ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Peoria Chiefs 8-2](#). The Rattlers took a 3-0 lead with three runs in the bottom of the fourth inning and added on to their lead with a run in the fifth, three runs in the seventh, and a run in the eighth. Joe Gray Jr and Ben Metzinger each went 2-for-4 with two RBI. Gray had a two-run homer in the fourth and Metzinger had a two-run double in the seventh. Seven of the nine Timber Rattlers in the lineup had a hit and eight of nine reached base in the game.

CRUISE CONTROL: Steven Cruz allowed two runs in the fifth inning before escaping a bases-loaded jam to qualify for the win. Cruz snapped a personal four-game losing streak with the victory.

RYAN'S SONG: Ryan Brady pitched three scoreless innings with four strikeouts in relief of Cruz. Brady has 34 strikeouts in 32 innings pitched over thirteen relief appearances for the Timber Rattlers this season.

FINISH WITH A FLOURISH: Taylor Floyd pitched the ninth inning. He struck out the first two batters he faced, walked Victor Scott II on a 3-2 pitch, and struck out the final batter to close the game. Floyd has walked five and struck out 23 in 18 innings pitched this season.

EXTRA MILE: Robert Moore and Matt Wood had back-to-back doubles in the bottom of the fourth. Gray followed with his fifth home run of the season.

WARMING UP: In their three wins during this series, the Timber Rattlers are 12-for-36 with runners in scoring position.

MAKING MOVES: The Milwaukee Brewers announced the signing of pitcher Sam Gardner from the Gateway Grizzlies of the Frontier League. Gardner was assigned to the Timber Rattlers prior to Friday's game.

DID YOU KNOW? Peoria leads the Timber Rattlers 9-7 with five games remaining in the season series. However, the Timber Rattlers have outscored the Chiefs 77-70 in this season.

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels for 1983 and 1984 with a change to the Chiefs nickname for 1984 followed by an affiliation switch to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. Peoria became the Cardinals Midwest League affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his second year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, and Yadier Molina.

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Eric Brown Jr (#6), Robert Moore (#8), Eduardo Garcia (#19), Matthew Wood (#24), and Joseph Hernandez (#25). Hendry Mendez (#13) is currently on Wisconsin's IL. [MLB Pipeline](#) has six Peoria players on their list of Top 30 Cardinals prospects: Tink Hence (#3), Cooper Hjerpe (#6), Jimmy Crooks (#15), Ian Bedell (#24), Dionys Rodriguez (#26), and Victor Scott II (#27). Inohan Paniagua (#17), Austin Love (#19), and Zane Mills (#30) are on Peoria's IL.

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TYLER WOESSNER: Drafted by the Milwaukee Brewers in the sixth round of the 2022 draft out of Central Arizona College.

WHAT A SEASON: Woessner went 11-2 with a 3.55 ERA in nineteen games – eighteen starts – during his final season at CAC. He walked 34 and struck out 122 in 96-1/3 innings pitched for the Vaqueros.

PITCHING INTO THE FINALS: Central Arizona College advanced to the 2022 NJCAA College World Series in Grand Junction, Colorado. Woessner was the winning pitcher in the game that got CAC into the Championship game as he allowed three runs and struck out eight over seven innings in the Vaqueros' 7-4 win over Walters State Community College on [June 3, 2022](#). Central Arizona College won the National Title the next day with a 4-2 win over Cowley County Community College.

NORTH TO ALASKA: Woessner pitched in three games – one start – for the Mat-Su Miners of the Alaska Baseball League in 2021. He had no record, walked three, and struck out four over seven innings.

FIRST YEAR AS A BREWER: Woessner started his pro career with the Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and made three appearances – two starts – with eleven strikeouts over six scoreless innings. Woessner also made one start for the Carolina Mudcats at the end of the 2022 Carolina League season.

LAST START: Woessner had a [no decision at Cedar Rapids on May 28](#). He allowed three runs – two earned – on three hits with two walks and two strikeouts over three innings.

VS. PEORIA: Woessner is 2-0 in three starts – [April 11](#), [April 16](#), and [May 5](#) – against the Chiefs. He has allowed eight runs – four earned – on eleven hits with six walks and fifteen strikeouts over fourteen innings.

PEORIA SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TRENT BAKER: Drafted by the St. Louis Cardinals in the ninth round of the 2021 draft out of Angelo State University.

ANGELO: Baker pitched four seasons at Angelo State, an NCAA Division II school in San Angelo, Texas. He was 31-7 with a 2.69 ERA and 148 strikeouts over 131 innings pitched in 52 games – 47 starts.

SENIOR SEASON: Baker went 13-1 with a 2.11ERA in seventeen starts during his final season at Angelo State. He had 120 strikeouts over 106-2/3 innings pitched, was named the Lone Star Conference Pitcher of the Year, and helped the Rams advance to the 2021 NCAA Division II College World Series. He pitched twice during that College World Series but had a no decision in both starts.

SUMMER WORK: Baker pitched in three different summer wood bat leagues during his college career: Newark of the Perfect Game Collegiate Baseball League (2018), Mankato of the Northwoods League (2019), and Round Rock of the Texas Collegiate League (2020).

GOING PRO: Baker made eight relief appearances without a decision for the Florida Complex League affiliate of the Cardinals in 2021 after signing with St. Louis. In 2022, Baker made 25 starts for Palm Beach in the Florida State League and was 9-7 with a 3.14ERA and 138 strikeouts over 123-1/3 innings pitched.

LAST START: Baker [lost to Great Lakes at home on May 28](#). He allowed five runs on six hits with a walk and two strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Baker is 1-1 in three starts – [April 11](#), [April 16](#), and [May 4](#) – against the Timber Rattlers this season. He has allowed six runs on twelve hits with five walks and fourteen strikeouts over thirteen innings against the Rattlers this season. Wisconsin has two homers off Baker this season: Ernesto Martínez on April 11 and Jesús Chirinos on April 16.
