ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp are in their first season as the Sky Carp and their second season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into AE Supply Stadium on August 3. Jorge Hernandez is in his first season as the manager of the Sky Carp

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have a history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Tyler Black (#6), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Zavier Warren (#17), and Cam Robinson (#26). Carlos Rodríguez (#21) is on the Wisconsin injured list. MLB Pipeline has six current Sky Carp on their Top 30 list of Miami Marlins prospects: Dax Fulton (#9), Victor Mesa Jr. (#14), Cody Morissette (#16), Nasim Nunez (#18), Evan Fitterer (#19), and Tanner Allen (#23).

### WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP RUSSELL SMITH:** Selected by the Brewers in the second round (51st overall selection) of the 2021 draft out of Texas Christian University. He is rated as he #16 prospect in the Brewers system by MLB Pipeline.

**AREA CODE:** Smith was picked as the Most Outstanding Player at the Area Code Games in 2016. He was also a four-year letter winner at Midlothian (TX) High School.

NO, CUBS, NO: The Chicago Cubs picked Smith in the  $38^{th}$  round of the 2017 draft. He elected to honor a commitment to TCU.

**HORNED FROGS:** Smith was 7-3 with a 3.83 ERA in fifteen starts during his final season at TCU. He had 101 strikeouts in 82-1/3 innings pitched that season

MISSING TIME: Smith missed the 2019 season due to Tommy John Surgery and most of the 2020 season due to the pandemic shutdown.

**LAST START:** Smith lost to Peoria at home on June 1. He allowed four runs on seven hits with two walks and no strikeouts over six innings.

**VS. BELOIT:** Smith <u>had a no decision at Beloit on April 14</u>. He pitched four scoreless innings, allowed two hits, walked two, and struck out four.

### BELOIT SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

 $\mbox{\bf RHP MD JOHNSON:}$  The Marlins selected Johnson in the  $6^{\text{th}}$  round of the 2019 draft out of Dallas Baptist University.

**PATRIOT GAMES:** Johnson pitched four seasons at Dallas Baptist. He was 29-9 with a 4.27 ERA and 274 strikeouts in 297 innings over 68 games – 57 starts – in his career.

**SENIOR MOMENTS:** Johnson was 10-2 in sixteen starts in his final season at DBU. He had an ERA of 2.76 and had 110 strikeouts with 29 walks over 98 innings pitched as a senior.

**TO THE PROS:** Johnson made pitched for the Batavia Muckdogs in the New York-Penn League in 2019 after signing with the Marlins. He made fifteen relief appearances and was 1-0 while allowing nine earned runs and striking out 22 in 19 innings pitched.

**FLORIDA MAN:** Johnson went 3-4 with the Jupiter Hammerheads to start his 2021 season. He had a 3.19 ERA in ten games – seven starts – before his promotion to Beloit on July 6.

**CENTRALLY LOCATED:** Johnson was 3-4 in eleven starts with Beloit in 2021. He had a 2.58ERA with 59 strikeouts over 59.1 innings pitched.

**LAST START:** Johnson won <u>at Quad Cities on May 31</u>. He allowed a run on a hit – a solo home run – with four walks and nine strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Johnson took the <u>loss against the Timber Rattlers at Beloit on April 12</u> when he allowed four runs on six hits with no walks and eight strikeouts over three innings. Johnson was 1-0 in two starts for Beloit against Wisconsin in 2021 as he pitched eleven shutout innings and allowed three hits.
