ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Indianapolis Indians posted two-run innings in two of the first three frames and held off the Gwinnett Strippers to prevail in the penultimate game of the 2025 season on Saturday night at Coolray Field, 5-3. The Indianapolis offense got going early. Ji Hwan Bae led off the game and sliced a single to left field. Liover Peguero then worked a walk. A wild pitch moved both runners up, and Nick Solak grounded out to short to send home Bae. One out later, Jase Bowen singled home Peguero. That two-run output was matched in the third by Indy. With two outs and nobody aboard, Solak smacked a double to left field. Nelson Velazquez then knocked a hit to left field and Solak scampered home. Bowen struck again as he doubled to left-center field to drive in Velazquez. After a four-RBI night on Friday, Bowen has driven in six runs over the past pair of contests. Gwinnett picked up a run in the second when David Fletcher advanced Eddys Leonard home, and they cut the Indianapolis lead to just one run in the sixth. With Conner Capel and Adam Zebrowski aboard, Carlos Rodriguez singled to right field to trim the deficit. Indy plated an insurance run to gain some breathing room in the eighth. Solak led off and reached on an error. He would move to second on a wild pitch, and two batters later, scored on Brett Sullivan's single.

BATTING TITLE RACE: Nick Solak went 1-for-5 with two runs, one double and one RBI in last night's contest, putting his batting average on the season at .331. He ranks second in the International League, only trailing Lehigh Valley's Justin Crawford (.334). Crawford has secured qualified status through the season but was placed on the 7-day injured list on Sept. 5 with a concussion. Should Solak finish with a higher batting average, he would be Indy's first batting champion since Junior Noboa hit .340 in 1989.

PO-YU'S STRONG DEBUT: Po-Yu Chen continued his stellar start to Triple-A last night, earning his second win in three starts. He tossed 5.0 innings of one-run ball on seven hits, two walks and four strikeouts. He has now allowed just one run across his first 13.2 innings with Indianapolis, owning a 0.66 ERA. He made his debut on May 26 vs. Nashville, tossing 5.0 innings. He rejoined Indy on Sept. 12 and tossed 3.2 scoreless on Sept. 14 vs. Iowa.

BOOMING BOWEN: Jase Bowen continued his stellar run with Indianapolis last night, going 2-for-4 with a double and two RBI. He has reached base safely in 24 of his last 27 games since Aug. 17 and has hit safely in 12 of 15 games in Sept. Across these 27 games, he is hitting .305 (29-for-95) with 15 runs, seven doubles, three triples, two home runs, 14 RBI, 13 walks, five stolen bases and an .894 OPS. In addition to this, he also leads Indians' hitters since his Triple-A debut on Aug. 7 in walks (18), on-base percentage (.379) and extra-base hits (15). Bowen drove in four runs on Friday night, including a three-run home run. It was his most driven in since four on Aug. 17, 2023, with High-A Greensboro vs. Bowling Green. In the seventh inning, Bowen crushed his home run 108.5 mph and 430-feet to the left field bullpen for a 9-5 advantage. It was the hardest-hit ball of Bowen's professional career.

THE WEEKEND STARTS EARLY: The Indians enter play with the best record from Thursday-Sunday (62-39, .614) of all Triple-A teams and the most wins on the extended weekend. Additionally, it is the Indians most wins from Thursday-Sunday in a season since at least 2005, surpassing their 55 wins in 2005.

BAEWATCH: Ji Hwan Bae went 4-for-5 with one run and one double in last night's contest, matching his season high in hits. He last did so on July 22 vs. Toledo. Bae has hit safely in 13 of his past 14 games with Indy since Aug. 9, batting .328 (21-for-64) with 11 runs, seven doubles, three triples, three RBI, two walks, one stolen base and an .889 OPS in this span.

