ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the South Bend Cubs 5-2 at Four Winds Field.](#)

Jadher Areinamo hit a lead-off home run in the first inning and Tyson Hardin allowed one run over six innings for the Timber Rattlers.

QUALITY IS JOB ONE: Hardin pitched his fourth consecutive quality start for the Timber Rattlers last night and picked up his fourth win of the season. He allowed six hits and walked none. Hardin has walked four and struck out 48 in 44-2/3 innings pitched in 2025. He has not issued a free pass since Brandon Winokur of Cedar Rapids drew a walk on a 3-2 pitch with two outs in the second inning on April 26. His streak has reached 28-1/3 innings without walking a batter.

THREE IS A MAGIC NUMBER: Wisconsin won three straight games for the second time this season. The Rattlers also won three in a row from April 24-26.

GOING DEEP: Wisconsin has at least one homer in each of the first three games of this series, their longest homer streak as a team this season. Wisconsin's longest home run streak last year was four games.

ADD ONE: Blake Burke went 1-for-3 last night to extend his on-base streak to 25 games (33-for-97, eleven walks, .413 OBP, .908 OPS). This is the longest on-base streak in the Midwest League this season.

ABOUT SOUTH BEND: The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs in 2015. South Bend has won Midwest League titles in 1989, 1993, 2005, 2019, and 2022. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, Carlos Gonzalez, Pete Crow-Armstrong, and current Timber Rattlers manager Victor Estevez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982. Nick Lovullo, the son of Arizona Diamondbacks manager Torey Lovullo, is in his second year as South Bend's manager.

ABOUT THE CUBS: The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL for an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, and Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP RYAN BIRCHARD: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Birchard in the 5th round of the 2023 draft out of the Niagara County Community College.

PLAYER OF THE YEAR: Birchard was named the Western New York Athletic Conference Player of the Year in 2023. He was 8-0 in ten games – nine starts – with a 1.08 ERA and 95 strikeouts over fifty innings pitched. Birchard was also named a First Team All-NJCAA Division III All-American in 2023.

QUICK TRIP TO TRENTON: Birchard made four appearances – two starts – for Trenton in the MLB Draft League after the end of his college season. He allowed one run, walked one, and struck out sixteen over nine innings before signing with Milwaukee.

DELAYED START: Birchard did not pitch professionally in 2023. He made a start for the Carolina Mudcats on April 6, 2024 (4.0IP, H, R, 0ER, 2BB, 6K) but was placed on the IL after that game. He next pitched with the ACL Brewers on July 16 and July 22. Birchard rejoined Carolina for appearances on July 28 and August 3 before being sent to Wisconsin on August 13.

AS A RATTLER (2024): Birchard made five regular season starts for Wisconsin last season. He was 0-3 with an 8.71 ERA. He walked fourteen and struck out thirteen in 10-1/3 innings with the Timber Rattlers

LAST START: Birchard had a no decision against Beloit at home on [May 17](#). He allowed two runs on three hits, walked four, and struck out seven over 4-2/3 innings.

VS. SOUTH BEND: Birchard has never pitched against South Bend prior to this evening. Today is also his first appearance against an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs.

SOUTH BEND STARTING PITCHER:

RHP NICK DEAN: The Chicago Cubs selected Dean in the 19th round of the 2023 draft out of the University of Maryland.

TURTLE TIME: Dean pitched for Maryland from 2020 through 2023. He was 13-6 with a 4.44 ERA and 219 strikeouts over 231 innings in 43 starts during his collegiate career.

FINAL COLLEGIATE SEASON: Dean went 3-2 with a 5.54 ERA in fifteen starts for the Terrapins in 2023. He walked 32 and struck out 77 over 74-2/3 innings pitched. Dean did not pitch professionally after signing with the Cubs in 2023.

STARTING OUT IN THE SOUTH: Dean began his pro career with the Myrtle Beach Pelicans in the Carolina League this season. He was 2-0 with a 2.33 ERA in seven games – three starts – for the Pelicans before his promotion to South Bend on May 22, 2024. Dean went 4-4 with a 4.10 ERA in fifteen games – fourteen starts – for the Cubs last season.

LAST START: Dean had a no decision at Lansing on [May 16](#). He allowed five runs on nine hits with two walks and five strikeouts over 4-2/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN (2024): Dean was 1-0 in three starts against the Timber Rattlers last season. He allowed five runs on nine hits with three walks and ten strikeouts over 11-2/3 innings.
