LAST ACTION: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the South Bend Cubs 15-12 on Sunday afternoon at Neuroscience Group Field. The Cubs scored in eight of the nine innings, but Wisconsin rallied from 5-1 and 7-4 deficits with three home runs. Sunday's win gave the Rattlers a series split to avoid their first series loss since May. Wisconsin is 15-2 with two splits in series this

GOING DEEP: Eduardo Garcia hit a three-run home run in the third inning to pull Wisconsin to within 5-4. Jadher Areinamo hit a three-run homer in the sixth inning to give Wisconsin an 8-7 lead. Ramón Rodríguez cracked a two-run homer in the seventh for a 10-8 lead. Wisconsin has hit three homers in a game five times this season.

A PLUS: Areinamo was activated off the Wisconsin IL on Friday. He is 5-for-9 with two homers, two doubles, and five RBI in the two games he has played since Friday. Areinamo leads the Midwest League in doubles (26) and average (.312), second in hits (104), and third in RBI (60).

ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo (1969-1976), Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

# PITCHING MATCHUP

#### WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP PATRICIO AQUINO: The Milwaukee Brewers signed Aquino as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on January 15, 2021.

**LET'S GET IT STARTED:** Aquino made his professional debut with the Brewers #1 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2021. He made eleven starts and was 1-2 with a 2.66 ERA and 54 strikeouts in 44 innings pitched.

**LET'S GO TO ARIZONA:** Aquino was 2-1 with a 4.72 ERA in eight games – seven starts – for the Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League during the 2022 season. He had 49 strikeouts over 34-1/3 innings pitched.

**ON TO CAROLINA:** Aquino was 5-3 with a 2.75 ERA in 21 games – 19 starts – with 86 strikeouts over 88-1/3 innings pitched during the 2023 regular season.

**PLAYOFF CALL:** Aquino was the starting pitcher for the Mudcats in Game Two of the first round Carolina League playoff series against the Down East Wood Ducks. He had a no decision with six scoreless innings. The Mudcats would lose the game 6-5 in ten innings.

**HOW DOES HE RATE?** MLB Pipeline rates Aquino as the #28 prospect in the Brewers organization.

**LAST START:** Aquino had a no decision at home against South Bend on July 31. He pitched five scoreless innings, walked none, and struck out one.

VS. QUAD CITIES: Aquino has made two appearances – one start – against the River Bandits this season. He has allowed one run on four hits with two hit batsmen, three walks, and seven strikeouts over eight innings. Aquino earned the save with four scoreless innings at home on June 8.

#### **QUAD CITIES STARTING PITCHER:**

**LHP RYAN RAMSEY:** The Kansas City Royals selected Ramsey in the 13<sup>th</sup> round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Maryland.

**TURTLE SOUP:** Ramsey pitched three seasons at Maryland and was 17-2 with two saves and a 3.36 ERA in 36 games – sixteen starts. He walked 58 and struck out 140 in 135 innings for the Terrapins.

**NO TO THE LAND:** Cleveland selected Ramsey in the 36<sup>th</sup> round of the 2019 draft out of Pascack Hills (NJ) High School. He chose to go to Maryland.

**THE VINYARD:** Ramsey pitched for the Martha's Vineyard Sharks of the New England Collegiate Baseball League in 2021 and was 2-0 with a 1.88 ERA in six games – five starts.

**LEVELING UP:** Ramsey made his pro debut with the ACL Royals with one appearance in 2022. In 2023, he pitched in the ACL, with Columbia in the Carolina League, and with Quad Cities. Ramsey was 3-3 with a 3.83 ERA in fourteen games – ten starts – with 69 strikeouts over 51-2/3 innings pitched overall. Ramsey was 1-2 with a 10.67 ERA in five games – two starts – for the River Bandits after he was called up on August 7, 2023.

**LAST START:** Ramsey won at Peoria on <u>July 31</u>. He allowed two hits, hit a batter, walked one, and struck out five over five scoreless innings against the Chiefs.

VS. WISCONSIN: Ramsey pitched four scoreless innings of relief against the Timber Rattlers at Modern Woodmen Park on May 9. He allowed one hit, hit two batters, walked one, and struck out three in that game and earned the save. On June 9 at Wisconsin, Ramsey allowed a run on three hits with four walks and four strikeouts over five scoreless innings as the starter for a no decision.
