ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Quad Cities River Bandits beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 5-1 at Neuroscience Group Field.](#)

Andrew Fischer doubled, stole third, and scored on an RBI grounder by Jesús Made in the bottom of the first inning. Austin Charles hit a two-out, two-run home run in the top of the third to give Quad Cities a 2-1 lead. The Bandits added a run in the fifth and two runs in the ninth while holding Wisconsin to two hits for the game. Nolan Sailors went 4-for-5 with an RBI while Charles was 3-for-4 for Quad Cities. The loss was the fourth in a row for the Rattlers.

TWO HITS, THREE BASERUNNERS: Fischer had both of Wisconsin's hits. He also singled in the sixth inning for his third multi-hit game as a Rattler. Tayden Hall was the only other Rattler to reach base last night as he walked with two outs in the second inning. Hall has 66 walks this season. Quad Cities pitchers faced one batter over the minimum for a nine-inning game. Hall and Fischer were both caught stealing after they reached in the second and sixth innings. Wisconsin left no runners on base and went 0-for-1 with runners in scoring position in the game.

SHUTDOWN MODE: Patricio Aquino allowed an infield single, walked none, and struck out five over 2-1/3 innings in relief for the Rattlers last night.

DOWN THE STRETCH: Quad Cities picked up ground in the playoff race on both the Beloit Sky Carp and the South Bend Cubs last night as the teams tied for the top spot lost last night. Beloit has the tiebreaker on South Bend. Quad Cities has the tiebreaker on both Beloit and South Bend. The Rattlers loss last night dropped their elimination number to one.

ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo (1969-1976), Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TANNER GILLIS: The Milwaukee Brewers signed Gillis as a non-drafted free agent on September 3, 2024.

ON THE HORIZON: Gillis was a First Team All-Horizon League selection in his one season at Northern Kentucky in 2024. He was 8-3 with a 5.00 ERA in fourteen starts. Gillis had pitched four seasons for Cedarville University, an NCAA Division II school from 2019-2023.

HOW GREEN WAS THE VALLEY? Gillis made five appearances – four starts – for Mahoning Valley in the MLB Draft League in 2024. He was 2-1 with a 1.80 ERA, struck out 24, and walked seven over 25 innings.

CAROLINA ON MY MIND: Gillis started the 2025 season with the Carolina Mudcats. He was 1-1 with a save in seven relief appearances. Gillis had a 1.32 ERA and 28 strikeouts in 27-1/3 innings for the Mudcats before he was assigned to Wisconsin on May 15.

IT'S A MAJOR AWARD: Gillis was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week on August 11. He set a new professional single-game high for strikeouts with seven over 6-1/3 scoreless innings at Peoria on August 7.

LAST START: Gillis had a no decision at Beloit on [August 21](#). He allowed two runs on six hits with two walks and three strikeouts over six innings.

VS. QUAD CITIES: Gillis had a no decision at Quad Cities on [July 26](#). He allowed two runs on three hits with two walks and three strikeouts over four innings. The only other time he has pitched against an affiliate of the Kansas City Royals was on [April 24](#) as a reliever for the Carolina Mudcats against the Columbia Fireflies. He allowed two runs on seven hits with no walks and four strikeouts over three innings for a blown save and a loss.

QUAD CITIES STARTING PITCHER:

RHP EMMANUEL REYES: The Royals signed Reyes as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic in 2022.

CLIMBING THE LADDER: Reyes pitched for both of Kansas City's Dominican Summer League affiliates in 2022, split time between the Arizona Complex League and the Columbia Fireflies of the Carolina League in 2023, and spent the entire 2024 season with Columbia. He was 5-5 with a 3.62 ERA in 23 games – 21 starts – and struck out 85 over 107 innings with the Fireflies last year.

THIS SEASON: Reyes began 2025 in the ACL and was 1-1 in three relief appearances. He moved to Columbia on June 14 and was 1-2 with a 3.72 ERA in eight games – six starts – before he was transferred to the River Bandits on July 29.

LAST START: Reyes lost to Great Lakes at home on [August 21](#). He allowed three runs – two earned – on four hits with four walks and six strikeouts over four innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Reyes has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers in his career. He is 1-1 in two appearances against affiliates of the Milwaukee Brewers this season. He won in three innings of scoreless, hitless relief against the ACL Brewers on [June 4](#) and lost as a starter at Carolina on June 21 when he allowed five runs – four earned – over 2-1/3 innings.