STIFLING STARTERS: Indians' starters in September have logged the lowest ERA (2.19, 16er/65.2ip), tied for the lowest OPS against (.625), the fifth-lowest WHIP (1.23) and tied for fifth-lowest opponent average (.224, 55-for-245) among all Triple-A clubs in the month. There has been one earned run or less surrendered in 14 of 17 Indians starts this month and three or fewer hits allowed in 12. The ERA for Indians' starters is their second lowest in a calendar month with at least four games played, trailing only a 1.85 ERA (22er/107.0ip) in April 2016.

NEVER LET IT SNOWBALL: Indy stands as the only Triple-A club to have not sustained a losing streak of four or more games this season. With Thursday's win, they secured a finish to the season without a losing streak longer than three games. This is the first time since 2006 that Indy has avoided a four-game skid. That season, the Indians endured seven three-game losing streaks, compared to the four they have suffered this year. They are the first Triple-A team to finish a season without losing four or more games in a row since Tacoma in 2021 (five three-game losing streaks).

TODAY'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians and Gwinnett Strippers meet in the final game of the 2025 season from Coolray Field tonight at 6:05 PM. Indy leads the season series over Gwinnett, 9-2, and won their first series at Gwinnett since taking two of three games from July 7-9, 2017. RHP Drake Fellows takes the mound for Indianapolis, set for his 33rd appearance and 19th start of the season. Fellows matched a season high with 6.0 innings in the series opener on Tuesday, allowing just one run with five strikeouts. It will be his third start against the Strippers on the campaign as he has allowed just one run across 11.0 innings against the club. Opposite Fellows is RHP Carlos Carrasco. Indy jumped on Carrasco in Tuesday's series opener, tagging him for seven earned runs across 4.0 innings on nine hits.

ON THIS DATE IN 2000: Just three years into joining the International League, the Indians fought their way to the top of Triple-A baseball with a 9-2 rout in Game 4 against Memphis. Horacio Estrada – the IL leader with 14 wins that season – tossed 8.0 two-run innings to clinch the Triple-A World Series, 3 games to 1. Indy's single-season record holder with 35 saves, Bob Scanlan, closed out the title game with two strikeouts in a 1-2-3 ninth inning.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Drake Fellows: He will be making his 19th start of the season and his 39th career start compared to 34 career relief appearances.

Last Outing: Fellows had one of his best outings of the season in Tuesday's opener, tossing 6.0 innings of one-run ball with four hits, one walk and five strikeouts. It was his second quality start on the campaign as he matched his season high in innings.

Against the Stripers: In two previous starts against Gwinnett this season, Fellows has allowed just one run in 11.0 innings of work.

Swingman: With his 33rd appearance and 19th start of the season tonight, Fellows will surpass Osvaldo Bido in 2022 (32 G, 25 GS) for the most appearances by an Indians' pitcher with at least 18 games started in a season since at least 2005.

Fellows Posts Zeroes: Fellows owns the longest scoreless streak by an Indians pitcher this season, tossing 15.0 scoreless frames across four starts from July 12-31.

May Flowers: Fellows was named the Indians May Player of the Month earlier this season. In six appearances, he ranked sixth among Triple-A pitchers with at least 15.0 innings pitched in ERA (1.15, 2er/15.2ip) and 11th in WHIP (0.96). He was the first Indians reliever to earn the award since Hunter Stratton in Aug. 2023.

Fab Five: Fellows picked up a win in a career and team-high five straight decisions from April 20-May 31. He pitched to a 2.08 ERA (5er/21.2ip) with 25 strikeouts in nine appearances across that stretch.

Miscellaneous: Selected by San Diego in the sixth round (173rd overall) of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Vanderbilt (Nashville, Tenn.) University... Acquired by Pittsburgh from San Diego on Jan. 19, 2021 with RHP David Bednar, OF Hudson Head and LHP Omar Cruz in exchange for RHP Joe Musgrove; New York (NL) recieved LHP Joey Lucchesi from San Diego and sent C Endy Rodriguez to Pittsburgh.
