ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Beloit Sky Carp 3-2 at ABC Supply Stadium. Kay-Lan Nicasia hit a two-out, two-run home run in the top of the sixth inning to put the Timber Rattlers up 2-1. Hedbert Pérez added a two-out, RBI single in the top of the seventh. The Sky Carp scored a run in the bottom of the ninth but left the tying run at third base.

GOING DEEP: Wisconsin trailed 1-0 with two outs and none on in the top of the sixth inning. Nick Brink had pitched 5-2/3 scoreless innings as the starting pitcher for the Sky Carp before leaving the game for Justin Storm. Blake Burke singled against Storm to keep the inning alive. Nicasia followed with a homer to right-center for his first home run since April 10 to give the Rattlers the lead.

LIKE A GOOD NEIGHBOR: Pérez gave Wisconsin a 3-1 lead with his single in the seventh. That would provide the winning margin for the Rattlers. Wisconsin is 14-10 in one-run games this season.

YEOMAN'S WORK: Wisconsin starting pitcher Manuel Rodriguez pitched two innings in his second start off the injured list. He allowed one hit, a lead-off home run by Eric Rataczak in the second inning. Stiven Cruz took over in the third and pitched 4-1/3 scoreless innings of relief with two walks and four strikeouts to keep Wisconsin within striking distance.

BRAVO BROCA! Jesús Broca relieved Cruz with a runner at second and one out in the seventh inning. He stranded the runner at third. In the eighth, Broca allowed two singles with two outs before getting the final out. In the ninth, the Sky Carp had runners at second and third with one out. He allowed a run but earned his third save of the season.

FLASHING THE LEATHER: Wisconsin played an errorless game on Tuesday. They also turned a double play in the fourth inning. The Rattlers lead the Midwest League in double plays (79) and are tied for second in fielding percentage (.978).

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's fourth season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Angel Espada is in his first season as the manager of the Sky Carp. Bill Hall, Prince Fielder, Rickie Weeks, Chris Bosio, Greg Vaughn, Joey Meyer, BJ Surhoff, Tim Dillard, Mitch Stetter, and Matt Chapman played in Beloit.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places five Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Bishop Letson (#14), Blake Burke (#17), Jadher Areinamo (#23), Juan Baez (#26), and Manuel Rodriguez (#29). MLB Pipeline has five Beloit players on their Top 30 list of Marlins prospects: Noble Meyer (#4), Echedry Vargas (#16), Gage Miller (#21), Karson Milbrandt (#24), and Brayan Mendoza (#30).

■ PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

LHP SAM GARCIA: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Garcia in the eighth round of the 2024 draft out of Oklahoma State.

HITTING THE HIGH POINT: Garcia pitched three seasons at High Point University from 2021 through 2023. He was a First Team All-Big South selection after his sophomore season when he was 5-4 with a save and a 1.94 ERA in sixteen games – eight starts.

STILLWATER: Garcia pitched for Brewster of the Cape Cod League in 2023 and transferred to Oklahoma State University for his final season of collegiate baseball. As a Cowboy, Garcia was 7-3 with a 3.64 ERA in sixteen starts. He had 115 strikeouts over 89 innings.

STARTING OUT: Garcia did not pitch professionally last year. He made his pro debut with the Carolina Mudcats this season and was 5-1 with a save and a 2.08 ERA in ten appearances – two starts. Garcia walked nineteen and struck out 44 in 34-2/3 innings with Carolina before his promotion to Wisconsin on June 3.

LAST START: Garcia lost to Quad Cities at home on <u>June 26</u>. He allowed one run on two hits with two walks and six strikeouts over five innings. The only run he allowed was a solo home run by Bryan Gonzalez in the second inning. Garcia warmed up for the top of the sixth inning, but a 50-minute rain delay started before he could make a pitch in the frame.

VS. BELOIT: Garcia has never faced the Sky Carp before tonight. This evening is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Miami Marlins.

BELOIT STARTING PITCHER:

RHP WILL SCHOMBERG: Acquired by the Miami Marlins in a trade with the Seattle Mariners for JT Chargois on July 30, 2024.

ON THE SEA: The Mariners originally signed Schomberg as a non-drafted free agent on July 22, 2023. He had pitched collegiately at Davidson University. Schomberg was 12-4 with a 4.55 ERA in 52 games – fifteen starts – in four years at Davidson. He pitched for Everett and Modesto in the Seattle system last season before the trade to Miami.

DRAFT POSITION: Schomberg pitched two seasons in the MLB Draft League. He made ten relief appearances for West Virginia in 2022 and six appearances – two starts – for Williamsport in 2023.

ON WISCONSIN: Schomberg made six starts with Beloit after the trade in 2024. He was 1-3 with a 7.13 ERA, walked 23 and struck out 32 in 24 innings with the Sky Carp.

LAST START: Schomberg had a no decision at Peoria on <u>June 25</u>. He allowed three runs on four hits with two walks and a strikeout over 3-2/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Schomberg had a no decision at Neuroscience Group Field on May 18. He allowed four runs – three earned – on seven hits with a walk and three strikeouts over 2-2/3 innings.
