### ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Cedar Rapids Kernels beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 10-1 at Perfect Game Field.](#)

Jeferson Morales broke a 1-1 tie with a grand slam in the bottom of the fourth inning.

**POWER SURGE:** Joey Wiemer tied the game 1-1 with a solo home run in the top of the fourth. Wiemer's homer was his fifth since joining the Timber Rattlers. He was 2-for-3 last night and has extended his current hitting streak to seven games (12-for-25, .480).

**MULTI-BALL:** Felix Valerio and Carlos Rodríguez each had two hits last night for the Rattlers. Both had a single and a double. Rodríguez has seventeen multi-hit games with Wisconsin this season.

**SIX-PACK:** Last night was the sixth grand slam allowed by Wisconsin pitching this season. The Timber Rattlers have allowed three of those bases-loaded homers to the Kernels.

**A STREAK:** Wisconsin pitchers have allowed at least one home run in ten straight games. The Timber Rattlers have allowed 22 homers in the last ten games. Wisconsin has allowed 119 home runs this season, the most in the High-A Central League.

**ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS:** The Cedar Rapids Kernels are charter members of the High-A Central League. The current franchise began its existence as the Cedar Rapids Braves, an affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves in the Three-I League in 1958. That was the same year and league the current Timber Rattlers franchise joined the Three-I League as the Fox Cities Foxes. Both teams moved to the Midwest League when the Three-I League ended after the 1961 season. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels made the Midwest League playoffs every year they were affiliated with the Twins. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, Trevor Hoffman, and Ted Simmons.

**ABOUT THE TWINS:** Minnesota's former High-A Affiliate was the Fort Myers Miracle in the Florida State League. From 1995 through 2019, the Twins were affiliated with four teams in the Midwest League. They were with the Fort Wayne Wizards (1995-1998), Quad City River Bandits (1999-2005), Beloit Snappers (2006-2012), and Cedar Rapids Kernels (2013-2019)

**PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES:** [MLB Pipeline](#) puts four Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Xavier Warren (#11), Carlos Rodríguez (#14), Nick Kahle (#19), and Joe Gray Jr. (#30). [MLB Pipeline](#) has six Kernels on their list of Twins prospects: Matt Canterino (#7), Matt Wallner (#12), Wander Javier (#21), Seth Gray (#24), and Yunior Severino (#28), and Louie Varland (#30). Blayne Enlow (#11) and Luis Rijo (#25) are currently on the Kernels injured list.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP BRANDON KNARR:** The Brewers signed Knarr as a non-drafted free agent out of the University of Tampa on July 17, 2020.

**GOLDEN DOME:** Knarr pitched at Notre Dame as a freshman and appeared in twelve games.

**TO FLORIDA:** Knarr spent his sophomore season at the College of Central Florida. He was 6-1 with 86 strikeouts and an ERA of 4.66 over 65-2/3 innings in sixteen games – thirteen starts.

**TAMPA, TOO:** Knarr transferred to the University of Tampa for the 2019-2020 season and was 4-1 with 64 strikeouts and a 2.55 ERA over 35-1/3 innings pitched in six starts before the shutdown.

**IN THE MUD:** Knarr started the 2021 season with the Carolina Mudcats. He was 7-2 with 103 strikeouts over 75 innings and an ERA of 3.84 in sixteen games – thirteen starts – before his promotion to Wisconsin on August 17.

**LAST START:** Knarr won [at Down East on August 11](#). He allowed a run on two hits with four walks and seven strikeouts over five innings.

**VS. CEDAR RAPIDS:** Knarr has never faced the Kernels prior to this evening. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Minnesota Twins.

## CEDAR RAPIDS SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP TYLER WATSON:** The Twins acquired Watson from the Washington Nationals in a trade on July 31, 2017. Minnesota sent reliever Brandon Kintzler to Washington for Watson and future considerations.

**GOING NATIONAL:** Watson was originally selected by Washington in the 34<sup>th</sup> round of the 2015 draft out of Perry High School in Gilbert, Arizona.

**CLIMBING THE CORPORATE LADDER:** Watson started his pro career with the Gulf Coast League Nationals in 2015, split time between the Auburn Doubledays in the New York-Penn League and the Hagerstown Suns in the South Atlantic League in 2016, and the Suns for 18 games – 17 starts – in 2017.

**WELCOME TO IOWA:** Watson joined the Kernels after the trade and went 1-3 in five starts for Cedar Rapids to close out the 2017 season. He also made a start during the Kernels playoff run for a no decision in 2017.

**TWO-YEAR TIME FRAME:** Watson made 18 appearances – 17 starts – for the Kernels and four starts for the Fort Myers Miracle of the Florida State League in 2018. He spent the entire 2019 season with Fort Myers and was 1-5 with a save and a 3.62 ERA in 23 games – eighteen starts.

**LAST START:** Watson lost [at Peoria on August 10](#). He allowed five runs on six hits over 2-1/3 innings pitched with two walks and four strikeouts.

**VS. WISCONSIN (2021):** Watson made two relief appearances and went 1-0 against the Timber Rattlers in the series in Cedar Rapids in May. He allowed four runs – three earned – on seven hits with four walks and four strikeouts over six innings in those games. Watson was the starting pitcher [at Wisconsin on July 29](#) and took the loss. He allowed an unearned run on four hits with a walk and two strikeouts over five innings.
