### CIRCLE CITY ROUNDUP

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** Nick Solak reached base safely in four of his five plate appearances and Rafael Flores drove in a pair of two singles as the Indianapolis Indians defeated the Iowa Cubs, 5-2, on Saturday night at Victory Field. The Indians hopped out to a 2-0 lead on Flores' singles in the third and fifth innings. A two-out walk and subsequent pair of errors by Sammy Siani led to the I-Cubs first run in the seventh, but consecutive singles by Nelson Velázquez and Brett Sullivan in the bottom half extended the lead to 5-1. Iowa got one run back in the top of the eighth on an RBI single by Dixon Machado. Eddy Yean made his third consecutive start for the Indians and tossed 3.0 scoreless innings. Wilkin Ramos was the second arm out of the bullpen and continued to hold Iowa scoreless through the fifth inning. Starter Jaxon Wiggins surrendered the first Indians run and was chased after 2.2 innings.

**WINDIANAPOLIS:** The Indians 81 wins are their most in a season since winning 83 games in 2015. Indy owns a Triple-A best 49-25 (.662) record at home and it is the club's second-best home winning percentage to this point in the season since at least 2005, trailing only their 48-24 (.667) record at home through Sept. 14, 2012. 49 wins at Victory Field on the campaign matches 1997 for the most single-season wins at the venue in the Victory Field era (since 1996). With a win in the final home game this afternoon, Indy can set a new record of 50.

**CAPTAIN JACK:** Pirates outfielder Jack Suwinski joined the Indians on Thursday on an MLB rehab assignment, marking the 13th player to appear on a rehab assignment with the club on the campaign. He reached base safely four times in last night's contest, going 1-for-2 with two runs and a trio of walks. It matched his season high in free passes, last doing so on July 3 at Louisville. On Thursday, he launched his 13th home run of the season 110.7 mph to right field in the sixth inning on a fastball from fellow rehabber Michael Soroka. Suwinski was placed on the 10-day injured list on Aug. 29 with a right groin strain. The outfielder appeared in 53 games earlier this season with Indy from April 25-July 6 and ranked among International League hitters in that span in RBI (T-2nd, 48), home runs (T-7th, 12), runs scored (9th, 41) and OPS (10th, .926). He also led Indians' hitters across that stretch in walks (28), extra-base hits (23) and total bases (99). He has cranked 26 home runs in 134 games with the club, which is the most by an Indians hitter with fewer than 150 games played since at least 2005.

**YEAN SHORTS:** Eddy Yean provided another strong opening appearance last night, tossing a season-high tying 3.0 scoreless innings with one hit, two walks and one strikeout. He opened the game for the Indians on Tuesday night, tossing 3.0 scoreless innings. He struck out seven batters, his most since a career-high nine on June 25 (2) with Low-A Bradenton vs. Jupiter. Prior to Tuesday's outing, he had not struck out more than two batters in an outing since Aug. 7, 2024, with Double-A Altoona at Portland.

**BRANDAN BLANKS:** Brandon Bidiois tossed 2.0 scoreless and hitless innings in Tuesday's series opener and has now faced 64 consecutive batters without allowing a hit since July 29 with Double-A Altoona at Portland. Bidiois is yet to allow a hit or run in six games and 9.2 innings with Indy, walking five and striking out 13. Among all minor leaguers with at least 50.0 innings pitched, he has the lowest batting average against (.111, 21-for-190), lowest OPS against (.349), second-lowest ERA (0.78) and hits per nine (3.28). In addition to these stats, he has an 8-0 record across 37 total appearances in 2025.

**THE BIG DOMBKOWSKI:** LHP Nick Dombkowski dazzled on Friday night, posting career highs in innings (6.1) and strikeouts (11). He struck out seven of the first nine batters in the contest and did not allow a hit until the fifth inning. It was the most strikeouts by an Indians pitcher since Mike Burrows also struck out 11 on May 11 vs. Columbus. The southpaw has allowed two earned runs or fewer in four of his last five starts since Aug. 20.

**MVP:** The Indianapolis Indians announced on Saturday afternoon that utilityman Nick Solak has been named the team's 2025 Most Valuable Player after ranking among IL leaders in batting average (3rd, .325), on-base percentage (5th, .407), hits (5th, 127) and OPS (9th, .901) through Friday, Sept. 12. Right-handed pitchers Bubba Chandler and Eddy Yean, outfielder Matt Fraizer and infielder Tsung-Che Cheng were also recognized as award winners.

**WIN-AREZ:** RHP Valentin Linarez earned the win in his Triple-A debut with Indianapolis on Friday night, tossing 1.2 hitless innings with one hit batter, one walk and one strikeout. The 25-year-old appeared in 37 games with Double-A Altoona prior to being transferred to Indianapolis, posting a 3.16 ERA (20er/57.0ip), 1.16 WHIP and .192 opponent average.

**TODAY'S MATCHUP:** The Indianapolis Indians host their final home game of the 2025 season this afternoon at 1:35 PM against the Iowa Cubs. RHP Po-Yu Chen is set to take the mound for the Indians, making his second Triple-A start. Chen debuted for Indy on May 26 vs. Nashville, picking up the win with 5.0 scoreless innings. In 26 games (23 starts) with Double-A Altoona this season, he is 4-11 with a 5.73 ERA (63er/99.0ip). Opposite Chen is I-Cubs RHP Will Sanders. Sanders made one previous start against Indy on Aug. 1 at Iowa, in which he tossed 6.0 innings of two-run ball with eight strikeouts. Indy is 9-7 against Iowa on the campaign and secured its second consecutive season series over the club following a 13-5 record in 2024.

**ON THIS DATE IN 1994:** Casey Candaele, Kevin Maas and Will Pennyfeather all hit home runs in a 7-5 victory over Nashville, Triple-A affiliate of the Chicago White Sox, at Bush Stadium that gave Indy its first American Association title since completing a four-peat in 1989. The postseason championship was also Indianapolis' first as an affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds.
