**Aviators vs. Rainiers:** The Las Vegas Aviators professional baseball team, Triple-A affiliate of the Athletics and '25 PCL Champions, will face the Tacoma Rainiers, Triple-A affiliate of the Seattle Mariners, tonight in game three of the six-game series in Pacific Coast League action at Las Vegas Ballpark (8,196)...Las Vegas is 1-1 in the series...the homestand against Tacoma will conclude on Sunday, July 12...the Triple-A Break, that coincides with the MLB All-Star Break, will be held from Monday-Thursday, July 13-16...the Aviators will then travel to Texas to face the Round Rock Express, in a three-game series from Friday-Sunday, July 17-18-19.

#### Tacoma defeats Las Vegas 9-7 in game two of series:

The Rainiers defeated the Aviators, 9-7, last night in game two of the six-game homestand before a crowd of 4,458 at Las Vegas Ballpark.

**Las Vegas Offense:** The Aviators recorded 12 hits and stranded 10 runners on base. Three players had three-hit games: Second baseman **Darell Hernaiz** was 3-for-5, HR, 4 RBI. Right fielder **Brayan Buelvas** was 3-for-3, triple, walk, RBI, run scored and catcher **Brian Serven** was 3-for-5, triple, run scored.

**Tacoma Offense:** The Rainiers recorded 14 hits and stranded 14 runners on base. Tacoma, trailing 7-5, rallied for four runs in the ninth inning. Shortstop **Brock Rodden** was 3-for-4, double, two walks, stolen base, RBI. DH **Spencer Packard** was 3-for-4, walk, two runs scored and center fielder **Victor Labrada** was 2-for-4, double, triple, 3 RBI.

**Salt Lake defeats Las Vegas 9-1 in game five of series (Saturday, July 4):** The Bees defeated the Aviators, 9-1, in game five of the six-game series before a crowd of 7,837 at The Ballpark at America First Square.

**Las Vegas Offense:** The Aviators recorded 6 hits and stranded six runners on base. Las Vegas scored its lone run in the third inning on RBI single by center fielder **Cade Marlowe** (1-for-3, walk). Left fielder **Brayan Buelvas** was 1-for-3, double and second baseman **Michael Stefanic** was 1-for-4, double.

**Salt Lake Offense:** The Bees recorded 14 hits and stranded eight runners on base. Six players recorded multiple-hit games: Designated hitter **Jeimer Candelario** was 3-for-5, run scored. **Las Vegas defeats Salt Lake 10-6 in series finale (Sunday, July 5):** The Aviators defeated the Bees, 10-6, in the finale of the six-game series and the season-long 12-game road trip before a crowd of 4,558 at The Ballpark at America First Square.

**Las Vegas Offense:** The Aviators recorded 14 hits and stranded 13 runners on base. Five players recorded multiple-hit games: Shortstop **Drew Swift** was 3-for-5, double, walk, SB, two runs scored. **Las Vegas defeats Tacoma 9-5 in series opener (Tuesday, July 7):** The Reyes de Plata defeated the Rainiers, 9-5, in the opener of the six-game homestand before a crowd of 4,543 at Las Vegas Ballpark.

**Las Vegas Offense:** The Reyes de Plata recorded 11 hits and stranded nine runners on base. Four players recorded multiple-hit games: Third baseman **Tommy White** was 3-for-4 with a double, SF, RBI, run scored. First baseman **Joey Meneses** was 2-for-4, HR, SF, RBI, 3 RBI, two runs scored; second baseman **Drew Swift** was 2-for-4, double, stolen base, two runs scored and right fielder **Brayan Buelvas** was 2-for-4, double, RBI, run scored.

**Tacoma Offense:** The Rainiers recorded 9 hits and stranded eight runners on base. Shortstop **Ryan Bliss** was 3-for-5, triple, RBI, run scored. Third baseman **Patrick Wisdom** (2-for-5) hit a three-run home run in the first inning.

**AVIATORS INFLIGHT NEWS** – Las Vegas is 1-1 in the series...the six-game homestand against the Tacoma Rainiers, Triple-A affiliate of the Seattle Mariners, will conclude on Sunday, July 12...the Aviators hold the best record in Triple-A at 54-33 (.621)...Memphis Redbirds (Triple-A affiliate of the St. Louis Cardinals, International League) have the second best overall record at 54-35 (.607)...Las Vegas also has the best road record in the PCL (31-15, .674)...Tacoma and Las Vegas will play each other a total of 24 times in 2026...following the homestand, the Triple-A break will be held from Monday-Thursday, July 13-16...the Aviators will then travel to Texas to face the Round Rock Express, Triple-A affiliate of the Texas Rangers, in a three-game series from Friday-Sunday, July 17-19...the 2026 season will feature six-game series from Tuesday-Sunday and off days on Mondays...the '26 campaign will now feature 148 games (75-home; 73-away)...150-game campaign has been scheduled for the fifth consecutive season (2022 – present).

