JULY, 2025:

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Cedar Rapids Kernels 10-0 at Veterans Memorial Stadium. Manuel Rodriguez, Anthony Flores, and Aaron Rund combined on the two-hit shutout. Tayden Hall hit a pair of homers and Jadher Areinamo added a two-run home run for the offense. Wisconsin ended a seven-game winning streak for the Kernels.

AREINAMO APPRECIATION: Areinamo went 2-for-5 with three runs and two RBI last night. It was his 27th multi-hit game of the season. He leads the Midwest League with 101 hits this season. In 204 games as a Rattler, Areinamo has 231 hits with 21 homers and 119 RBI. Areinamo is hitting .294 with an OPS of .791 in his career with Wisconsin.

FIRST: Manuel Rodriguez earned his first Midwest League win last night. He allowed one hit, walked two. and struck out three over five scoreless innings

HALL MONITOR: Hall hit his first homer last night with one out in the top of the second inning to jump start a five-run outburst. He launched his second homer of the game with two outs in the seventh inning. Last night was the first time Wisconsin has hit more than two homers as a team in a game this season. They had hit two home runs in a game twelve times in 2025 prior to

KING OF TRIOS: Blake Burke had three hits and two RBI last night for Wisconsin. Burke has 26 multi-hit games this season. He is tied for second in the league in hits (98) and is third in the league in average (.313).

SHUT DOWN MODE: The Rattlers have seven shutouts this season. Only the Quad Cities River Bandits (11) have more team shutouts in the Midwest League this season.

DOUBLE DIGITS: The Rattlers reached ten runs for the first time in the second half last night. They had not reached double digits in runs since June 17 at West

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence in 1949 as the Cedar Rapids Rockets, an unaffiliated team in the Central Association. They moved to the Three-I League as the Cedar Rapids Indians, an affiliate of Cleveland in 1950. They were affiliated with the Milwaukee Braves from 1954 through 1962. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins from 2013 through 2023, including a 2023 Midwest League Championship. That streak ended last year when the Kernels missed the playoffs. Notable alumni include Mike Trout. Byron Buxton, and Milwaukee Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook. Hall of Famers John McGraw (1891 Canaries), Lou Boudreau (1938 Raiders), Ted Simmons (1967 Cardinals), and Trevor Hoffman (1991 Reds) played for earlier pro teams in Cedar Rapids.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places five Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Bishop Letson (#14), Blake Burke (#17), Jadher Areinamo (#23), Juan Baez (#26), and Manuel Rodriguez (#29).

MLB Pipeline has five active Kernels on their list of Minnesota prospects: Brandon Winokur (#7), Kyle DeBarge (#12), Billy Amick (#14), Danny De Andrade (#25), and Jose Olivares (#28). Charlee Soto (#8), Rayne Doncon (#15), and Khadim Diaw (#29) are currently on the Cedar Rapids IL

■ PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TANNER GILLIS: The Milwaukee Brewers signed Gillis as a non-drafted free agent on September 3, 2024.

ON THE HORIZON: Gillis was a First Team All-Horizon League selection in his one season at Northern Kentucky in 2024. He was 8-3 with a 5.00 ERA in fourteen starts. Gillis had pitched four seasons for Cedarville University, an NCAA Division II school from 2019-2023.

HOW GREEN WAS THE VALLEY? Gillis made five appearances – four starts – for Mahoning Valley in the MLB Draft League in 2024. He was 2-1 with a 1.80 ERA, struck out 24, and walked seven over 25 innings.

CAROLINA ON MY MIND: Gillis started the 2025 season with the Carolina Mudcats. He was 1-1 with a save in seven relief appearances. Gillis had a 1.32 ERA and 28 strikeouts in 27-1/3 innings for the Mudcats before he was assigned to Wisconsin on May 15.

LAST START: Gillis had a no decision against South Bend at home on <u>July</u> 12 at home. He allowed two hits and struck out four over three scoreless innings.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS: Gillis has never faced the Kernels prior to this afternoon. Today is also the first time he has pitched against an affiliate of the Minnesota Twins.

CEDAR RAPIDS STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JOSE OLIVARES: The Twins signed Olivares as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on January 15, 2021.

SHORT SEASONS: Olivares pitched in the Dominican Summer League in 2021 and the Florida Complex League in 2022. He pitched fifteen innings in ten appearances in the DSL and 33-2/3 innings in ten appearances in Florida. Olivares was 5-4 with a save, 55 strikeouts, and 27 walks in those first two seasons.

HOLDING DOWN THE FORT: Olivares made 21 appearance – twenty starts – with Fort Myers in the Florida State League in 2023. He was 3-4 with a 6.22 ERA with 83 strikeouts in 85-1/3 innings. Olivares only made thirteen appearances – ten starts – with the Mighty Mussels in an injury-plagued 2024. He was 2-3 with 47 strikeouts in 46 innings last year in the Florida State League.

PLAYER RATING: MLB Pipeline ranks Olivares as the #28 prospect in the Minnesota system.

LAST START: Olivares earned the win at Peoria on July 10. He allowed three runs on two hits and three walks over five innings. Olivares had four strikeouts in the game.

VS. WISCONSIN: Olivares made two three-inning starts – April 22 and April 27 – against the Rattlers in Cedar Rapids. He allowed two hits, walked one, and struck out eight without allowing a run in six innings. On June 4 in Wisconsin, Olivares lost to the Rattlers when he gave up seven runs – six earned – on four hits and four walks over 3-2/3 innings.
