### SATURDAY IN THE PARK: [The Fort Wayne TinCaps beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 2-1 at Parkview Field.](https://www.wosh.com)

Fort Wayne broke a scoreless tie with two runs in the bottom of the eighth inning. They had runners at the corners with one out in the frame when Kasen Wells dropped a bunt for a safety squeeze and reached for an RBI single against reliever Yorman Galindez. Yerlin Rodriguez took over Galindez with the bases loaded and two outs to face Rosman Verdugo. Rodriguez walked Verdugo on four pitches to force in the second run of the inning. Braylon Payne homered with one out in the top of the ninth and Daniel Dickinson drew a walk, but the Rattlers couldn't get him past first base as the next two batters were retired to end the game.

**ON A HEATER:** Payne is on a six-game hitting streak (10-for-22, .455). He has four homers, two doubles, six RBI, and nine runs scored during the streak. Payne has an OPS of 1.677 during the streak and has joined Andrew Fischer and Josh Adamczewski for the team lead in homers with five this season.

**POWER SURGE:** Wisconsin's 23 home runs this month are the most by the Rattlers in April since 2005. The 2017 Rattlers had 21 homers in April.

**BETTER MAKE IT FIVE:** All five Wisconsin starting pitchers in this series – Travis Smith, Ethan Dorchies, Wande Torres, Bryce Meccage, and Braylon Owens – have all gone five innings. Smith, Dorchies, Torres, and Meccage each allowed two runs and earned the win. Owens allowed one hit, walked two, and struck out six over five scoreless innings for a no decision. In their 25 innings, the starters have a combined ERA of 2.88 with six walks and 26 strikeouts.

### KEEP CLIMBING UP THAT HILL (PART ONE):

Wisconsin's four-game winning streak came to an end with yesterday's loss. The Rattlers have not had a winning streak go past four since the 2024 season.

**KEEP CLIMBING UP THAT HILL (PART TWO):** Since the change to mostly six-game series in 2021, the Timber Rattlers have never swept a six-game series.

**ABOUT FORT WAYNE:** The Fort Wayne TinCaps franchise started in Mattoon, Illinois for the 1947 season. That franchise moved to Keokuk, Iowa to become the Keokuk Cardinals from 1958 through 1962. The team moved again to Wisconsin Rapids, Wisconsin for 1963. They were affiliated with the Washington Senators in 1963 and became a Minnesota Twins affiliate after the Major League team moved to Minneapolis for the 1964 season. Wisconsin Rapids moved to Kenosha, Wisconsin for the 1984 season and remained an affiliate of the Twins. Fort Wayne joined the Midwest League after the Kenosha Twins moved to Indiana for the 1993 season. The team renamed themselves as the Fort Wayne Wizards and stayed an affiliate of the Twins through the 1998 season. Fort Wayne affiliated with the San Diego Padres for the 1999 season and has remained in that relationship to this day. There was one more move for the franchise when the team moved from Memorial Stadium to Parkview Field to start the 2009 season. They also changed their name to TinCaps for 2009. The TinCaps won the only MWL Pennant for the Fort Wayne entry of the franchise in 2009. Notable former Fort Wayne players include Torii Hunter, Jake Peavy, AJ Pierzynski, Josh Barfield, LaTroy Hawkins, Corey Kluber, David Freese, Trea Turner, and Fernando Tatis Jr.

**ABOUT THE PADRES:** San Diego's relationship with Midwest League teams began in 1990 when they started an affiliation with the Waterloo Diamonds. That partnership moved to the Springfield Sultans with the Waterloo franchise for 1994. The Padres were the parent club of the Clinton LumberKings from 1995 through 1998 before joining with the Fort Wayne franchise for 1999.

**WHEN LAST WE MET:** Wisconsin and Fort Wayne last met in a series from June 18-23, 2024. Parkview Field was the site of the series with each team winning three of the six games. Wisconsin won the first two games 4-1 and 8-3. The TinCaps won games three and four 5-1 and 5-4. The Rattlers won the Saturday game 7-4 with the TinCaps winning the finale on Sunday 6-5.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP JASON WOODWARD:** The Milwaukee Brewers selected Woodward in the fourth round of the 2023 draft out of Florida Gulf Coast University.

**FROM THE COAST:** Woodward pitched three seasons at FGCU. He was 11-6 with a 3.68 ERA and 139 strikeouts over 127-1/3 innings in 34 games – twenty starts. His junior season ended after three starts due to an injury that required Tommy John Surgery before the draft.

**THAT SCHOOL SEEMS FAMILIAR:** Former Timber Rattlers who played at Florida Gulf Coast University are Jacob Barnes and Jordan Desguin.

**STARTING AND STOPPING:** Woodward made his professional debut in a start against the ACL Dodgers on June 27, 2024. He made four starts in the ACL before a promotion to Carolina in August where he made three more starts for the Mudcats before an injury that required a second Tommy John Surgery and missing the entire 2025 season.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** Woodward pitched 2/3 of an inning in the bottom of the sixth against the TinCaps on [April 21](#). He allowed one hit, walked one, and struck out one before the game was halted by rain. It did not restart.

**LAST START:** Woodward had a no decision against Peoria in game one of a doubleheader at home on [April 15](#). He allowed a hit, walked two, and struck out one over three innings.

**VS. FORT WAYNE:** Woodward's relief appearance against Fort Wayne on April 21 was the first time pitched against the TinCaps. It was also the first time he faced an affiliate of the San Diego Padres.

## FORT WAYNE STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP ABRAHAM PARRA:** The San Diego Padres signed Parra as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela in 2022.

**FROM THE ISLAND TO THE DESERT:** Parra began his pro career in 2023 by pitching for both of San Diego's affiliates in the Dominican Summer League and was 1-1 on ten games – five starts. The Padres moved him to the Arizona Complex League for 2024, and Parra was 0-4 with a 9.59 ERA in thirteen games – seven starts.

**LAST YEAR:** Parra made two relief appearances for the ACL Padres before a move to Lake Elsinore for the remainder of the 2025 season. He made eighteen appearances – eleven starts – with the Storm. Parra went 4-4 with a 5.29 ERA and 74 strikeouts in 81-2/3 innings in the California League last year.

**LAST START:** Parra had a no decision at Lake County on [April 19](#). He allowed an unearned run on two hits with a walk and three strikeouts over five innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Parra has never pitched against Wisconsin prior to this afternoon. The last time he faced a Milwaukee Brewers affiliate was [May 25, 2024](#) in an Arizona Complex League game. He allowed a run on a hit – a solo home run by Johan Barrios – with a walk and two strikeouts over two innings of relief for a no decision.