**AVIATORS CLINCH SPOT IN 2026 PCL PLAYOFFS:** Las Vegas, on Saturday, June 20, officially won the first half of the 10-team Pacific Coast League title and clinched a spot in the 2026 playoffs for the second consecutive season...the Aviators will host the second half champion in the PCL best-of-three LCS beginning on Tuesday, September 22 at Las Vegas Ballpark®...the Memphis Redbirds, Triple-A affiliate of the St. Louis Cardinals, captured the 20-team International League first half...the Las Vegas Ballpark will then host the Triple-A National Championship Game (International League vs. Pacific Coast League) for the fifth straight season on Saturday, September 26 and the time is TBA.

**2026 PCL PITCHERS OF THE WEEK:** Right-hander **Mason Barnett** from April 20-26...defeated Salt Lake on April 25 at Las Vegas Ballpark...5.0 shutout innings, one hit, walked two, seven strikeouts on 72 pitches (44 strikes). Left-hander **Gage Jump** from May 18-24...no decision vs. Albuquerque on May 20...season-high 7.0 shutout innings, four hits, no walks, nine strikeouts on 88 pitches (61 strikes).

**2026 PCL PLAYERS OF THE WEEK:** Outfielder **Henry Bolte** from May 4-10...appeared in six games against St. Paul and batted .556 (15-for-27) with four doubles, one triple, five home runs and 9 RBI, including a franchise record 12 consecutive hits (May 7-8-9) and tied the PCL record.

Outfielder **Cade Marlowe** (May 18-24)...appeared in six games against Albuquerque and batted .538 (14-for-26) with five doubles, triple, two home runs, 13 RBI and nine runs scored, which included five-multiple-hit games.

Infielder **Joey Meneses** (June 15-21)...appeared in five games against Round Rock and batted .550 (11-for-20) with two doubles, one triple, two home runs, 11 RBI and 10 runs scored, which included four multiple-hit games.

**43<sup>rd</sup> SEASON IN THE SILVER STATE (1983-2026)** – The Aviators are playing in their 43<sup>rd</sup> season (44<sup>th</sup> calendar season) in the Silver State as a proud member of the Pacific Coast League...**the Las Vegas Aviators have the proud distinction of being Nevada's longest enduring professional sports franchise**...Las Vegas Triple-A baseball was born on April 10, 1983 before a sellout crowd of 10,622 at Cashman Field (Las Vegas defeated Salt Lake City, 11-8)...catcher **Bruce Bochy** has the distinction of hitting the first Triple-A home run in Cashman Field history for the Las Vegas Stars on April 10, 1983.

**PACIFIC COAST LEAGUE:** The PCL is in its 123<sup>rd</sup> season (1903-2020, 2022 -) and consists of two divisions for a total of 10 teams. **West Division:** Las Vegas Aviators, Reno Aces, Sacramento River Cats, Salt Lake Bees, Tacoma Rainiers; **East Division:** Albuquerque Isotopes, El Paso Chihuahuas, Oklahoma City Comets, Round Rock Express, Sugar Land Space Cowboys. The 10-team league in 2021 was named Triple-A West and returned as the PCL in 2022!

**INTERNATIONAL LEAGUE:** The IL consists of two divisions for a total of 20 teams. **East Division:** Buffalo Bisons, Charlotte Knights, Durham Bulls, Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp, Lehigh Valley IronPigs, Norfolk Tides, Rochester Red Wings, Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, Syracuse Mets, Worcester Red Sox. **West Division:** Columbus Clippers, Gwinnett Stripers, Indianapolis Indians, Iowa Cubs, Louisville Bats, Memphis Redbirds, Nashville Sounds, Omaha Storm Chasers, St. Paul Saints, Toledo Mud Hens. The 20-team league in 2021 was named Triple-A East and returned as the IL in 2022.

**INTERLEAGUE PLAY IN 2026:** The Aviators, for the second straight season, played opponents from the IL. Las Vegas hosted the St. Paul Saints, Triple-A affiliate of the Minnesota Twins, in a six-game series from Tuesday-Sunday, May 5-10 at Las Vegas Ballpark. Las Vegas traveled to Omaha, Nebraska and played the Omaha Storm Chasers, Triple-A affiliate of the Kansas City Royals, in a six-game series from Tuesday-Sunday, June 9-14.

**2025 SEASON** – The Aviators compiled an overall record of 83-67 (.553) and finished in second place in the PCL West Division. Las Vegas won the first half with a 49-26 record (.653) and Tacoma won the second half. The Aviators then defeated the Rainiers, 2-games-to-0, in the LCS at Las Vegas Ballpark to capture its third PCL championship in franchise history (1986, 1988, 2025). Las Vegas then lost to the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (International League champions), Triple-A affiliate of the Miami Marlins, 8-7, in the **Triple-A National Championship Game** on September 27 before the sellout crowd of 10,129 at Las Vegas Ballpark.

