ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Beloit Sky Carp beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 6-3 at Neuroscience Group Field.](#) Beloit had three homers – Jake Thompson and Yiddi Cappe with solo shots and Zach Zubia with a two-run blast – to win their second straight game in the series. Thompson also doubled twice and scored three runs for the Sky Carp. Gabe Bierman allowed two runs on six hits over six innings for the win.

CHANCES WERE: Wisconsin trailed 5-0 after the top of the sixth but scored twice in the bottom of the sixth on RBI from Joe Gray Jr and Darrien Miller. The Rattlers got the tying run to the plate with two outs in the sixth but left two runners on base. Matt Wood drove in a run in the seventh and Wisconsin got the go-ahead run to the plate in the inning but left two runners on base again.

BAKER'S DOZEN: Ernesto Martinez Jr went 2-for-4 last night to extend his hitting streak to thirteen games. Martinez is 19-for-47 (.404) during the streak, which is the longest on the team in 2023. This is the longest hitting streak by a Rattler since LG Castillo had a fifteen-game hitting streak from June 16 through July 10, 2021. Je'Von Ward has the longest hitting streak by a Rattler in the High-A Era. He had a 17-game hitting streak from May 14 through June 11, 2021.

ONE QUARTER: Robert Moore was 1-for-5 with double and a run scored last night to extend his current on-base streak to 25 games. Moore is 28-for-95 (.295) with an OPS of .855 with sixteen walks, seventeen RBI, and sixteen runs scored during the streak that started on June 8. Moore's streak is the third-longest in the Midwest League this season. Moore also happens to be on an eleven-game hitting streak (14-for-44, .318), his longest of the season.

OF THIS ERA: Moore's on-base streak is the longest by a Rattler since the High-A Era began for the team in 2021. Moore's on-base streak is the longest by a Rattler since Thomas Dillard had a 29-game on-base streak from July 14 through August 15, 2019.

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's third season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Billy Gardner Jr is in his first season as the manager of the Sky Carp.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Jacob Misiorowski (#4), Robert Moore (#8), Hendry Mendez (#13), Eduardo Garcia (#19), and Matthew Wood (#24). Eric Brown Jr (#6) and Joseph Hernandez (#25) are currently on Wisconsin's IL. [MLB Pipeline](#) has five Beloit players on their list of Marlins prospects: Jacob Berry (#2), Joe Mack (#5), Yiddi Cappe (#6), Kahlil Watson (#12), and Karson Milbrandt (#15).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CAMERON WAGONER: Selected by Milwaukee in the eleventh round of the 2022 draft out of Eastern Michigan University.

EASTERN NOTES: Wagoner did not pitch collegiately in 2022. He made six relief appearances during the abbreviated 2020 season and 18 appearances – three starts – in 2021. He was 2-4 with a 4.42 ERA and 67 strikeouts over 57 innings during his two college seasons.

HOW DID YOU SPEND YOUR SUMMERS? Wagoner played for Greeneville in the Appalachian League in 2021 and was with both Wareham and Cotuit in the Cape Cod League in 2022. He was 2-3 with a 4.97 ERA in nineteen games – two starts – and 57 strikeouts over 38 innings pitched in those summer leagues.

AS A PRO: Wagoner made four appearances – two starts – for the ACL Brewers Gold after signing with Milwaukee. He was 1-0 and had eight strikeouts in eight innings in the ACL.

DOWN UNDER: Wagoner pitched for the Brisbane Bandits of the Australian Baseball League during the Winter of 2022-23. He made ten starts during the regular season of the ABL and was 3-1 with a 3.26 ERA and 43 strikeouts in 47 innings pitched.

LAST START: Wagoner lost at Quad Cities on [July 3](#). He allowed six runs on ten hits with a walk and a strikeout over 4-1/3 innings.

VS. QUAD CITIES: Wagoner is 0-2 in two starts against the Sky Carp this season. He lost to them at Beloit on [April 8](#) and at home on [April 26](#). Wagoner has allowed seven runs – six earned – on ten hits with no walks and six strikeouts over eight innings against Beloit this season.

BELOIT SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP KARSON MILBRANDT: Selected by the Miami Marlins in the third round of the 2022 draft out of Liberty (MO) High School. He is the #15 prospect in the Marlins system according to MLB Pipeline.

IS IT IN YOU? Milbrandt was named the Gatorade Player of the Year for Missouri prior to the 2022 draft. He was 7-1 with a 1.66 ERA and 91 strikeouts over 50-2/3 innings pitched. He also hit .400 with an OPS of 1.043 in his senior season.

VANDERWHAT? Milbrandt signed with the Marlins over a commitment to Vanderbilt University.

STARTING OUT: Milbrandt made one professional appearance in 2022, a two-inning start for the Jupiter Hammerheads against the Lakeland Flying Tigers on September 9 in a Florida State League game. He allowed two runs on two hits with a walk and a strikeout for a no decision.

LEAVING JUPITER: Milbrandt started this season with the Jupiter and was 3-3 with a 5.33 ERA in twelve starts. He walked 26 and struck out 52 in 52-1/3 innings pitched before being assigned to Beloit on June 28.

LAST START: Milbrandt had a no decision in his Midwest League debut on [July 2](#) at home against the South Bend Cubs. He allowed a run on three hits with three walks and five strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Milbrandt has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
