ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the South Bend Cubs 3-1 at Neuroscience Group Field. Joe Gray Jr broke a 1-1 tie with a two-run home run in the bottom of the eighth inning. Cam Robinson pitched a scoreless ninth for his eighth save.

BLACK RIDER: Tyler Black walked twice and scored a run for the Rattlers last night. He has been Wisconsin's lead-off batter in the last nine games. Black has been on base 21 times and scored ten runs in the lead-off

GRAY HAVENS: Gray has homered in two straight games and has hit four home runs in his last nine games. He has ten RBI, six walks, and an OPS of 1.060 in his last nine games.

KELLY SHOWS HIS QUALITY: Wisconsin starting pitcher Antoine Kelly allowed one run on five hits with a walk and five strikeouts over 6-1/3 innings for the first quality start of his professional career. Last night was also the first time Kelly has pitched into the seventh inning as a starter as a pro.

LIGHT THE BEACONS: South Bend tied the game with an RBI single by Owen Caissie in the top of the seventh off Kelly and Kent Hasler entered the game with runners at first and second with one out. A popup was lost in the twilight for a single to load the bases. Then, Hasler got a strikeout and a force out at third to escape the inning. Hasler would get the win after Gray's homer in the eighth.

FELL DEEDS AWAKE: Robinson has a save in five straight appearances. He has allowed one hit, walked four, and struck out twelve over ten scoreless innings over six appearances in May. Robinson leads the Midwest League in saves.

MANY PARTINGS: Tristan Peters drove in Wisconsin's first run of the game with a sacrifice fly in the bottom of the first inning. Peters went 0-for-3 and saw his on-base streak end at 23 games.

ABOUT SOUTH BEND: The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs. South Bend won Midwest League pennants in 1989, 1993, 2005, and 2019. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, and Carlos Gonzalez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982.

ABOUT THE CUBS: The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL with an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP RYNE MOORE: The Brewers selected Moore in the 18th round of the 2021 draft out of Old Dominion University.

THE MONARCH: Moore went 9-1 with a 3.16 ERA in seventeen games – fourteen starts – in his final season at ODU. He was also named a Second Team All-Conference USA selection in 2021.

AM I BLUE? Moore began his professional career with Milwaukee's Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League after signing his professional contract. He made six appearances – two starts – and allowed a run on four hits over 12-2/3 innings for Brewers Blue.

IN MY MIND I'M GOING TO CAROLINA: Moore started the 2022 season with the Carolina Mudcats. He was 0-1 with a 2.31 ERA in six starts in the Carolina League. Moore walked eleven and struck out 38 over 35 innings for the Mudcats.

WELCOME TO WISCONSIN: Moore joined the Timber Rattlers on May 12, 2022.

LAST START: Moore had <u>a no decision at Fayetteville on May 10</u> in his final start with the Carolina Mudcats. Moore allowed a run on six hits with a walk and six strikeouts over seven innings.

VS. SOUTH BEND: Moore has never faced South Bend prior to this afternoon. This will also be the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs.

SOUTH BEND STARTING PITCHER:

RHP DANIEL PALENCIA: The Cubs acquired Palencia from the Oakland Athletics on July 26, 2021 in a trade that sent Andrew Chafin to the A's in exchange for Palencia and Greg Deichmann.

ORIGIN STORY: Oakland signed Palencia as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on February 13, 2020.

CALIFORNIA DREAMING: Palencia made his professional debut with the Stockton Ports in the Low-A West in 2021 and went 0-2 with a 6.91 ERA in six starts before the trade. The Cubs assigned Palencia to Myrtle Beach in the Low-A East after the trade.

PELI-CAN: Palencia was 1-0 with a 3.67 ERA in seven starts at Myrtle Beach. He walked eighteen and struck out 38 over 27 innings pitched for the Pelicans.

LAST START: Palencia had a <u>no decision against the Peoria Chiefs at home on May 6</u>. He allowed an unearned run on three hits with two walks and three strikeouts over four innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Palencia has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. Today will be the first time Palencia will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