**2024 SEASON** – The Aviators compiled an overall record of 74-75 (.497) and finished in fourth place in the PCL West Division. The Tacoma Rainiers captured the West Division with an overall record of 82-68 (.547). Sugar Land Space Cowboys recorded the best record in the 30-team Triple-A (93-56, .624) and defeated the Reno Aces, 2-games-to-0, to capture the PCL Championship. Sugar Land then defeated the Omaha Storm Chasers, Triple-A affiliate of the Kansas City Royals, 13-6, in the **Triple-A National Championship** game on September 28 before a crowd of 8,007 at Las Vegas Ballpark.

**LAS VEGAS 80-WIN SEASONS** – The Las Vegas franchise has won 80 or more games in a seven six times: **85** (2002, franchise best 85-59 record (.590); **83** (1983 inaugural season, 83-60 (.580); **83** (83-57, .593 in 2019); **83** (83-67, .553 in 2025); **81** (81-63, .563 in 2013); **81** (81-63, .563 in 2014); **80** (1986 PCL champions with an 80-62 mark (.563)...Las Vegas recorded back-to-back 80-win seasons for the first time in franchise history (2013 & 2014)...the 83-57 record in 2019 marked a single-season franchise record for winning percentage at .593 (140-game season).

**LAS VEGAS BALLPARK HISTORY:** Howard Hughes Holdings Inc. (NYSE: HHH) then-owner announced on **October 10, 2017** its plans to develop and construct a baseball stadium in Downtown Summerlin® on approximately eight acres just south of City National Arena, the National Hockey League practice facility for the Vegas Golden Knights. The announcement on October 10, followed a vote by the Las Vegas Convention and Visitors Authority Board of Directors approving a marketing partnership that gives **LVCVA** naming rights to the stadium. The Las Vegas Ballpark was designed by HOK, a global architecture firm with an expertise in stadium design and constructed by **HUNT/PENTA**.

The groundbreaking ceremony took place on **Friday, February 23, 2018** before a crowd of several hundred people! The 8,196-fan-capacity stadium blends the distinct architectural style of the Summerlin® community with the aviation legacy of Howard Hughes. The ballpark provides a wide range of seating options including 22 suites, club seats, berm seating, party zones and decks, picnic tables, kids' zone, bars and even a pool beyond the outfield wall. Designed to create a festival-like atmosphere in Downtown Summerlin, the site is landscaped to complement the master planned community. Parking is conveniently located on adjacent sites. The grand opening took place on **Tuesday, April 9, 2019** before a sellout crowd of 11,036 and the Aviators defeated Sacramento, 10-2.

**LAS VEGAS AVIATORS LOGO AND INFORMATION HISTORY:** Howard Hughes Holdings Inc. (NYSE: HHH), then-owner of the city's professional Triple-A baseball team of the Pacific Coast League, and developer of the Summerlin® master planned community and the Las Vegas Ballpark® located at Downtown Summerlin®, announced on **December 8, 2018** the team's new name - the **Las Vegas Aviators®**.

The name change completed a rebrand that included the team's new two-year Player Development Contract (PDC) with the Athletics (2018) and the opening of the Las Vegas Ballpark, the state-of-the-art Triple-A baseball stadium, that now serves as the home of the Aviators.

The name change (from 51<sup>st</sup>) pays homage to the company's namesake, **Howard R. Hughes, Jr.**, one of the twentieth century's most successful businessmen whose passion for aviation and legacy of innovation includes significant aviation-related firsts and accomplishments. In the H-1 Racer, a plane he designed and built, Hughes set the land speed record of 352 miles per hour in 1935. Hughes went on to set other records, including the fastest coast-to-coast flight in 1937 and the fastest circumnavigation of the globe in 1938, then acquiring and successfully operating major airlines and aviation companies.

**NEW YORK, NY (AUGUST 1, 2024) – Seaport Entertainment Group Inc.** (NYSE American: SEG) (the "Seaport Entertainment Group" or "Company"), a newly formed company positioned at the intersection of entertainment and real estate, announced that it has completed its previously announced separation (the "Separation") from its predecessor **Howard Hughes Holdings Inc.** (NYSE: HHH) ("Howard Hughes") and is now an independent, standalone publicly traded company. The Company began its common stock trading (August 1) on the NYSE American LLC under the ticker symbol SEG.

Seaport Entertainment Group's portfolio is anchored by the historic Seaport neighborhood in Lower Manhattan, which includes 478,000 square feet of primarily retail, restaurant and entertainment offerings, the 3,500-person concert venue on The Rooftop at Pier 17, a mixed-use development site at 250 Water Street, and the Tin Building by Jean-Georges, an immersive culinary marketplace. The Company's portfolio also includes **Las Vegas Ballpark in downtown Summerlin, NV; the Las Vegas Aviators, the Triple-A Minor League Baseball Affiliate of the Athletics**; a 25% ownership interest in Jean-Georges Restaurants; and an interest in and to 80% of the air rights above the Fashion Show mall in Las Vegas.
