### ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers defeated the Great Lakes Loons 10-4 at Neuroscience Group Field.](#)

Joe Gray Jr. had four hits, including a home run, stole two bases, and scored two runs for the Rattlers. LG Castillo and Joey Wiemer also homered for Wisconsin. The Rattlers rallied from a 4-2 deficit with five runs in the bottom of the fifth inning. The Wisconsin defense turned three double plays last night.

**GRAY AREA:** Gray recorded his first four-hit game as a professional last night. He has five homers and 25 RBI in 31 games with Wisconsin. Gray has 17 homers, an OPS of .949, and 78 RBI in 82 games between Carolina and Wisconsin this year.

**POWER SURGE:** Wiemer has homered in three straight games with the Timber Rattlers. He has hit at least one homer in six of his last eight games between Carolina and Wisconsin. Wiemer has seven homers in his last eight games.

**OH, WHAT A RELIEF IT IS:** Wisconsin relievers covered four scoreless innings again last night. Nash Walters worked a scoreless sixth; Evan Reifert pitched two scoreless frames; and Taylor Floyd closed out the game with a scoreless ninth. Wisconsin's bullpen has combined for 15 innings in the first four games of the series. They have allowed one run and recorded 25 strikeouts in the series.

**ABOUT GREAT LAKES:** The Great Lakes Loons came into existence in 2007 after the Midwest League team left Battle Creek at the end of the 2006 season. The team in Battle Creek had been known as the Michigan Battle Cats, Battle Creek Yankees, and the Southwest Michigan Devil Rays. The Loons have been affiliated with the Los Angeles Dodgers since 2007. They made the Midwest League playoffs seven times between 2007 and 2019. The Loons won the Midwest League title in 2016. Notable Great Lakes alumni include Clayton Kershaw, Kenley Jansen, Nathan Eovaldi, Joc Peterson, Julio Urias, Walker Buehler, and Gavin Lux.

**ABOUT THE DODGERS:** The Los Angeles Dodgers were only in the Midwest League for a few seasons prior to affiliating with the Loons. They were in Dubuque in 1967 and in Clinton from 1977 to 1979. Orel Hershiser and Steve Sax were notable Dodgers to play in Clinton.

**GREAT LAKES IN 2019:** The Loons had the best record in the Midwest League in 2019. They were 81-55 in the regular season but were swept in the Eastern Division Finals by the South Bend Cubs.

**GREAT LAKES IN 2021:** The Loons are 46-42 and tied with the Cedar Rapids Kernels and have dropped two games behind Cedar Rapids for the second playoff spot in the High-A Central League. Great Lakes is facing a team from the Western Division for the first time this season by playing the Timber Rattlers. They lead the league in homers (132) and are second in OPS (.793) and average (.253). The Loons pitchers are third in the league in ERA (4.10).

**PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES:** [MLB Pipeline](#) puts five Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Xavier Warren (#11), Carlos Rodriguez (#14), Hayden Cantrelle (#16), Nick Kahle (#19), and Joe Gray Jr. (#30). [MLB Pipeline](#) has four current Loons on their list of Dodgers prospects: Andy Pages (#6), Clayton Beeter (#10), Leonel Valera (#23), and Hyun-Il Choi (#25). Bobby Miller (#3) and Robinson Ortiz (#20) are currently on the Great Lakes Injured List.

## WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER

**RHP JUSTIN JARVIS:** Selected by Milwaukee in the 5<sup>th</sup> round of the 2018 draft out of Lake Norman High School in Mooresville, North Carolina.

**THE SENIOR SEASON:** In his final season of high school, Jarvis was 8-2 with a 1.60ERA, and 95 strikeouts. Former Major Leaguer Ty Wigginton was his head coach.

**A PERFECT DAY:** Jarvis pitched a perfect game with 18 strikeouts in a game against East Rowan High School early in his senior season of high school.

**NOT ON CAMPUS:** Jarvis signed with the Brewers over a commitment to UNC-Wilmington.

**YEAR ONE:** Jarvis was 1-2 with a 6.63ERA in ten games – three starts – for Milwaukee's Arizona League affiliate after signing last season. He walked four and struck out 18 over 19 innings pitched in the Arizona League.

**2019:** Jarvis was 4-1 with a 3.50 ERA in 18 games – eleven starts – for the Timber Rattlers in 2019. He had 52 strikeouts over 74-2/3 innings.

**LAST START:** Jarvis had a no decision [at Beloit on August 5](#). He allowed two hits and struck out three over two scoreless innings. It was his first start in a game since June 29.

**VS. GREAT LAKES:** Jarvis has never faced the Loons prior to this evening. This is also the first time he will face an affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers.

## GREAT LAKES SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP HYUN-IL CHOI:** The Dodgers signed Choi as an International Free Agent out of the South Korea on August 24, 2018.

**STRIKING DEBUT:** Choi began his professional career with the Dodgers Mota affiliate in the Arizona League in 2019. He led the league in strikeouts with 71 in 65 innings pitched.

**NUMBERS GAME:** Choi was 5-1 with a 2.63ERA in 14 games – 11 starts – and walked just eleven in the AZL in 2019.

**QUAKING:** Choi started the 2021 season with the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes in the Low-A West. He was 8-3 with a 3.17 ERA in 15 games – two starts. Choi had 75 strikeouts and seven walks over 65-1/3 innings with Rancho Cucamonga.

**LAST START:** Choi had a no decision against [the Fort Wayne TinCaps on August 8](#). He allowed two runs on five hits with no walks and three strikeouts over four innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Choi has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. In 2019, he made two appearances against the Brewers Blue and two appearances against the Brewers Gold in the Arizona League. Choi was 2-0 and allowed five runs on 18 hits with four walks and 16 strikeouts over 17 innings against both Brewers affiliates.
