### **INDY BITS**

ABOUT SUNDAY: A sacrifice fly by Spencer Horwitz and an RBI single from Nick Solak in the third inning plated both Indianapolis Indians runs in a 2-0 shutout win over the Columbus Clippers on Sunday afternoon at Victory Field. Starting pitcher Mike Burrows struck out a career-high 11 batters across 4.2 scoreless frames. Back-to-back singles in the third frame by Tsung-Che Cheng and Nick Yorke set up the Indians for victory, with Horwitz and Solak bringing them both home to give Indianapolis a game-deciding two-run lead. Following Mike Burrows' stellar start, Randy Labaut posted 1.2 scoreless innings with one walk, recording all five outs via strikeout. Labaut passed the baton to Carson Fulmer who posted 1.2 shutout frames of his own before Eddy Yean (S, 4) closed the door with a scoreless ninth inning for his fourth save and ninth consecutive scoreless appearance.

MIKE DROP: Mike Burrows posted a career-high 11 strikeouts in his start on Sunday afternoon vs. Columbus, setting up the Indians for their third shutout of the season with 4.2 innings, four hits and two walks. He became the first Indians pitcher in the Victory Field era to post 11 strikeouts in 4.2 innings or fewer. He earned his first win of the season in Tuesday's series opener, tossing 5.0 innings of one-run ball with two hits, no walks and seven strikeouts. The lone run allowed was a solo home run to C.J. Kayfus in the second inning. In three games (two starts) in May, Burrows owns a 0.71 ERA (1er/12.2ip) with seven hits, three walks and 23 strikeouts.

'PEN IS MIGHTY: The Indians bullpen has shined in the series against Columbus, posting a 0.62 ERA (2er/29.0ip) across six games. Indy relievers have a 0.72 WHIP and .130 opponent average (12-for-92) in this span with 38 strikeouts. They have converted on all four save opportunities and the lone runs were solo homers. Nine of 16 total pitchers used in the series did not allow runs.

YEAN SHORTS: Eddy Yean picked up his fourth save of the season on Sunday, stranding the tying runs on-base with a scoreless ninth inning in the Indians 2-0 win over Columbus. Yean extended his scoreless outing streak to nine games, marking the longest run by an Indians pitcher this season and the fifth-longest active run in the International League. In this span, he has blanked opponents across 11.1 innings with 10 hits, seven walks, eight strikeouts and four saves. This, opposed to allowing four runs, five hits, five walks and just one strikeout in his first 2 1 innings this season.

PAIR O' PIRATES: First baseman Spencer Horwitz and right-handed pitcher Dauri Moreta had their rehab assignments transferred to Indianapolis on Tuesday last week. Horwitz was placed on the 10-day injured list on March 27, retroactive to March 24, after undergoing right wrist surgery on Feb. 12. Moreta was placed on the 60-day injured list on Feb. 16 after undergoing Tommy John surgery and being sidelined for the entire 2024 season. Nearly 14 months after his last professional appearance, the right-hander began a rehab assignment with High-A Bradenton on April 29 and tossed 2.0 scoreless innings in two games. Horwitz went 0-for-2 with a sacrifice fly and one RBI on Sunday. In four games on the rehab stint, Horwitz is hitting. 222 (4-for-18) with one double, one RBI and one run. He posted multi-hit efforts on Tuesday and Saturday. Moreta threw 1.1 innings on Friday night, allowing one run with one hit, one walk and two strikeouts. He tossed a scoreless sixth inning on Tuesday with one walk, striking out the side.

SOLAK ECLIPSE: Nick Solak is on a scorching run to begin the 2025 season, ranking among International League leaders in batting average (.385, 38-for-99, 1st), OBP (.446, 3rd), OPS (1.042, 4th) and SLG (.596, 5th). He went 1-for-3 with an RBI single on Sunday, extending his hitting streak to five games. He has reached base safely in 26 of 29 games this season and has one-plus hit in 25 of those, including a team best 13-game hitting streak from April 3-23. Solak hit. 400 (20-for-50) with two doubles, three home runs, 11 RBI, four walks, 11 runs, three stolen bases and a 1.056 OPS in that span, with that streak being tied for the third longest in the International League this season. He struck out just seven times across 55 plate appearances during the hitting streak. He was named the Indians April Player of the Month on Friday after he led the team in batting average, hits, total bases, home runs, RBI, on-base percentage, slugging percentage and OPS across 20 games. Solak hit. 394 (28-for-71) with 16 runs, two doubles, five home runs, 14 RBI, six walks, three stolen bases and a 1.070 OPS in April. In addition to his team-leading marks, he ranked among International League qualifiers in batting average (2nd), OPS (4th), slugging percentage (5th, 634), hits (T-6th) and on-base percentage (7th, 436). His batting average was the highest by an Indians batter in a single month since Gregory Polanco hit. 400 in April 2014. He reached base safely in 19 of 20 games in April.

**TONIGHT'S MATCHUP:** The Indianapolis Indians continue their 12-game homestand and begin a six-game series against the Louisville Bats tonight at 6:35 PM. The two teams meet for the second time this season, with a 3-3 series split from April 8-13. Minor League Baseball's No. 2 overall prospect, Bubba Chandler, is set to make his eighth start of the season. In his last start vs. Columbus on May 7, Chandler took his first loss in 14 career starts with Indianapolis. He tossed just 2.2 innings, allowing season highs in runs (three), hits (five) and walks (four). Chandler is 1-0 in three career starts opposite Louisville, posting a 1.38 ERA (2er/13.0ip), six hits, four walks and 19 strikeouts. Tonight is set to be his third start against the club this season. Opposite Chandler is Bats right-hander Aaron Wilkerson. Wilkerson earned the win against Indy in Game 2 on April 12, tossing 5.0 shutout innings with four hits and four strikeouts. In two career starts against the Indians, he is 2-0 with a 0.77 ERA (1er/11.2ip), seven hits, two walks and 13 strikeouts.

PITCHER OF THE MONTH: On May 5, Bubba Chandler was named the 2025 International League April Pitcher of the Month. after he led all minor league pitchers with at least 20.0 innings in fewest hits allowed (seven) and batting average against (.106, 7-for-66). He is the first Indianapolis Indians pitcher to win a league monthly award since Zach Duke in May 2005. He went 1-0 with a 1.33 ERA (3er/20.1ip), 27 strikeouts and a 0.64 WHIP across five starts in the month. In addition to his minor league leading marks, he led IL pitchers with at least 20.0 innings in WHIP and finished third in ERA.

ON THIS DATE IN 1998: Indianapolis prevailed in a 1-0 win over Pawtucket at Victory Field. The Tribe out-hit the Red Sox, 6-2, with Tribe starter Rodney Bolton tossing 7.0 one-hit innings to earn the win. Pawtucket's starter, Brian Barkley, went the distance in the loss. The game was the shortest 9.0-inning game in Victory Field history at 1:49.
