INDY BITS

ABOUT SUNDAY: The Indianapolis Indians could not overcome a five-home run performance by the Omaha Storm Chasers and dropped the series finale, 8-1, on Sunday aftermoon at Werner Park. The Storm Chasers jumped on Thomas Harrington early, when Nick Loftin and MJ Melendez launched back-to-back home runs to give Omaha a lead it would not relinquish. Omaha added to its lead in the third, beginning with a Nick Pratto single. John Rave followed with a triple to right field to drive in Pratto, and after Peyton Wilson drew a walk, Loftin grounded into a double play that brought in the inning's final run. Harold Castro's solo homer in the fourth extended the lead to 5-0. The Indians go the hibbard in the sixth when Ji Hwan Bae doubled and later scored on Jack Suwinski RBI single. The Storm Chasers responded with two more home runs in the seventh—a two-run shot off the bat of Nelson Velázquez and a solo homer from Rave—to seal the win for Omaha. Luinder Avila earned the win for the Storm Chasers, tossing six innings of one-run baseball, allowing five hits and striking out three. Indianapolis starter Harrington surrendered five runs on five hits with a pair of strikeouts and a valk in five innings of work.

PAIR O' PIRATES: First baseman Spencer Horwitz and right-handed pitcher Dauri Moreta today had their rehab assignments transferred to Indianapolis. Horwitz was placed on the 10-day injured list on March 27, retroactive to March 24, after undergoing right wrist surgery on Feb. 12. He began a rehab assignment with Double-A Altoona on April 27 and appeared in five games between first base and designated hitter with a .125 batting average (2-for-16), one double, two walks and two runs. Moreta was placed on the 60-day injured list on Feb. 16 after undergoing Tommy John surgery and being sidelined for the entire 2024 season. Nearly 14 months after his last professional appearance, the right-hander began a rehab assignment with High-A Bradenton on April 29 and tossed 2.0 scoreless innings in two games.

BAEWATCH: Ji Hwan Bae extended his on-base streak to 17 games on Sunday, going 1-for-4 with one double and one run. It is the longest on-base streak by an Indian this season and is tied for the fourth longest active streak in the International League. He is hitting, 290 (20-for-69) with six doubles, five RBI, eight walks, 17 runs and five stolen bases in this span. Since making his season debut with Indy on April 8, Bae's 20 runs socred rank second in the International League behind Lehigh Valley's Otto Kernp (24r). He has one-plus hit in eight straight contests, 11 of his past 12 and 14 of the 17 games in his active on-base streak. He has scored one-plus run in 12 of the 17 games and one-plus walk in seven of those games. Bae scored a career-high tying four runs on April 17 vs. Toledo (3x, MR: 9/11/22 at OMA). He tallied a stolen base in four straight games from April 17-22, marking his first time stringing four straight games with a steal air etied for the longest streak by an International League player this season. He picked up three RBI in Game 1 on April 25, driving in three-plus runs for the first time since Sept. 22, 2024, at St. Paul.

MALCOM'S ROADTRIP: Malcom Nuñez capped off the Indians 13-game road trip on Sunday going 3-for-4 with one double. It marked his first three-plus hit performance since a career-high tying four knocks on Sept. 2, 2024 at Toledo. Appearing in 11 of those games, Nuñez hit a team best. 412 (14-for-34) with three doubles, three RBI, three walks, four runs and a .936 OPS. He had four multi-hit performances in this span and had one-plus hit in nine of those. He has eight multi-hit games on the campaign with 11 of his 27 hits going for extra bases.

HARRINGTON'S START: Thomas Harrington took his second loss of the season on Sunday, tossing a season-high tying 5.0 innings with a season-high tying five runs, five hits, one walk and a season low two strikeouts. Harrington allowed a career-high three home runs in the defeat. He has allowed five-plus hits in three straight starts for the first time since a four-start stretch from May 24-June 11, 2024, with Altoona. Harrington has completed 5.0-plus innings in 9 of his 12 career starts with Indianapolis.

