ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers defeated the Lansing Lugnuts 7-2 at Neuroscience Group Field. The Timber Rattlers broke a 2-2 tie on a two-out, RBI single by Luis Castillo in the bottom of the fifth inning. Wisconsin added a run in the sixth and three runs in the seventh. The Timber Rattlers took advantage of five errors by Lansing's defense.

KING OF TRIOS: Castillo went 3-for-4 with two RBI last night. Castillo leads the Timber Rattlers in RBI with 57.

TWO-OUT BINGO: Wisconsin scored five of their seven runs with two outs last night.

SECOND HALF SURGE: Daniel Dickinson was 2-for-3 with an RBI, a stolen base, two walks, and three runs scored for Wisconsin last night. He is hitting .348 with 27 walks, 21 RBI, and twenty stolen bases over 28 games in the second half.

HOW DO YOU SPELL RELIEF? Wisconsin's three relievers pitched 4-1/3 scoreless innings last night. Quinton Low entered the game with two on and two out in the top of the fifth in a tie game. He got the final out of the fifth, pitched a scoreless sixth, and picked up the win when the Rattlers took the lead in the bottom of the fifth. Tanner Perry tossed two frames, walked one, and struck out three without allowing a hit. Michael Fowler pitched the ninth. Wisconsin pitchers struck out twelve with starting pitcher Wande Torres picking up seven over 4-2/3 innings.

CHASING HISTORY: The 2026 Timber Rattlers are just the fifth team in franchise history to reach 100 home runs in a season.

ABOUT THE LANSING LUGNUTS: The Lugnuts began their existence as the Lafayette (IN) Chiefs of the Mississippi-Ohio Valley League in 1955. Lafayette became the Red Sox in 1956 and as the Mississippi-Ohio Valley League became the Midwest League. The franchise moved Waterloo, Iowa in 1958 and remained there as the Hawks, Royals, Indians, and Diamonds until the end of the 1993 season. New ownership bought the team and moved them to Springfield, Illinois for two seasons before finally locating the team in Lansing, Michigan in 1996. Since they started in Lansing, the Lugnuts were affiliated with the Kansas City Royals (1996-1998), the Chicago Cubs (1999-2004), the Toronto Blue Jays (2005-2019), and the Athletics. The Lugnuts won Midwest League titles in 1997 and 2003. Notable Lansing alumni include Kevin Appier, Carlos Beltrán, Rich Hill, Mark Prior, Carlos Zambrano, Bo Bichette, Vladimir Guerrero Jr, Danny Janssen, Noah Syndergaard, and Rowdy Tellez.

ABOUT THE ATHLETICS: The Athletics have been in and out of in the Midwest League since the 1968 season. They were in Burlington from 1968 through 1974 before leaving the league. The A's returned to the Midwest League in 1982 to be the parent club of the Madison Muskies and stayed in Madison through 1993. Their affiliation stayed with the franchise after its move to West Michigan in 1994. The Athletics left the league again after the 1997 season only to return with Kane County as their affiliate from 2003 through 2010. From there, they went to Burlington (2011-2012), Beloit (2013-2019), and Lansing (since 2021).

STARTING PITCHERS

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

LHP J.D. THOMPSON: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Thompson in the second round of the 2025 draft out of Vanderbilt University.

SAIL AWAY: Thompson pitched three seasons for the Commodores. He was 13-7 with a 4.28 ERA in 43 games – 29 starts – and struck out 219 over 164 innings. Thompson made sixteen starts in his final season at Vanderbilt with a 6-5 record, a 4.00 ERA, and 122 strikeouts in 90 innings with just thirty walks.

SUMMERS IN NEW ENGLAND: Thompson pitched for Newport in the New England Collegiate Baseball League in 2023 and for Bourne in the Cape Cod League in 2024.

HOW DOES HE RATE? Thompson is currently rated at #26 in the Brewers system by MLB Pipeline. *Baseball America* has him at #21 after its latest update.

LET'S GO! Thompson did not pitch professionally in the Brewers system after signing with Milwaukee. His final collegiate appearance was a win against Wright State on [May 30, 2025](#) in the Nashville Regional of the 2025 NCAA Baseball Tournament. He struck out twelve, walked one, and gave up three runs on five hits over eight innings. Thompson made his pro debut as a starter for the Timber Rattlers on [May 2, 2026](#).

LAST START: Thompson was not involved in the decision at South Bend on [July 24](#). He allowed an unearned run on a hit, two walks, a hit batsman, and six strikeouts over 2-2/3 innings.

VS. LANSING: Thompson has never pitched against the Lugnuts before this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will face an affiliate of the Athletics.

LANSING STARTING PITCHER:

RHP DEVIN KIRBY: The Athletics signed Kirby as a Minor League Free Agent on May 23, 2026.

CHAPTER ONE: The Minnesota Twins signed Kirby as a non-drafted free agent out of the University of Connecticut on July 27, 2023. Kirby pitched for the FCL Twins in 2023 and 2024 and for Fort Myers of the Florida State League in 2024. The Twins assigned Kirby to the Arizona Fall League in 2024 and had him start 2025 with Fort Myers before releasing him on May 28, 2025.

CHAPTER TWO: The Baltimore Orioles signed Kirby as a Minor League Free Agent on June 6, 2025. He pitched for Delmarva in the Carolina League and Aberdeen in the South Atlantic League before he was released on August 2, 2025. Kirby was 2-1 with a 6.89 ERA and a save in 25 relief appearances in 2025 with Fort Myers, Delmarva, and Aberdeen.

PRE-MICHIGAN: Kirby started this season with the ACL Athletics and Stockton Ports in the California League before joining the Lugnuts on July 22.

LAST START: Kirby lost to Great Lakes at home on [July 23](#). He allowed eight runs – seven earned – on nine hits over 4-2/3 innings in his Lansing debut.

VS. WISCONSIN: Kirby has never faced Wisconsin prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
