheremy Vargas hit the first Timber Rattlers home run of the season last night. Vargas hit a lead-off homer in the sixth inning to give Wisconsin an 8-4 lead. The dinger was the first by Vargas since August 11, 2022 in a game against the ACL Cubs.

ALL WE NEED IS JUST A LITTLE PATIENCE:

Wisconsin hitters drew ten walks on Wednesday. The Timber Rattlers have coaxed 29 walks this season and lead the Midwest League in that category

EARLY RETURNS: Wisconsin also leads the MWL in average (.292), OBP (.411), OPS (.771), and runs (29). The Rattlers are tied for the league lead in steals (12). DOUBLE DIGITS: Wisconsin reached double digits in runs in their fifth game of the 2024 season. The Timber Rattlers didn't get to ten runs in a game last season until their thirtieth game of the season when they beat South Bend 10-6 at home on May 12, 2023.

ABOUT SOUTH BEND: The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs in 2015. South Bend has won Midwest League titles in 1989, 1993, 2005, 2019, and 2022. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, Carlos Gonzalez, and current Timber Rattlers manager Victor Estevez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982. Nick Lovullo, the son of Arizona Diamondbacks manager Torev Lovullo, is in his first year as South Bend's manager.

ABOUT THE CUBS: The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL with an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, and Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

SEASON SO FAR: South Bend won their season opening game 3-1 on April 5 at Quad Cities. The Cubs lost the next two games in the series 3-2 in ten innings on Saturday and 4-0 on Sunday.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Luis Lara (#9), Mike Boeve (#15), Luke Adams (#16), Dylan O'Rae (#21), Jadher Areinamo (#23), and Patricio Aquino (#29). MLB Pipeline has four active South Bend players on their list of Cubs prospects: Jefferson Rojas (#8), Drew Gray (#15), Pedro Ramirez (#17), and Brody McCullough (#26).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP WILL RUDY: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Rudy in the 5th round of the 2022 draft out of the California Polytechnic State University, Pomona.

WHAT A SEASON: Rudy was at Cal Poly Pomona for three seasons but had just one full season due to COVID-19 abbreviating 2020 and canceling the 2021 season for the Broncos. In 2022, which was still his freshman season, Rudy went 8-1 with a 3.10 ERA over thirteen starts. He walked fifteen and struck out 96 in 87 innings pitched during that season.

TROPHY ROOM: Rudy was a three-time Pitcher of the Week in the California Collegiate Athletic Association, two-time National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association West Region Pitcher of the Week, a First Team All-CCAA selection, and the CCAA's Most Valuable pitcher last season.

OUR OLD FRIEND FROM POMONA: Rudy was the highest draft selection of a Poly Pomona player since Cody Ponce was picked 55th overall in the 2015 draft. The Brewers also picked Ponce, who pitched for the Timber Rattlers right after the 2015 draft.

THE CAPE: Rudy made one start for Yarmouth-Dennis in the Cape Cod League in 2022 before the draft. He did not pitch in the Brewers system until 2023.

THE MUDCAT: Rudy was 5-3 in eighteen starts for Carolina in 2023 for his professional debut. Rudy had a 3.46 ERA, 26 walks, and 69 strikeouts over 80-2/3 innings.

LAST START: Rudy had a no decision for Carolina in a game against the Salem Red Sox on <u>September 8, 2023</u>. He allowed a run on four hits with a walk and a strikeout over three innings.

VS. SOUTH BEND: Rudy has never faced the South Bend Cubs prior to this evening. He picked up the win over the Myrtle Beach Pelicans, the Carolina League affiliate of the Cubs, on <u>July 14, 2023</u> in a road game. He allowed two runs – one earned – on six hits with a walk and three strikeouts.

SOUTH BEND SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP SAM ARMSTRONG: The Chicago Cubs selected Armstrong in the 13th round of the 2023 draft out of Old Dominion University.

BEWARE THE MONARCH: Armstrong was 9-4 in fifteen starts in 2023, his second and final season at ODU. He had a 3.51 ERA with 28 walks and 72 strikeouts over 77 innings pitched. In his two seasons at Old Dominion, Armstrong went 12-6 with a 4.94 ERA.

HOW WAS THE COD? Armstrong made two starts for Harwich in the Cape Cod League prior to the 2023 draft. He was 1-0 and allowed one hit with one unearned run and thirteen strikeouts over ten innings before signing with Chicago.

BUSY TIME: Armstrong signed his contract with the Cubs on July 25, 2023, made his pro debut with a one-inning start against the ACL Giants on August 8, and made his Carolina League debut with the Myrtle Beach Pelicans on August 12. Armstrong was 2-0 in eight relief appearances with the Pelicans. In Carolina League play, he had an ERA of 5.27 with eight walks and ten strikeouts over 13-2/3 innings.

LAST APPEARANCE: Armstrong pitched two scoreless innings in relief during the season-opening series at Quad Cities on <u>April 6</u>. He allowed two hits, walked none, and struck out five in a no decision.

LAST START: Armstrong made a start in his pro debut against the ACL Giants on <u>August 8, 2023</u>. He allowed one hit, walked none, and struck out one over a scoreless inning for a no decision.

VS. WISCONSIN: Armstrong has never pitched against Wisconsin prior to this evening. He has also never faced an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers before tonight.
