CIRCLE CITY ROUNDUP

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Syracuse Mets shut out the Indianapolis Indians for the second consecutive game and earned a 4-0 victory on Saturday night at NBT Bank Stadium. Jonah Tong settled in for Syracuse to record his second win in as many starts since being promoted to Triple-A. The Top-100 prospect fanned eight over 6.0 innings to earn the win. Syracuse opened the scoring in the second inning of their shutout bid. Luke Ritter and Joey Meneses each walked to start the inning. Yonny Hernandez then singled to left field to move everyone up and load the bases. Ali Sánchez grounded a ball to short and was robbed of a hit by Tsung-Che Cheng, who got an out at second base. Despite the phenomenal play, a run scored on the fielder's choice. Luis De Los Santos then advanced Meneses home with a sacrifice fly to center. Jared Young led off the bottom of the third for the Mets with a double to left-center field. He went to third on a sacrifice bunt, then scored on a passed ball. It remained a 3-0 lead for Syracuse until they tacked on an insurance run in the sixth. Hernandez knocked a one-out single to center field and then stole second base. Sánchez followed with a double to right field that advanced Hernandez home and gave the game its final margin of 4-0. The Indianapolis offense threatened early against Tong but could not convert. Alike Williams and Nick Yorke opened the game with back-to-back singles but were both stranded on base in the first inning. Rafael Flores led off the second with a double and Sammy Siani walked afterwards, but they were also stranded on the basepaths. After the early Indy offensive success, Tong retired 13 batters in a row before he allowed a pair of hits in the sixth prior to his exit. José Castillo and Dylan Ross finished off the shutout for the Mets. Drake Fellows allowed three runs, but just two earned, over his 5.0 innings and took the loss.

WEEKEND WARRIORS: The Indians are 51-34 in games played on Thursday-Sunday, which is the third-highest winning percentage (.600) and the second-most wins among Triple-A teams this season. The Indians' extended weekend record is their best to this point in the season since they were 49-29 (.628) on Thursday-Sunday through Aug. 22, 2015. Indians' pitchers have allowed the fifth-fewest home runs (78), has held opponents to the sixth-lowest ERA (4.44) and are tied for the seventh-most strikeouts (757) of any Triple-A staff from Thursday-Sunday.

ALIKA'S ALL OVER IT: Alike Williams went 1-for-4 last night, extending his hitting streak to nine games since Aug. 14, at Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. Across his streak, Williams is hitting .400 (14-for-35) with a 1.139 OPS while ranking among International League hitters in RBI (3rd, 12), hits (T-3rd, 14), total bases (4th, 26), runs scored (T-5th, 10) and home runs (T-7th, 3). Williams has hit safely in 15 of 17 games in August, good for a .328 batting average (21-for-64). He's also recorded a 1.022 OPS in the month while racking up two doubles, a triple, five homers and 16 RBI. Williams' five homers in the month matches June 2022 with High-A Bowling Green for his career high in a calendar month and his eight extra-base hits are his most in a month since racking up 10 in July 2023 with Indy.

NEW YORK(E) STATE OF MIND: Nick Yorke racked up multiple hits in his third straight game last night, going 2-for-3 with a walk in the loss. It was his 30th game of the season with multiple hits, supplanting Nick Solak for the most by an Indians' hitter on the campaign. He also extended his hitting streak to six games since Aug. 17 and is hitting .370 (10-for-27) with six RBI and a .837 OPS across his streak. Yorke has hit safely in 18 of his last 22 games since July 19 and has racked up 11 multi-hit games in that span. Across this stretch, Yorke is hitting .333 (32-for-96) with 13 runs scored, five doubles, a homer and 17 RBI.

BOWEN STAYS ON BASE: Jase Bowen walked last night to extend his on-base streak to 14 games dating back to his Triple-A debut on Aug. 7, vs. Omaha. Bowen has racked up eight walks since debuting with Indy, which is the most by an Indians' hitter in that span. Since debuting, Bowen is hitting .265 (13-for-49) with nine runs scored, four doubles, a homer and a .776 OPS.

TODAY'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians look to secure a series win and clinch a winning record across their two-week road trip with a win today over the Syracuse Mets in the finale of their six-game set on Sunday at NBT Bank Stadium at 1:05 PM. With a series win, the Indians will have won back-to-back series at Syracuse dating back to July 23-25, 2019. It would be the first time Indy has won two straight sets at Syracuse since at least 2005 and the first time they have done so regardless of setting since taking two of three from June 10-12, 2016, and securing a four-game sweep from Aug. 10-13, 2017, both of which came at Victory Field. RHP Ryan Harbin will start the game for Indy as an opener before giving way to southpaw Hunter Barco. It will be Harbin's first career appearance against Syracuse and Barco's second after starting Tuesday's series opener. RHP Austin Warren will oppose Harbin and make his fourth Triple-A start of the season. He made his first career appearance against Indy on Thursday and exited after recording one out.

BARCO BUMP DAY: Hunter Barco, MiLB's No. 86 prospect according to MLB Pipeline, has not allowed more than one run in each of his last three starts since Aug. 7 vs. Omaha. Across those starts, he's pitched to a 0.82 ERA (1er/11.1ip) with 13 strikeouts, a 0.91 WHIP and a .200 batting average against (8-for-40). Dating back to the start of the second half on June 23, Barco has made 10 starts and ranks among Triple-A pitchers (min. 40.0ip) in opponent's batting average (3rd, .197), opponent's OPS (5th, .594) and ERA (7th, 2.81, 13er/41.2ip). Since his Triple-A debut on May 9, he holds the sixth-lowest opponent's batting average (.212, 48-for-226) and OPS (7th, .650). Additionally, he has held opposing right-handed hitters to a .168 batting average (24-for-143), the third lowest among Triple-A southpaws with at least 100 at bats against righties.

ON THIS DATE IN 1986: The Indians outlasted Nashville in a 15-inning, 4-hour and 18-minute marathon at Bush Stadium, 7-6. The Sounds led 5-2 midway through the eighth inning, but the Indians plated three runs in the bottom half to eventually force extras. Both teams were held scoreless until the 15th when the visitors plated one, only to see Indy respond with two in the home half and score the game-winning run on an extra-base hit by Rene Gonzalez. George Wright went yard with a team-high three hits, and Razor Shines went deep as well.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

2025 DAY-BY-DAY

Hunter Barco: The southpaw ranks as Pittsburgh's No. 4 prospect and Minor League Baseball's No. 86 overall prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

Historic Zeroes: Barco did not allow a run in his six starts with Double-A Altoona, totaling 25.2 consecutive scoreless innings to begin the season, marking the longest scoreless streak in Curve history.

Last Outing: Barco allowed one run on four hits an a walk while striking out four in 3.0 innings of work on Tuesday against Syracuse.

Against the Mets: Tuesday was Barco's first career appearance against Syracuse.

EAS Pitcher of the Month: Barco was awarded the 2025 Eastern League April Pitcher of the Month Award after leading the league (min. 20ip) in ERA (0.00, 20.2ip) and batting average against (.132, 9-for-68), while ranking second in WHIP (0.63) and tied for fourth in strikeouts (30).

Mowing Them Down: Barco finished his award-winning April with back-to-back eight-strikeout starts, the last of which came in just 3.0 innings of work on April 27 at Double-A Chesapeake. He became the first Pirates full-season farmhand to strike out eight or more batters in 3.0 innings or less since Osvaldo Bido also struck out eight in 3.0 innings vs. Triple-A Louisville on Aug. 4th, 2022.

Miscellaneous: Barco was selected by the Pirates in the second round (44th overall) of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Florida (Gainesville).
