ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cedar Rapids Kernels beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 4-1 on Friday night at PG Cares Field. Cedar Rapids scored single runs in the first, third, fourth, and sixth inning. The Timber Rattlers were held to four hits in the game. Darrien Miller drove in Wisconsin's run with a two-out, RBI single in the top of the ninth. Marco Raya pitched three scoreless hitless innings as the starter. Jordan Carr pitched the final six innings in relief for the win.

AVOIDING THE SHUTOUT: Wisconsin's run in the ninth inning helped them avoid being shutout for the third time this season.

THE MILLER'S TALE: Miller extended his hitting streak to six games with his single last night. He has matched his longest hitting streak of the season. Miller's longest hitting streak with the Timber Rattlers last season was eight games.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU? Eric Brown Jr. singled in the sixth inning. He is 10-for-19 in the series. Brown is 28-fo-79 (.354) with a .935 OPS in twenty games during May.

EPIC AT BAT: Wisconsin starting pitcher Cameron Wagoner and Cedar Rapids shortstop Ben Ross faced each other with one out and runners on second and third in the bottom of the fourth inning. Wagoner missed with ball one. Ross fouled off the next four pitches. Then, Wagoner missed with ball two. Ross fouled off the next nine pitches. Wagoner finally retired Ross on a foul pop to third on the sixteenth pitch of the

RELIEF WORK: Luis Amaya took over for Wagoner after the marathon at bat and got the final out of the inning on the first pitch he threw to strand both runners. Amaya has inherited twelve runners this season and only allowed three to score.

LOOK OUT FOR GOPHERS: Kyler Fedko hit a solo homer in the bottom of the sixth. The Kernels have hit six homers in the first four games of this series.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence as the Cedar Rapids Braves, an affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves in the Three-I League, in 1958. That was the same year and league the current Timber Rattlers franchise joined the Three-I League as the Fox Cities Foxes. Both teams moved to the Midwest League when the Three-I League ended after the 1961 season. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels have made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, Trevor Hoffman, Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook, and Ted Simmons

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Eric Brown Jr (#6), Robert Moore (#8), Eduardo García (#19), Matthew Wood (#24), and Joseph Hernandez (#25). Hendry Mendez (#13) is currently on Wisconsin's IL. MLB Pipeline has nine active Kernels on their list of Minnesota prospects: Emmanuel Rodriguez (#3), Marco Raya (#6), Jose Salas (#9), Noah Miller (#13), Tanner Schobel #16), Misael Urbina (#21), Alejandro Hidalgo (#22), Ben Ross (#28), and Jaylin Nowlin (#29). Connor Prelipp (#5) is currently on the IL.

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP STIVEN CRUZ: Signed by Milwaukee as an International Free Agent out of Nicaragua on July 2, 2019.

DELAYED START: Cruz began his pro career with the Brewers-1 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2021. He was 3-3 with a 1.37 ERA and 73 strikeouts over 52-2/3 innings pitched in twelve games – eleven starts.

MUDDY WATERS: Cruz started the 2022 season with the Carolina Mudcats in the Carolina League. He went 3-5 with a 4.60 ERA in fifteen starts for Carolina. Cruz walked 18 and struck out 89 over 72-1/3 innings pitched.

ON TO WISCONSIN: Cruz joined the Timber Rattlers on August 16, 2022. He made four starts with the Rattlers and allowed one run on six hits with six walks and twenty strikeouts over nineteen innings pitched for a 1-1 record

IT'S A MAJOR AWARD: Cruz beat Lansing at home on August 24, 2022. He allowed a hit with a walk and seven strikeouts over six scoreless innings in the game. Cruz was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week on August 29 for this game.

LAST START: Cruz lost to Quad Cities at home on May 21. He four runs on three hits with two walks and three strikeouts over 2-2/3 innings.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS: Cruz lost to the Kernels in Cedar Rapids in his Timber Rattlers debut on <u>August 18, 2022</u>. Cruz allowed one run on one hit, a lead-off home run by Mikey Perez in the top of the fifth inning. He walked two and struck out five over six innings. Wisconsin lost the game 1-0 the homer by Perez was the only hit in the game for the Kernels.

CEDAR RAPIDS SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ALEJANDRO HIDALGO: The Twins acquired Hidalgo from the Los Angeles Angels on November 18, 2022 in a trade that sent Gio Urshela to the Angels.

ORIGIN STORY: Hidalgo was originally signed by the Angles as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on July 2, 2019.

IN THE DESERT: Hidalgo did not pitch professionally in 2019 or 2020. He made his professional debut with the Arizona Complex League Angels in 2021. He was 3-2 with a 4.67 ERA in seven games – six starts – with nine walks and 31 strikeouts over 27 innings.

TO THE EMPIRE: The Angels assigned Hidalgo to the Inland Empire 66ers for the 2022 season. He went 0-3 in ten starts with a 4.62 ERA and 58 strikeouts over 39 innings pitched. Hidalgo was placed on the IL list after a start on June 11 and didn't pitch for the 66ers for the remainder of the season.

FEELING 22: Hidalgo is the #22 prospect in the Twins organization as rated by MLB Pipeline after the trade.

LAST START: Hidalgo had a <u>no decision against Peoria at home on May 21</u>. He allowed two runs on one hit and six walks 1-1/3 innings. Hidalgo had one strikeout in the game.

VS. WISCONSIN: Hidalgo has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. He made two starts against the Milwaukee Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League during the 2021 season. Hidalgo was 1-0, allowed four runs on nine hits, walked two, and struck out seven in those two starts.
