LAST ACTION: [The Peoria Chiefs defeated the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 3-2 on Sunday at Neuroscience Group Field.](#)

Darlin Moquette broke a 1-1 tie with a two-run home run in the top of the ninth inning. Wisconsin had runners at second and third with no outs. They scored a run to get close, but the Chiefs held on for the win and the series split.

COOOOOOOOOOOOP: Wisconsin grabbed a 1-0 lead when Cooper Pratt hit a two-out, solo home run in the bottom of the sixth inning. The homer was Pratt's second of the season with Wisconsin. Pratt also happened to turn 20 on Sunday.

FIRST! Jadhre Areinamo had a pinch-hit, RBI single in the bottom of the ninth inning on Sunday. It was the first pinch hit by a Rattler this season. Wisconsin pinch hitters had been 0-for-11 with a walk and a hit batsman before Areinamo's hit on Sunday.

REHABBING: Brewers relievers Trevor Megill and Enoli Paredes both pitched scoreless innings on Sunday. Megill worked a perfect fourth and Paredes allowed a single in a scoreless fifth.

RENDEZVOUS WITH HISTORY: Luke Adams is tied with Nick Sanay (2017 Lansing) for the Midwest League record for times being hit by a pitch (38). Adams will set a new League record the next time he is plunked.

ABOUT GREAT LAKES: The Great Lakes Loons came into existence in 2007 after the Midwest League team left Battle Creek, Michigan at the end of the 2006 season. The team in Battle Creek had been known as the Michigan Battle Cats, Battle Creek Yankees, and the Southwest Michigan Devil Rays. The Loons have been affiliated with the Los Angeles Dodgers since 2007. They have made the Midwest League playoffs nine times since 2007. The Loons won the Midwest League title in 2016 and lost to Cedar Rapids in the Midwest League Championship Series in 2023. Notable Great Lakes alumni include Clayton Kershaw, Kenley Jansen, Nathan Eovaldi, Joc Peterson, Julio Urias, Walker Buehler, and Gavin Lux. Jair Fernandez, who played in 52 games with the Timber Rattlers in 2007, is the manager of the Loons in 2024.

ABOUT THE DODGERS: The Los Angeles Dodgers were only in the Midwest League for a few seasons prior to affiliating with the Loons. They were in Dubuque in 1967 and in Clinton from 1977 to 1979. Orel Hershiser and Steve Sax were notable Dodgers to play in Clinton.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) places six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Cooper Pratt (#4), Luis Lara (#8), Luke Adams (#15), Jadhre Areinamo (#21), Patricio Aquino (#28), Ryan Birchard (#30). [MLB Pipeline](#) has six Loons on their list of Top 30 Dodgers prospects: Josue De Paula (#2), Maddux Bruns (#18), Patrick Copen (#20), Peter Heubeck (#26), Payton Martin (#28), and Jesus Galiz (#30).

THE SEASON SO FAR: The Loons completed a six-game sweep at Fort Wayne on April 28. They are 16-8 and are the top team in the East Division. Great Lakes had an eight-game winning streak before losing last night.

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP WILL RUDY: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Rudy in the fifth round of the 2022 draft out of the California Polytechnic State University, Pomona.

WHAT A SEASON: Rudy was at Cal Poly Pomona for three seasons but had just one full season due to COVID-19 abbreviating 2020 and canceling the 2021 season for the Broncos. In 2022, which was still his freshman season, Rudy went 8-1 with a 3.10 ERA over thirteen starts. He walked fifteen and struck out 96 in 87 innings pitched during that season.

TROPHY ROOM: Rudy was a three-time Pitcher of the Week in the California Collegiate Athletic Association, two-time National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association West Region Pitcher of the Week, a First Team All-CCAA selection, and the CCAA's Most Valuable pitcher last season.

OUR OLD FRIEND FROM POMONA: Rudy was the highest draft selection of a Poly Pomona player since Cody Ponce was picked 55th overall in the 2015 draft. The Brewers also picked Ponce, who pitched for the Timber Rattlers right after the 2015 draft.

THE CAPE: Rudy made one start for Yarmouth-Dennis in the Cape Cod League in 2022 before the draft. He did not pitch in the Brewers system until 2023.

THE MUDCAT: Rudy was 5-3 in eighteen starts for Carolina in 2023 for his professional debut. Rudy had a 3.46 ERA, 26 walks, and 69 strikeouts over 80-2/3 innings.

LAST START: Rudy beat Peoria at home on [August 15](#). He allowed three runs on four hits with two walks and five strikeouts over five innings.

VS. GREAT LAKES: Rudy beat the Loons at home on [May 2](#). He allowed a run on two hits with no walks and five strikeouts over six innings.

GREAT LAKES STARTING PITCHER:

RHP PATRICK COPEN: The Los Angeles Dodgers selected Copen in the seventh round of the 2023 draft out of Marshall University. MLB Pipeline rates Copen as the #20 prospect in the Dodgers system. *Baseball America* places him at #26 in the Dodgers organization.

WE ARE MARSHALL: Copen was 5-14 with a 6.30 ERA in three seasons at Marshall. He had 166 strikeouts and 102 walks in 161-1/3 innings pitched over 37 games – 31 starts – during his collegiate career.

TIME ON THE CAPE: Copen made seven relief appearances for Brewster in the Cape Cod League in 2022. He was 0-1 with two saves and a 5.79 ERA.

TIME TO START: Copen began his pro career with a scoreless relief outing for the ACL Dodgers on August 22, 2023. He also made two brief starts for Rancho Cucamonga in 2023. He had no record with three walks and two strikeouts over 4-1/3 innings as a pro last season.

THIS SEASON: Copen started 2024 with Rancho Cucamonga back in the California League. He was 5-2 with a 3.15 ERA, 25 walks, and 60 strikeouts over 54-1/3 innings pitched before his promotion to Great Lakes on June 25, 2024.

LAST START: Copen had a no decision at Lake County on [August 13](#). He allowed two runs on two hits with five walks and three strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Copen has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will face an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
