ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Great Lakes Loons beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 7-0 at Neuroscience Group Field. The Loons broke up a scoreless game with four runs in the top of the sixth inning and added three more in the top of the eighth. Both teams had three hits in the game. Great Lakes was able to take advantage of ten walks, three wild pitches, a passed ball, and an error to score their runs. Wisconsin was shut out for the fifth time this season and the second time this month with last night's result.

MADE FOR THIS: Jesús Made was 1-for-3 and was hit by a pitch last night. He is on an eight-game hitting streak (14-for-32; .438). Made has two doubles, a triple, a homer, five RBI, and an OPS of 1.190 during the streak.

SPEED KILLS: The Loons went 8-for-8 in stolen base attempts last night. Kendall George had three stolen bases more steals last night. George, the Midwest League leader in stolen bases with 82 is 14-for-14 in steals during this series. Great Lakes is 29-for-30 in stolen base attempts as a team in the first five games of this series.

END OF THE LINE: Yerlin Rodriguez gave up two earned runs in the top of the sixth last night. That ended his streak of consecutive games without allowing an earned run at twelve. Rodriguez walked four, gave up one hit, and allowed two inherited runners to score.

ALMOST: Wisconsin went 1-for-5 with runners in scoring position. Luis Castillo had a two-out single to left in the bottom of the sixth inning. However, Marco Dinges was thrown out at the plate for the final out of the inning.

BIG CROWDS CONTINUE: Last night's attendance was 6,040. It was the eighth time in the last eleven home games Wisconsin has topped 5,000 and the fourth time in the last eight games they have surpassed 6,000. The total attendance in the last eleven games at Neuroscience Group Field is 61,077 for an average attendance of 5,552.

ABOUT GREAT LAKES: The Great Lakes Loons came into existence in 2007 after the Midwest League team left Battle Creek, Michigan at the end of the 2006 season. The team in Battle Creek had been known as the Michigan Battle Cats, Battle Creek Yankees, and the Southwest Michigan Devil Rays. The Loons have been affiliated with the Los Angeles Dodgers since 2007. They have made the Midwest League playoffs nine times since 2007. The Loons won the Midwest League title in 2016 and lost to Cedar Rapids in the Midwest League Championship Series in 2023. Notable Great Lakes alumni include Clayton Kershaw, Kenley Jansen, Nathan Eovaldi, Joc Peterson, Julio Urias, Walker Buehler, and Gavin Lux. Jair Fernandez, who played in 52 games with the Timber Rattlers in 2007, is in his second season as the manager of the Loons.

ABOUT THE DODGERS: The Los Angeles Dodgers were only in the Midwest League for a few seasons prior to affiliating with the Loons. They were in Dubuque in 1967 and in Clinton from 1977 to 1979. Orel Hershiser and Steve Sax were notable Dodgers to play in Clinton.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP BISHOP LETSON: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Letson in the 11th round of the 2023 draft out of Floyd Central High School in Floyds Knobs, Indiana.

PUR-DON'T: Letson signed with the Brewers over a commitment to Purdue University.

DEBUT SEASON: Letson did not pitch professionally in 2023. He was 1-4 with a 3.13 ERA in sixteen games – fourteen starts – with the Carolina Mudcats in 2024. He had 57 strikeouts in 63-1/3 innings. Opponents hit .195 against Letson last year.

DOUBLE RATING: *Baseball America* placed Letson as the #8 prospect in the Brewers system in their *2025 Prospect Handbook*. MLB Pipeline places Letson at the #7 spot after their latest update.

LAST START: Letson allowed two runs – one earned – on three hits with three walks and four strikeouts over 5-2/3 innings for a no decision at Peoria on [May 8](#).

VS. GREAT LAKES: Letson has never pitched against the Loons prior to this afternoon. Today is also his first appearance against an affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers.

GREAT LAKES SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP AIDAN FOELLER: The Dodgers selected Foeller in the eleventh round of the 2024 draft out of Southern Illinois University.

COMMUNITY: Foeller pitched three seasons at Northeast Mississippi Community College. He received a redshirt season due to an injury in 2022 that limited him to two games. In his junior college career, Foeller was 4-6 with a 6.17 ERA in 23 games – fourteen starts.

SALUKI: Foeller pitched one season at Southern Illinois. He went 5-3 with a 5.91 ERA in fifteen games – fourteen starts with 105 strikeouts over 77-2/3 innings.

BEFORE MICHIGAN: Foeller made his pro debut with two brief relief outings for the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes of the California League in 2024. He returned to the Cal League in 2025 and was 4-3 in 22 games – twenty starts – with a 5.24 ERA and 127 strikeouts over 89-1/3 innings before his promotion to Great Lakes on August 14. Today is his Midwest League debut.

LAST START: Foeller had a no decision at Visalia on [August 12](#). He allowed two runs on four hits with a walk and six strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Foeller has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers. Today is the first time he is facing an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
