ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Beloit Sky Carp 5-1 at Neuroscience Group Field.](#)

Arbert Cipion broke a 1-1 tie with a two-run single in the bottom of the eighth inning and the Rattlers added two more runs in the inning for their third straight win. Wisconsin is 8-2 in their last ten games.

A MAN OF QUALITY: Wisconsin starting pitcher Alexander Cornielle gave up a home run on the second pitch of last night's game. That was the only run he allowed. Cornielle allowed four hits, walked two, and struck out seven over six innings for a no decision and a quality start. Last night was Cornielle's second straight quality start for the Timber Rattlers.

AIR ACOSTA: Jose Acosta made a leaping grab of a line drive and turned it into a double play in the top of the second. In the bottom of the inning, Acosta hit a two-out, solo home run to tie the game 1-1. In the eighth inning, Acosta drew a lead-off walk and eventually scored the go-ahead run on the single by Cipion.

BULLPEN BITS: Joey Matulovich picked up the win in last night's game with two scoreless innings. Brannon Jordan pitched a scoreless ninth. Wisconsin relievers have not allowed a run in twelve innings during the first three games of the series with the Sky Carp.

THE BEAT GOES ON: Jeferson Quero extended his current hitting streak to nine games with a single in the fourth inning. He is 19-for-39 (.487) with four homers and twelve RBI during the streak.

DID YOU KNOW? The Timber Rattlers have a chance to finish the season with 40 or more home wins for the eighth time in team history. The 2022 Rattlers are 39-24. The franchise record for home wins in a season is 48 and was set by the 1997 team.

ON ASSIGNMENT: The Milwaukee Brewers have sent outfielder Jonathan Davis to the Timber Rattlers on a rehab assignment.

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp are in their first season as the Sky Carp and their second season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and [moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3](#). Jorge Hernandez is in his first season as the manager of the Sky Carp.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have a history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) puts four active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Jackson Chourio (#1), Jeferson Quero (#7), Carlos F. Rodriguez (#19), and Eduardo Garcia (#21). Tyler Black (#6), Russell Smith (#20), and Carlos D. Rodriguez (#22) are on the Wisconsin injured list. [MLB Pipeline](#) has three Beloit players on their list of Marlins prospects: Jose Salas (#5), Victor Mesa Jr (#16), and MD Johnson (#28). Cody Morissette (#23) is on the Sky Carp's IL.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CARLOS RODRIGUEZ: Selected by Milwaukee in the 6th round of the 2021 draft out of Florida SouthWestern State Junior College.

ALL-DADE: Rodríguez was a four-year letter winner at Miami Christian High School. He had a 0.67 ERA in his senior season of high school and was an All-Dade County selection.

BUC SHOTS: Rodríguez went 7-2 with a 2.11 ERA and 62 strikeouts over 47 innings pitched in his only season at Florida SouthWestern State. He was a First Team All-Suncoast Conference selection for his performance for the Buccaneers.

PICKED HIGH: Rodríguez is the highest Florida SouthWestern State draft selection since the baseball program restarted in 2016. He was the highest MLB draft selection from the school since Kerry Ward was a fourth-round pick of the Pittsburgh Pirates in 1993.

SWEET CAROLINA: Rodríguez did not pitch professionally last season. His first action as a pro was this season with the Carolina Mudcats in the Carolina League. Rodríguez was 3-4 with a 3.53ERA in nineteen games – thirteen starts – prior to joining the Timber Rattlers. He had walked 27 and struck out 84 in 71-1/3 innings with the Mudcats.

LAST START: Rodríguez [pitched six perfect innings at Peoria on September 3](#). He struck out nine and picked up the win in the game. Rodríguez was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week for this performance.

VS. БЕЛОИТ: Rodríguez has never faced the Sky Carp prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Miami Marlins.

BELOIT STARTING PITCHER

RHP JAKE WALTERS: Walters was selected by the Marlins in the 9th round of the 2018 draft out of Alabama.

ROLL TIDE: Walters was 4-5 in 14 starts with 82 strikeouts in his final season with the Crimson Tide. He made 52 starts in four years at Alabama.

LUMBER BARON: Walters went 7-4 with a save in 19 games – 17 starts – for the Clinton LumberKings in 2019. He had a 2.35ERA and struck out 87 in 92 innings. He also made two starts during Clinton's playoff run during the 2019 playoffs. He was the winning pitcher in the series-clinching win against Kane County in the first round on [September 5](#). In Game Two of the Midwest League Championship Series on [September 12](#), Walters had a no decision despite allowing two runs – one earned – on six hits with a walk and six strikeouts over six innings.

LAST SEASON: Walters spent most of the 2021 season with Beloit as he made fifteen appearances – five starts. He also made two relief appearances with Jacksonville, the Triple-A affiliate of the Marlins. Walters was 2-3 with a save and a 4.06 ERA with the Sky Carp last season.

THIS SEASON: Walters has made fourteen appearances – eleven starts – with three different Miami minor league affiliates this season. He made four appearances – one start – in the Gulf Coast League, five starts with Jupiter in the Florida State League, and five appearances – three starts for Beloit. Walters is 3-3 with a save, a 3.00 ERA, and 48 strikeouts over 48 innings in the minors this season.

LAST START: Walters [beat Quad Cities at home on September 2](#). He allowed two runs – one earned – on six hits with two walks and three strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN (2021): Walters made five appearances – two starts – against the Rattlers last season. He went 0-1 with a 6.75 ERA. Walters allowed eleven runs on eighteen hits with eight walks and nineteen strikeouts over 14-2/3 innings pitched against Wisconsin in 2021.
