LAST ACTION: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Beloit Sky Carp 6-5 at Neuroscience Group Field on September 9, 2022.](https://www.wisconsin-timber-rattlers.com/news/2022/09/09-the-beloit-sky-carp-6-5-at-neuroscience-group-field-on-september-9-2022)

Eduardo García hit two home runs, including a homer that tied the game 5-5 in the eighth, for the Timber Rattlers. Zack Raabe and Antonio Piñero had back-to-back doubles later in the eighth to give Wisconsin the lead and James Meeker pitched a scoreless ninth for his seventeenth save of the season. The final two games of the 2022 season, scheduled for September 10 and 11 against Beloit at Neuroscience Group Field at Fox Cities Stadium, were rained out.

ABOUT LAST SEASON: Wisconsin finished the 2022 season 69-60. The Timber Rattlers finished the first half in second place in the West division with a 36-29 record. Wisconsin finished the second half in second place in the division with a 33-31 record. The 2022 Rattlers went 40-24 in 64 home games. It was the eighth time Wisconsin has won 40 or more home games in a season.

OPENING DAY HISTORY – CHAPTER ONE: This will be the 14th time since 1995 the Timber Rattlers will open a season on the road game. Wisconsin is 15-12 in their first 27 season-opening games. They are 5-8 in their thirteen road games to start a season.

OPENING DAY HISTORY – CHAPTER TWO: This is the ninth time Wisconsin has opened a season with a game against Beloit. The Rattlers are 5-3 in eight games against Beloit to start a season.

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's third season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Billy Gardner Jr is in his first season as the manager of the Sky Carp.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JOSEPH HERNANDEZ: Acquired by Milwaukee in a trade with the Seattle Mariners on January 7, 2023 in exchange for Justin Topa.

FROM THE REPUBLIC: The Mariners originally signed Hernandez as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on July 2, 2017.

TWO YEARS ON THE ISLAND: Hernandez spent his 2018 and 2019 seasons with the Mariners affiliate in the Dominican Summer League. He was 3-2 with a save and a 4.62 ERA in fifteen games – six starts – in 2018 and went 0-1 in four relief appearances in 2019. He had 28 walks and 47 strikeouts over 45 innings pitched in the DSL.

BACK AT IT: Hernandez spent most of his 201 season with the Mariners affiliate in the Arizona Complex League. He was 4-0 with a 4.35 ERA in ten games – four starts – with 49 strikeouts over 31 innings. He also made one start for Arkansas, Seattle's Double-A affiliate in the Texas League that season.

AWARD WINNING: Hernandez was 9-5 with a 3.39 ERA in 24 games – 22 starts – for the Modesto Nuts, Seattle's affiliate in the California League in 2022. He had 143 strikeouts over 116-2/3 innings pitched and was named the California League Pitcher of the Year.

LAST START: Hernandez picked up the win against Stockton on [September 9, 2022 in his final start](#) for Modesto. Hernandez allowed one hit, walked two, and struck out seven over five scoreless innings for the win.

VS. БЕЛОИТ: Hernandez has never faced the Sky Carp prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Miami Marlins.

БЕЛОИТ SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP EVAN FITTERER: The Marlins selected Fitterer in the 5th round of the 2019 draft out of Aliso Niguel (CA) High School.

NOT A BRUIN: Fitterer signed with the Marlins over a commitment to the UCLA.

HOW DOES HE RATE? MLB Pipeline has Fitterer rated at #27 on their list of Miami Marlins Prospects.

FIRST PRO SEASONS: Fitterer made nine appearances – eight starts – in the Gulf Coast League in 2019 after signing with Miami. He went 0-1 with a 2.38ERA with twelve walks and nineteen strikeouts over 22-2/3 innings pitched during his first pro season. Fitterer made two starts in the Florida Complex League and seven appearance – six starts – for Jupiter in the Low-A Southeast in 2021. He was 0-1 with a 4.15ERA with ten walks and 33 strikeouts over 30-1/3 innings pitched at those to levels in 2021.

LAST YEAR: Fitterer was 4-7 with a 4.28 ERA in 22 starts for the Sky Carp in 2022. He walked 46 and struck out 80 over 107-1/3 innings pitched.

LAST START: Fitterer had a [no decision at Wisconsin on September 8, 2022](#). He allowed a run on four hits with a walk and four strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN (2022): Fitterer had no record in three starts – [April 16](#), [June 10](#), and September 8 – against the Timber Rattlers last season. He has allowed five runs on ten hits with nine walks and eleven strikeouts over 14-2/3 innings versus Wisconsin.