EXITMUSIC (FOR A BASEBALL). Nick Yorke caught fire on the Indians 13-game road trip, appearing in all of those games, hitting, 327 (16-for-49) with two home runs, seven RBI, five walks, six runs and three stolen bases. He has a hit in four straight contests and multiple hits in three of those. He went 2-for-4 on Sunday, posting his fifth multi-hit game of the road trip. He launched his third home run of the season in the seventh inning on Friday right, going 2-for-5 with a home run, two RBI, two runs and two stolen bases. It marked his first time homering in back-to-back games since June 8 and 9, 2024, with Worcester. Additionally, he posted back-to-back multi-RBI games for the first time this season. He swiped two-plus bags in that game for the first time since September 13, 2023, with Portland vs. Hartford. He swatted his second homer run of the season in the first inning on Thursday, going 3-for-5 with two RBI and one run. It marked his second three-hit game of the campaign, last doing so on April 22 at 5t. Paul.

SOLAK ECLIPSE: Nick Solak is on a scorching run to begin the 2025 season, ranking among International League leaders in batting average (.361, 30-for-83, 2nd), OPS (1.009, 4th) and SLG (.590, 4th). Going 0-for-4 on Sunday, it marked his first start without a hit since Game 2 on April 25 at St. Paul. He has reached base safely in 21 of his 24 games on the campaign and has one-plus hit in 20 of those, including a team best 13-game hitting streak from April 3-23. Solak hit. 4.00 (20-for-50) with throughouse, three home runs, 11 RBI, four walks, 11 runs, three stolen bases and a 1.056 OPS in that span. He struck out just seven times across 55 plate appearances during thitting streak. His 394 average and 1.070 OPS through April were the highest for an Indians hitter through April (min. 75 PA) since Gregory Polanco hit. 400 with a 1.089 OPS through the month in 2014. He tallied a pinch-hit single in the ninth inning on Wednesday after relieving DI Stewart. With a pinch-hit homer on Sunday in the eighth inning at St. Paul, these marked his first two knocks as a pinch hitter in his minor league career and the latest two since a pinch-hit single of fisick Porcello on Sept. 25, 2019, with Texas vs. Boston.

YEAN SHORTS: Eddy Yean tossed 1.0 scoreless innings on Sunday, extending his scoreless outing streak to seven games. This run is the longest scoreless outing streak by an Indian this season and Yean's longest of his career. He tossed 1.1 scoreless innings on Tuesday, escaping a bases-loaded jam in the eighth inning after walking three consecutive batters with one out. In this span, he has thrown 9.1 innings with six hits, five walks and seven strikeouts. This, opposed to allowing four runs, five hits and five walks with just one strikeout in his first 2.1 innings this season.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians begin a 12-game homestand and six-game series against the Columbus Clippers tonight at 6:35 PM. The Indians lost last season's series 5-12, going 3-8 at Victory Field and 2-4 at Columbus. Right-hander Mike Burrows is set to make his sixth appearance and fifth start of the season, last tossing 3.0 shutout innings out of the bullpen on Thursday with one hit, one walk and a season-high five strikeouts. In three career games (two starts) against the Clippers, Burrows has a 9.45 ERA (*Tevl*6.2ip) with 10 hits, two walks and eight strikeouts. Taking the mound for the Clippers is right-hander Slade Cecconi who is set to make his second start of the season. He tossed 3.1 innings on April 30 at St. Paul with one hit, two runs, one walk and five strikeouts. Tonight marks his first career appearance against Indianapolis.

ONTHIS DATE IN 2004: With a 19-3 win over Charlotte, the Indians set a new Victory Field era record with the most runs scored in a game at home. Indy put up five runs in the second, four in the third, five in the fifth and four in the seventh behind 20 team hits, four of which came off the bat of second baseman Matt Erickson.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Mike Burrows: Right-hander Mike Burrows is set to make his fourth start of the season. It will mark his third start at home, last tossing 2.1 innings of one-run ball on April 6 vs. Iowa.

Last Outing: On May 1 at Omaha, Burrows tossed 3.0 shutout innings out of the bullpen with one hit, one walk and a season-high five strikeouts.

Against the Clippers: In three career games (two starts) against the Clippers, Burrows is 0-1 with a 9.45 ERA (7er/6.2ip) with 10 hits, two walks and eight strikeouts.

September Callup: Following his 10-strikeout performance in the Indians 2024 season finale, Burrows was recalled by Pittsburgh for his major league debut on Sept. 28 at New York (AL). He earned the win out of the bullpen, allowing two runs (one earned) over 3.1 innings. He struck out Oswaldo Cabrera swinging as his second batter faced for his first MLB punchout.

Prospectus: Burrows is currently rated as Pittsburgh's No. 13 prospect by *Baseball America* and No. 15 by MLB Pipeline.
