ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Timber Rattlers defeated the Beloit Sky Carp 6-3 in Beloit's home opener. Ernesto Martínez Jr and Darrien Miller each homered for Wisconsin and four Timber Rattlers pitchers combined for sixteen strikeouts.

FIRST: Wisconsin tallied a run in the top of the first inning last night when Sal Frelick scored from third on a wild pitch. That marked the first time the Rattlers scored first in a game this season.

ON THE COMEBACK: The Sky Carp took a 2-1 lead with single runs in the first and second innings. Zavier Warren tied the game with an RBI single in the third. Martínez followed with a two-run home run to give the Rattlers a 4-2 lead. Wisconsin has three comeback wins this season

SET THE BAR A BIT HIGHER: Starting pitcher Antoine Kelly set a new single-game high for strikeouts in a game as a pro for himself with nine strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings last night. Kelly walked four, allowed two runs on two hits, and had a no decision last night. His previous professional high was eight.

MAKE IT A SWEET SIXTEEN: Miguel Guerrero, who picked up the win in relief, had four strikeouts in three innings. Robbie Baker added one strikeout in 1-1/3 innings out of the Wisconsin bullpen. Cam Robinson had two strikeouts in a scoreless ninth for the save.

KING OF TRIOS: Carlos Rodríguez went 3-for-5 with a double, two stolen bases, and a run scored last night. It was the first three-hit game by a Rattler this season. FOUR! Frelick singled in the first inning last night. He has at least one hit in each of the first four games of the

season for the Rattlers. GENTLEMEN THIEVES: Wisconsin stole five bases last night. Rodríguez and Frelick each had two steals and Tristan Peters added one stolen base.

ERROR-FREE: Wisconsin's defense did not commit and error last night. It was their first errorless game of the season.

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp are in their first season as the Sky Carp and their second season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into Al Supply Stadium on August 3. Jorge Hernandez is in his first season as the manager of the Sky Carp.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have a history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for the 2021

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts eight Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Sal Frelick (#1), Tyler Black (#6), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Zavier Warren (#17), Carlos Rodríguez (#21), and Cam Robinson (#26). ## **■ PITCHING MATCHUPS**

### WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP RUSSELL SMITH:** Selected by the Brewers in the second round (51st overall selection) of the 2021 draft out of Texas Christian University. He is rated as he #16 prospect in the Brewers system by MLB Pipeline.

**AREA CODE:** Smith was picked as the Most Outstanding Player at the Area Code Games in 2016. He was also a four-year letter winner at Midlothian (TX) High School.

**THANK YOU, NO:** The Chicago Cubs picked Smith in the 38<sup>th</sup> round of the 2017 draft. He elected to honor a commitment to TCU.

**HORNED FROGS:** Smith was 7-3 with a 3.83 ERA in fifteen starts during his final season at TCU. He had 101 strikeouts in 82-1/3 innings pitched that season

MISSING TIME: Smith missed the 2019 season due to Tommy John Surgery and most of the 2020 season due to the pandemic shutdown.

**LAST START:** Smith started in the Fort Worth Regional of the NCAA tournament against Dallas Baptist on June 5, 2021 and had a no decision. He allowed two runs and struck out eight over five innings for a no decision against the Patriots in that game.

**VS. BELOIT:** Smith has never faced the Sky Carp prior to this evening. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Tonight is Smith's professional debut, too.

PROFESSIONAL BESTS: INNINGS PITCHED: STRIKEOUTS:

### BELOIT SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP PATRICK MONTEVERDE:** The Marlins selected Monteverde in the 8<sup>th</sup> round of the 2021 draft out of Texas Tech.

**RED RAIDER:** Monteverde was 7-4 with a 3.75 ERA in sixteen starts at Texas Tech. He walked 21 and struck out 101 in 86-1/3 innings pitched.

**BEFORE TEXAS:** Monteverde pitched for Virginia Wesleyan University in 2017 as went 7-2 with a 1.96 ERA to be named Rookie of the Year in the Old Dominion Athletic Conference. He transferred to Seton Hill University in Greensburg, PA for 2018 and suffered a UCL injury in 2019. Transferred to Texas Tech for 2021.

**TO THE PROS:** Monteverde went to the Marlins affiliate in the Florida Complex League after signing with Miami. He was 2-for-2 in save opportunities in six relief appearances last season. Monteverde also made one start. He had a 3.07 ERA, walked four, and struck out sixteen over 14-2/3 innings pitched as a pro last season.

**DID YOU KNOW:** Monteverde faced Russell Smith in a Big XII game between Texas Tech and TCU on May 28, 2021. TCU won the game 7-2. Smith allowed two runs on three hits and struck out ten for the win. Monteverde allowed four runs – two earned – on six hits with six strikeouts over six innings to take the loss.

**LAST START:** Monteverde had a no decision in a road game against the Mets Florida Complex League affiliate on August 20, 2021. He gave up an unearned run on four hits with two walks and five strikeouts over three innings for a no decision.

**VS. WISCONSIN**: Monteverde has never faced the Rattlers. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
