WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON: [The Quad Cities River Bandits beat the Quad Cities River Bandits 7-6 at Neuroscience Group Field.](#)

Dionmy Salon had five RBI for the Bandits. Wisconsin scored five runs in the first inning before an out was recorded. Jader Areinamo started the scoring with an RBI single. Blake Burke had a two-run double. Yhoswar Garcia added an RBI triple, and Luiyin Alastre capped the inning with an RBI single. The River Bandits scored twice in the fifth on a two-run double by Salon. The game was halted by rain for 92 minutes in the bottom of the sixth. When play resumed, Alastre's sacrifice fly in the bottom of the sixth gave Wisconsin a 6-2 lead. Salon had a sacrifice fly in the seventh. In the eighth, the Bandits scored runs on a bases-loaded walk and a sacrifice fly before Salon drove in two more runs with a two-out double the lead.

BAKER'S DOZEN: Jader Areinamo is on a thirteen-game hitting streak after he went 2-for-4 with an RBI yesterday. He is 22-for-52 (.423) during the streak. Areinamo has six doubles, two homers, sixteen RBI, and nine runs scored with a 1.074 OPS during the streak. Areinamo has the longest hitting streak by a Rattler this season.

WELCOME BACK: Manuel Rodriguez was the starting pitcher for the Timber Rattlers yesterday after being activated off the IL earlier in the day. The start was his first since April 27. Rodriguez hit the first batter of the game with his first pitch before getting a strikeout and a 3-6-3 double play. He pitched a perfect second inning to end his day with 21 pitches (14 strikes).

ON THE RUN: Yhoswar Garcia stole third base just before the rain delay on Wednesday. It was his 33rd steal of the season. He is second in the Midwest League in steals with Kyle DeBarge of Cedar Rapids as the leader with 40 stolen bases this season.

JUST A COINCIDENCE: The three games between Wisconsin and Quad Cities played at Neuroscience Group Field have finished with a 7-6 final score.

ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo (1969-1976), Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

LHP SAM GARCIA: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Garcia in the eighth round of the 2024 draft out of Oklahoma State.

HITTING THE HIGH POINT: Garcia pitched three seasons at High Point University from 2021 through 2023. He was a First Team All-Big South selection after his sophomore season when he was 5-4 with a save and a 1.94 ERA in sixteen games – eight starts.

STILLWATER: Garcia pitched for Brewster of the Cape Cod League in 2023 and transferred to Oklahoma State University for his final season of collegiate baseball. As a Cowboy, Garcia was 7-3 with a 3.64 ERA in sixteen starts. He had 115 strikeouts over 89 innings.

STARTING OUT: Garcia did not pitch professionally last year. He made his pro debut with the Carolina Mudcats this season and was 5-1 with a save and a 2.08 ERA in ten appearances – two starts. Garcia walked nineteen and struck out 44 in 34-2/3 innings with Carolina before his promotion to Wisconsin on June 3.

LAST START: Garcia lost at West Michigan on [June 20](#). He allowed four runs – three earned – on five hits with a walk and four strikeouts over five innings.

VS. QUAD CITIES: Garcia has never faced the River Bandits before tonight. Garcia lost to Columbia, the Carolina League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals, on [April 25, 2025](#). He allowed three runs on four hits with four walks, a hit batsman, and five strikeouts over four innings.

QUAD CITIES STARTING PITCHER:

RHP LOGAN MARTIN: The Kansas City Royals selected Martin in the 12th round of the 2023 draft out of the University of Kentucky.

WILD CAT: Martin was 1-1 in nine games – eight starts – for Kentucky in 2023, his only season at the SEC school. Martin had a 4.44 ERA with 30 strikeouts in 26-1/3 innings.

WHERE DID HE COME FROM? Martin pitched three years at Sewanee: The University of the South, an NCAA Division III school of the Southern Athletic Association in Sewanee, Tennessee before transferring to Kentucky. In 2022, his final season of DIII ball, Martin had 98 strikeouts in 69-1/3 innings with a 1-5 record and a 3.89 ERA.

LAST START: Martin beat Lansing 1-0 at home on [June 20](#). He allowed one run on six hits with no walks and four strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Martin made two starts against Wisconsin at Modern Woodmen Park – [April 8](#) and [April 13](#) – earlier this season. He was 0-1 in those starts. Martin allowed three runs on seven hits with three walks and eleven strikeouts over 9-1/3 innings versus the Rattlers.
