WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON: [The Cedar Rapids](#)

[Kernels beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 6-5 in thirteen innings at Veterans Memorial Stadium.](#) The Timber Rattlers rallied from a 2-0 deficit with three runs in the top of the seventh inning on RBI singles by Luiyin Alastre and Luis Peña and an RBI grounder by Sawyer Strosnider. The Kernels tied the game in the eighth. Blayberg Diaz put the Rattlers in front with an RBI in the top of the twelfth, but Cedar Rapids tied the game in their half of the twelfth. Strosnider gave Wisconsin a 5-4 lead with a run-scoring single in the thirteenth. The Kernels won the game in the bottom of the thirteenth on an RBI single by Quinn McDaniel and an RBI double by Jose Salas. Wisconsin was 4-for-18 with runners in scoring position. The Kernels went 3-for-23 with runners in scoring position.

FIRST TIME IN A LONG TIME: Yesterday was the first thirteen-inning game for Wisconsin since July 23, 2017. The current extra inning format was adopted in 2018.

HEATING UP: Peña was 2-for-5 with a walk, two stolen bases, a run scored, and an RBI yesterday. He is 15-for-42 (.357) with eight runs, six RBI, four walks, and an OPS of .974 in ten games this month.

THIS CLOSE: The Kernels scored their run in the twelfth on an errant throw that – had it been on target – would have ended the game on a double play.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence in 1949 as the Cedar Rapids Rockets, an unaffiliated team in the Central Association. They moved to the Three-I League as the Cedar Rapids Indians, an affiliate of Cleveland in 1950. They were affiliated with the Milwaukee Braves from 1954 through 1962. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the end of the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins from 2013 through 2023, including a 2023 Midwest League Championship. That streak ended in 2024 when the Kernels missed the playoffs but started again in 2025 when they advanced to the Midwest League Championship Series. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, and Milwaukee Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook. Hall of Famers John McGraw (1891 Canaries), Lou Boudreau (1938 Raiders), Ted Simmons (1967 Cardinals), and Trevor Hoffman (1991 Reds) played for earlier pro teams in Cedar Rapids.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

STARTING PITCHERS

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JOSH KNOTH: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Knoth in Competitive Balance Round-A of the 2023 draft out of Patchogue-Medford (NY) High School with the 33rd overall pick.

GLORY DAYS: Knoth broke a pair of season pitching records held by Marcus Strowman at Patchogue-Medford High School. Strowman had an ERA of 0.25 and 106 strikeouts in 2009. Knoth had 107 strikeouts in 2022. In 2023, Knoth had an ERA of 0.17 and 109 strikeouts.

GOING PRO: Knoth signed with the Brewers over a commitment to the University of Mississippi. He did not pitch professionally in 2023. Knoth was 4-6 with a 4.48 ERA in 21 starts for the Carolina Mudcats in 2024. He struck out 96 in 84-1/3 innings. Knoth missed the 2025 season with an injury.

HOW DOES HE RATE? Knoth is currently rated at #10 in the Brewers system by MLB Pipeline. *Baseball America* has him at #20 after their latest update.

STARTING OVER: Knoth began this season with the ACL Brewers. He had no record in three starts with eight strikeouts over six innings in the Arizona Complex League before joining the Rattlers on May 21.

IT'S A MAJOR AWARD: The Brewers named Knoth their Minor League Pitcher of the month for June. He was 2-0 with a 3.74 ERA in five games with five walks and twenty strikeouts over 21-2/3 innings in June.

LAST START: Knoth won his second straight start as the winning pitcher at Beloit on [August 7](#). He allowed three runs on five hits with three walks and eight strikeouts over five innings.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS: Knoth beat the Kernels at home on [June 24](#). He allowed a run on four hits with no walks and two strikeouts over five innings.

CEDAR RAPIDS STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ADRIAN BOHORQUEZ: The Minnesota Twins signed Bohorquez as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on January 15, 2023.

HOW DOES HE RATE? Bohorquez is rated as the #19 prospect in the Twins system by MLB Pipeline. *Baseball America* puts him at #18 on their list of Minnesota prospects.

CLIMBING THE LADDER: Bohorquez began his pro career in the Dominican Summer League in 2023 and was 0-4 with a 5.25 ERA in eight games – six starts. He split time between the Florida Complex League and the Florida State League in 2024 with a 2-3 record, a 3.23 ERA, and 62 strikeouts over 53 innings pitched in sixteen games – twelve starts. Bohorquez started 2025 with Fort Myers in the FSL and was 2-3 with 4.66 ERA in fourteen games – ten starts – before a promotion to Cedar Rapids in August.

AS A KERNEL: Bohorquez went 1-1 with a 3.52 ERA in five games – four starts – for the Kernels during the regular season. He also made a brief start in the 2025 playoffs. He started 2026 with the Kernels but went on the injured list on April 20. Bohorquez made three rehab starts in the FCL before returning to the Kernels on June 22.

LAST START: Bohorquez was not involved in the decision at South Bend on [August 5](#). He allowed two hits, walked two, and struck out six over five scoreless innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Bohorquez was not involved in the decision at Neuroscience Group Field on [June 27](#). That was his first appearance after his rehab assignment to the FCL. Bohorquez walked two and struck out one without allowing a hit over 1-1/3 scoreless innings.
