## ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Dayton Dragons beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 5-3 at Neuroscience Group Field.](#)

Mat Nelson hit a solo homer in the top of the sixth inning to break a 3-3 tie. Dayton added an insurance run on an RBI single by Justice Thompson in the seventh. Wisconsin put two runners on with no outs in the bottom of the ninth, but Owen Holt stranded both runners to close out the game. Dayton has won three straight games in the series. The Dragons had eleven hits last night and have 55 hits in the series.

**EARLY ONSLAUGHT:** Robert Moore, Mike Boeve, and Brock Wilken had three straight singles to start the Wisconsin first inning to take a 1-0 lead. Hendry Mendez added a two-out, RBI single for a 2-0 advantage.

**PRESSURE POINTS:** The Dragons put their lead-off batter on base in seven of the nine innings. Additionally, of Dayton's eleven hits, they had seven extra-base hits with five doubles, a triple, and a homer.

**MISSED OPPORTUNITY:** Wilken tripped to open the bottom of the third inning. He was left stranded.

**BE LIKE MIKE:** Boeve tied the game 3-3 with a two-out, RBI single in the bottom of the fourth inning.

**A DRY SPELL:** John Murphy entered the game from the Dayton bullpen after the RBI single by Murphy in the fourth. He retired ten Rattlers in a row, including five by strikeout. Holt pitched a perfect eighth inning to make it thirteen consecutive Rattlers retired by Dayton pitching.

**ABOUT DAYTON:** The Dayton Dragons entered the Midwest League when the Rockford Reds moved to Ohio for the 2000 season. Dayton has been an affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds since 2000. Joey Votto, Johnny Cueto, Adam Dunn, Homer Bailey, Didi Gregorius, Nick Senzel, and Elly De La Cruz are just a few MLB players to play for the Dragons. The Dragons finished the first half 33-33 and missed the playoffs. Bryan LaHair is in his second season as the manager of the Dragons. LaHair appeared in 67 games with the Timber Rattlers during the 2004 season. He hit .279 with 24 doubles, five homers, and 28 RBI.

**ABOUT THE REDS:** The Cincinnati Reds have been the Major League parent club for the Dragons since 2000. The Reds had two MWL affiliates in 1999 (Rockford and Clinton) and 2000 (Dayton and Clinton). Cincinnati's first Midwest League affiliate was the Cedar Rapids Red Raiders in 1963 and 1964. The Reds left the Midwest League in 1964 before returning to Cedar Rapids in 1980 where they stayed until the end of the 1992 season. The Reds left the MWL for four seasons before returning to partner with the Burlington Bees in 1997 for two seasons before the partnership with Clinton and Rockford started.

**PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES:** [MLB Pipeline](#) places six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Brock Wilken (#8), Robert Moore (#17), Mike Boeve (#18), Bradley Blalock (#19), Matthew Wood (#25), and Hendry Mendez (#29). Eric Brown Jr (#12) is currently on Wisconsin's IL. [MLB Pipeline](#) has four Dayton players on their list of Top 30 Reds prospects: Edwin Arroyo (#3), Chase Petty (#7), Sal Stewart (#8), and Austin Hendrick (#29). Jay Allen II (#18) is on the Dayton IL.

## WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP EDWIN JIMENEZ:** Milwaukee signed Jimenez as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on October 11, 2018.

**HEADING TO THE CO-OP:** Jimenez was assigned to the Dominican Summer League Co-op team shared between Milwaukee and Cleveland for the 2019 season. Jimenez was 1-5 with a 3.05 ERA in twelve games – eight starts. He walked 26 and struck out 32 over 41-1/3 innings in his first professional season.

**FROM THE ISLAND TO THE DESERT:** Jimenez started the 2021 season with Milwaukee's number two affiliate in the Dominican Summer League. He was assigned to the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League on August 7, 2021. Jimenez went 1-1 with a 1.72 ERA in five games – four starts – in the DSL and 0-4 with a save and a 5.25 ERA in the ACL. He walked twelve and struck out 48 over 39-2/3 innings combined between his two stops in the system that season.

**CAROLINA ON MY MIND:** Jimenez was 4-7 in 25 games – seventeen starts – with the Carolina Mudcats in 2022. He had a 4.75 ERA, walked 41, and struck out 104 over 113-2/3 innings pitched in the Carolina League last season. Jimenez started the 2023 season with Carolina and went 2-0 in four games – one start – with five walks and 23 strikeouts over eighteen innings before his promotion to Wisconsin on May 2.

**PITCHER OF THE WEEK!** Jimenez was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week on July 31. He earned the award by striking out ten Cedar Rapids batters over 7-1/3 scoreless innings on [July 30](#). He walked three and didn't allow a hit until there was one out in the eighth inning.

**LAST START:** Jimenez lost at South Bend in game two of a doubleheader on [August 6](#). He allowed three runs on six hits with two walks, two hit batsmen, and three strikeouts over four innings.

**VS. DAYTON:** Jimenez lost at Dayton on [July 22](#). He allowed three runs on seven hits with a walk and four strikeouts over five innings.

## DAYTON SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP CARSON RUDD:** The Cincinnati Reds signed Rudd as a non-drafted free agent out of Stanford on September 4, 2020.

**CARDINAL RULE:** Rudd made 38 relief appearances at Stanford over three seasons, including the shortened 2020 season. He had no record, one save, an ERA of 4.36, 22 walks, and 30 strikeouts over 43-1/3 innings pitched during his collegiate career.

**CLEAR WATER:** Rudd pitched for the Eau Claire Express in the Northwoods League in 2018. He made nine appearances – seven starts – and was 3-3 with a 4.98 ERA with 38 strikeouts over 43-1/3 innings pitched.

**OUT EAST:** Rudd spent the summer of 2019 with the Newport Gulls in the New England Collegiate Baseball League. He had no record and a save with a 0.73 ERA and 23 strikeouts over 12-1/3 innings in eight relief appearances.

**TWO AT A TIME:** Rudd pitched in the ACL and Florida State League in 2021 and was 1-3 with a 5.51 ERA in seven games – four starts – in those two stops. In 2022, Rudd started out with Dayton but was sent back to Daytona in the FSL in July. He was 3-5 with three saves and a 5.72 ERA in 28 games – three starts last season. Rudd walked 30 and struck out 71 in 50-1/3 innings pitched in 2022.

**LAST START:** Rudd picked up the win against Beloit at home on [August 6](#). He allowed a run on three hits with two hit batsmen, no walks, and six strikeouts over five innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Rudd had a no decision against the Timber Rattlers at Dayton on [July 23](#). He allowed two runs on two hits with three walks and five strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings. Darrien Miller hit a home run against Rudd in that game.
