SUNDAY AFTERNOON: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Cedar Rapids Kernels 6-4 at Perfect Game Field.](#)

Wisconsin hit three home runs in the game for the second game in a row.

BALANCED AS ALL THINGS SHOULD BE: The Kernels won games one, three, and five. The Rattlers won games two, four, and six.

GOING DEEP: Tyler Black and Carlos Rodriguez hit back-to-back solo homers with two outs in the top of the second inning for a 3-0 lead. Tristan Peters gave Wisconsin a 6-2 lead with a two-out, three-run home run in the fourth. Black and Peters have homers in two straight games.

SIX-PACK: Rodriguez went 10-for-23 and had at least one hit in all six games of the series at Cedar Rapids. Rodriguez had to leave Sunday's game with an injury.

FIRST! Ryne Moore was the Wisconsin starting pitcher on Sunday. He allowed three runs – one earned – over six innings and earned his first professional victory.

A MERRY MONTH OF MAY: Cam Robinson pitched into and out of a bases-loaded jam in the bottom of the ninth on Sunday and escaped without allowing a run for his ninth save of the season. Robinson made nine relief appearances, allowed no runs, walked five, allowed five hits and struck out nineteen over fifteen scoreless innings while going 6-for-6 in save opportunities. Robinson has a scoreless streak of 15-1/3 innings.

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1957 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1956 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels in 1983. They changed their name to the Chiefs and their affiliation to the Chicago Cubs for the 1984 season. They became a Cardinals affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his first year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, and Yadier Molina.

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) puts seven Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Tyler Black (#6), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Xavier Warren (#17), Carlos Rodriguez (#21), and Cam Robinson (#26). [MLB Pipeline](#) has three current Chiefs on their list of Cardinals prospects – one active and two on the injured list: Austin Love (#20) is on the active list. Ian Bedell (#21) and Jhon Torres (#23) are on the Peoria Injured List.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JUSTIN JARVIS: Selected by Milwaukee in the 5th round of the 2018 draft out of Lake Norman High School in Mooresville, North Carolina.

THE SENIOR SEASON: In his final season of high school, Jarvis was 8-2 with a 1.60ERA, and 95 strikeouts. Former Major Leaguer Ty Wigginton was his head coach.

A PERFECT DAY: Jarvis pitched a perfect game with 18 strikeouts in a game against East Rowan High School early in his senior season of high school.

NOT ON CAMPUS: Jarvis signed with the Brewers over a commitment to UNC-Wilmington.

YEAR ONE: Jarvis was 1-2 with a 6.63ERA in ten games – three starts – for Milwaukee's Arizona League affiliate after signing with Milwaukee. He walked four and struck out 18 over 19 innings pitched in the Arizona League.

2019: Jarvis was 4-1 with a 3.50 ERA in 18 games – eleven starts – for the Timber Rattlers in 2019. He had 52 strikeouts over 74-2/3 innings.

2021: Jarvis was 1-7 with a 5.40 ERA in seventeen starts for the Timber Rattlers in 2021. He had 62 strikeouts over 63-1/3 innings.

LAST START: Jarvis [won at Cedar Rapids on May 25](#). He allowed two hits, walked two, and struck out nine over 6-2/3 scoreless innings.

VS. PEORIA (2022): Jarvis is 0-1 in two starts against the Chiefs this season. He was the starter at home [on April 9](#) and at Peoria [on April 30](#). Jarvis has allowed ten runs – eight earned – on ten hits with five walks and six strikeouts over eight innings against the Chiefs this season. Peoria has hit three homers off Jarvis in 2022.

PEORIA SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ZANE MILLS: The St. Louis Cardinals drafted Mills out of Washington State University with their fourth-round selection in the 2021 draft.

LET'S GO COUGARS: Mills went 5-5 with a 4.15 ERA and 83 strikeouts in 80-1/3 innings pitched in thirteen starts in his final season at Washington State. He was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Week twice in 2021.

IT'S COMPLEX: Mills made seven relief appearances for the Florida Complex League affiliate of the Cardinals after signing his professional contract. Mills allowed a run on four hits with no walks, two hit batsmen, and nine strikeouts over 7-2/3 innings pitched.

PALM READER: Mills started 2022 with the Palm Beach Cardinals in the Florida State League. He was 1-2 with a 3.48 ERA in seven starts with seven walks and 35 strikeouts over 41-1/3 innings before his promotion to Peoria on May 23.

LAST START: Mills [lost to Lake County at home on May 25 in his Midwest League debut](#). He allowed four runs on seven hits and two walks with no strikeouts over five innings against the Captains.

VS. WISCONSIN: Mills has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. Mills is making his first ever appearance against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers tonight.
